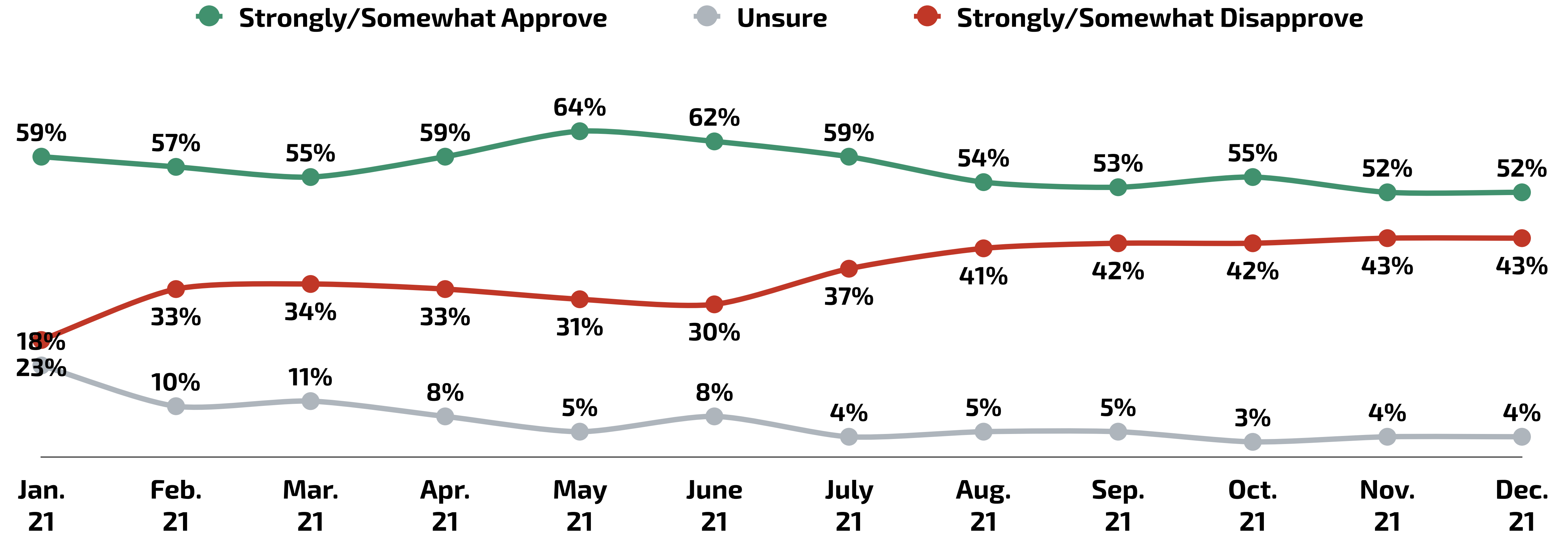

Q. Do you approve or disapprove of how Joe Biden is handling the spread of the coronavirus in the United States?



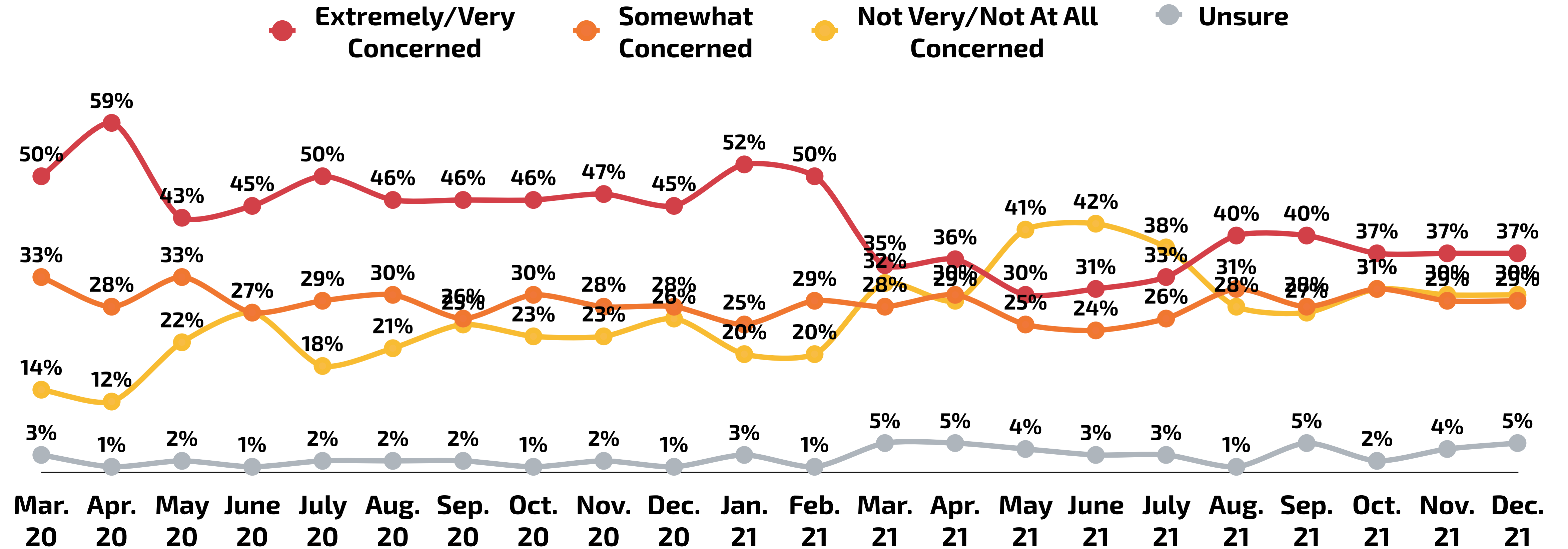

Q. How personally concerned are you about the chances of you or someone in your family becoming infected with the coronavirus?

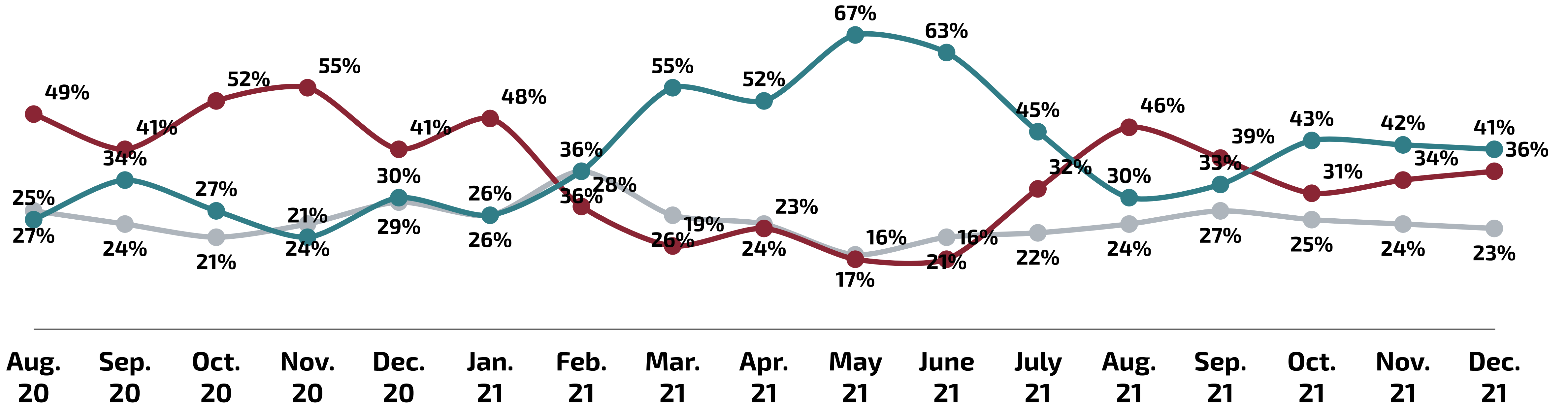


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“Worst Is Yet To Come” On The Rise Since October

Q. Which of the following best describes your feelings about the coronavirus outbreak in the United States?

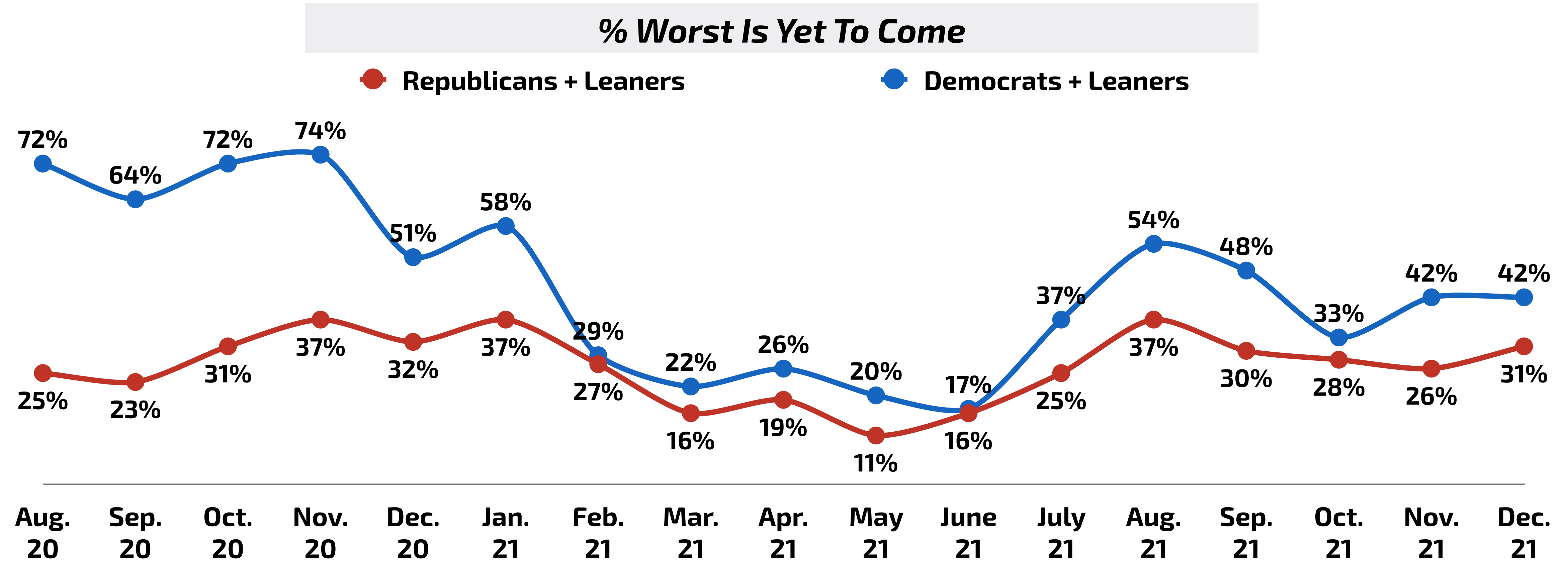
● The worst is behind us

Q. Which of the following best describes your feelings about the coronavirus outbreak in the United States?

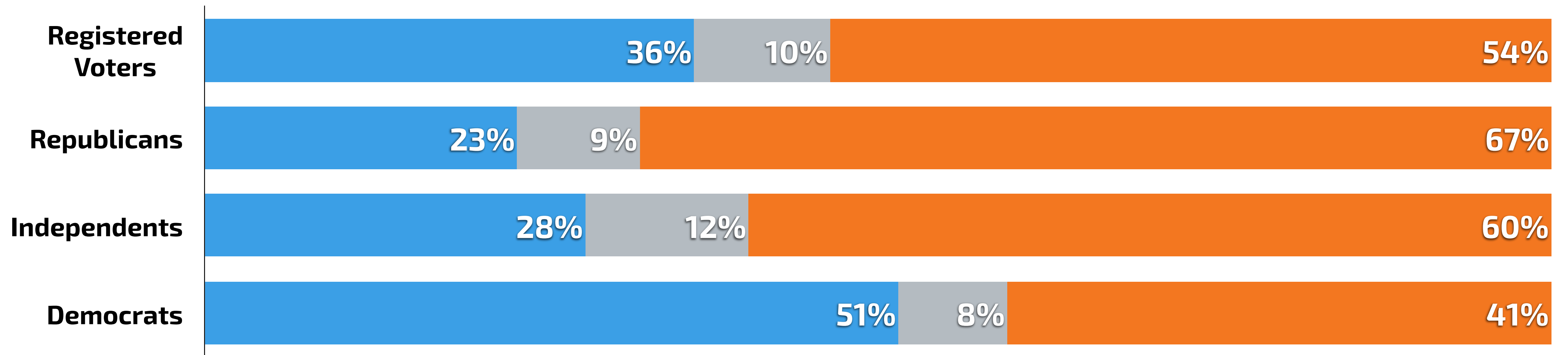


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Majority Of Voters Say COVID-19 Should Be Treated As Endemic

Q. Which of the following best describes how you think we should approach COVID-19 moving forward?

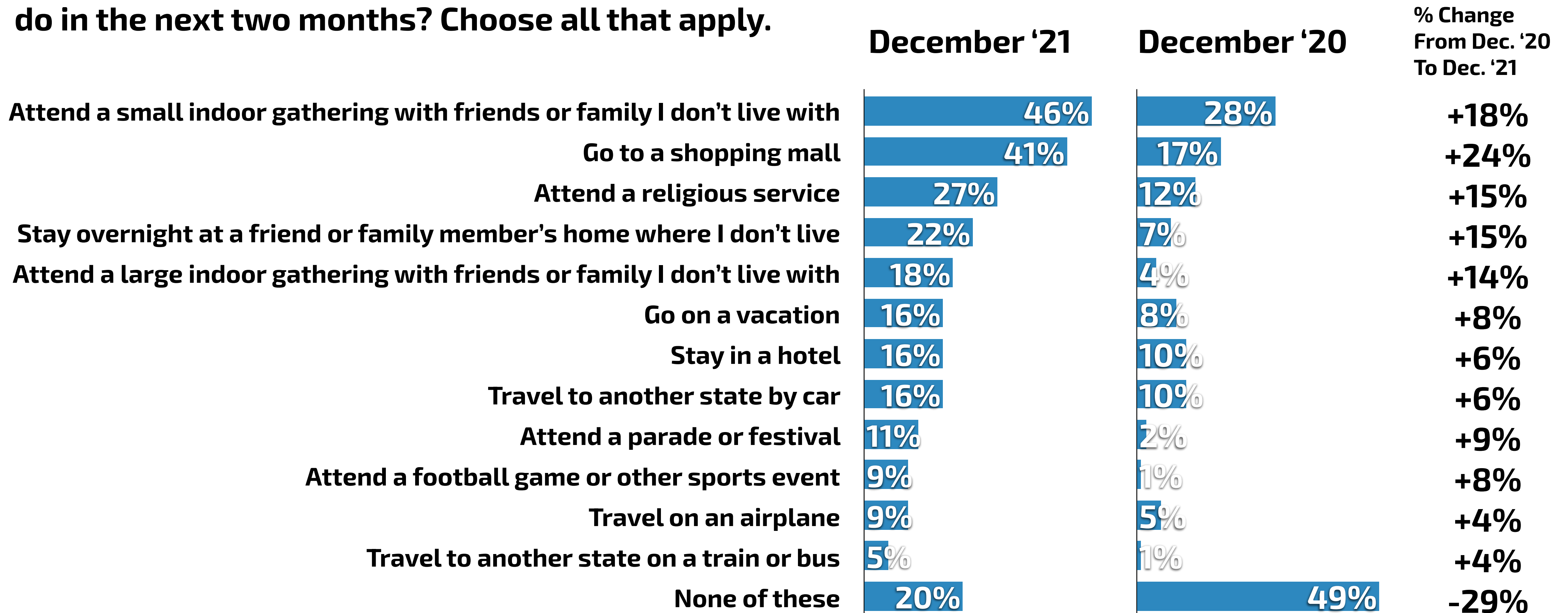

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Holiday Season Activities Up Across The Board Since Last Year

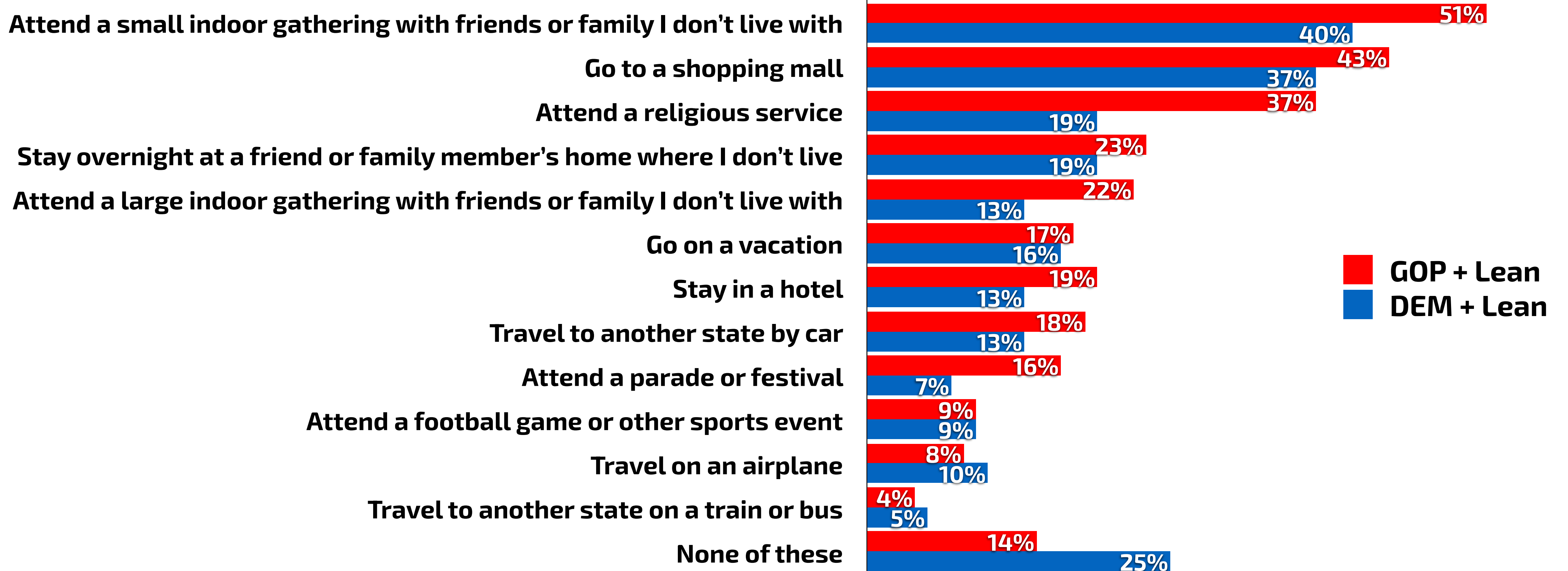
Q. Thinking about your plans for the upcoming holiday season, which of the following do you plan to do in the next two months? Choose all that apply.

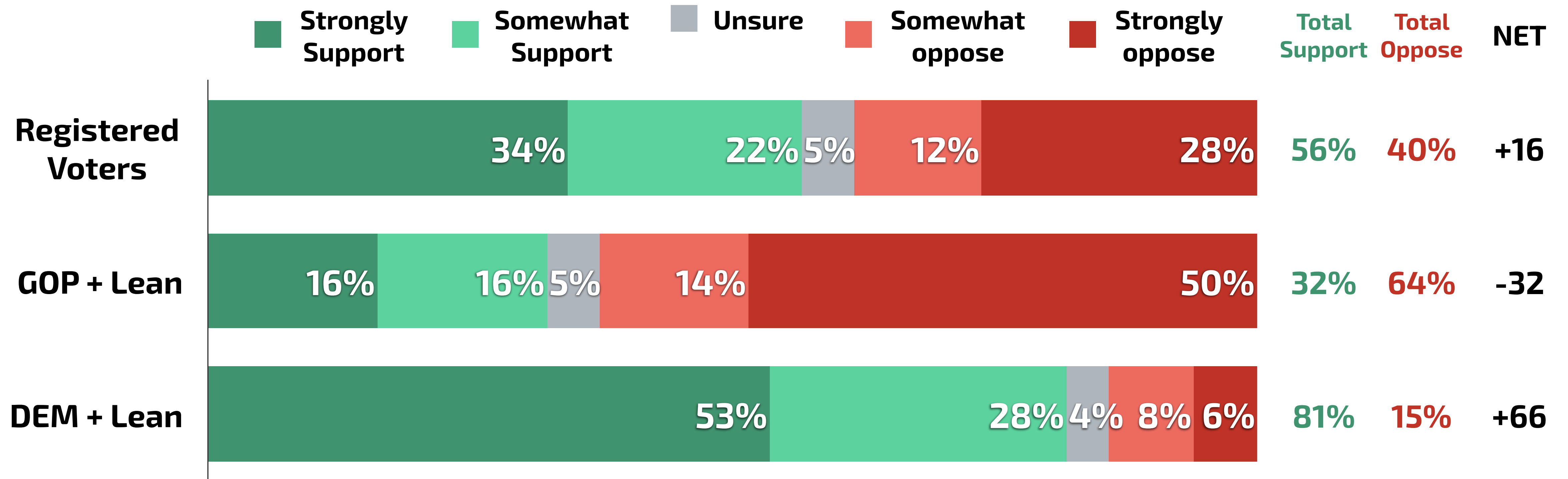

Strong Partisan Divide On Vaccine Mandate For Day-To-Day Activities

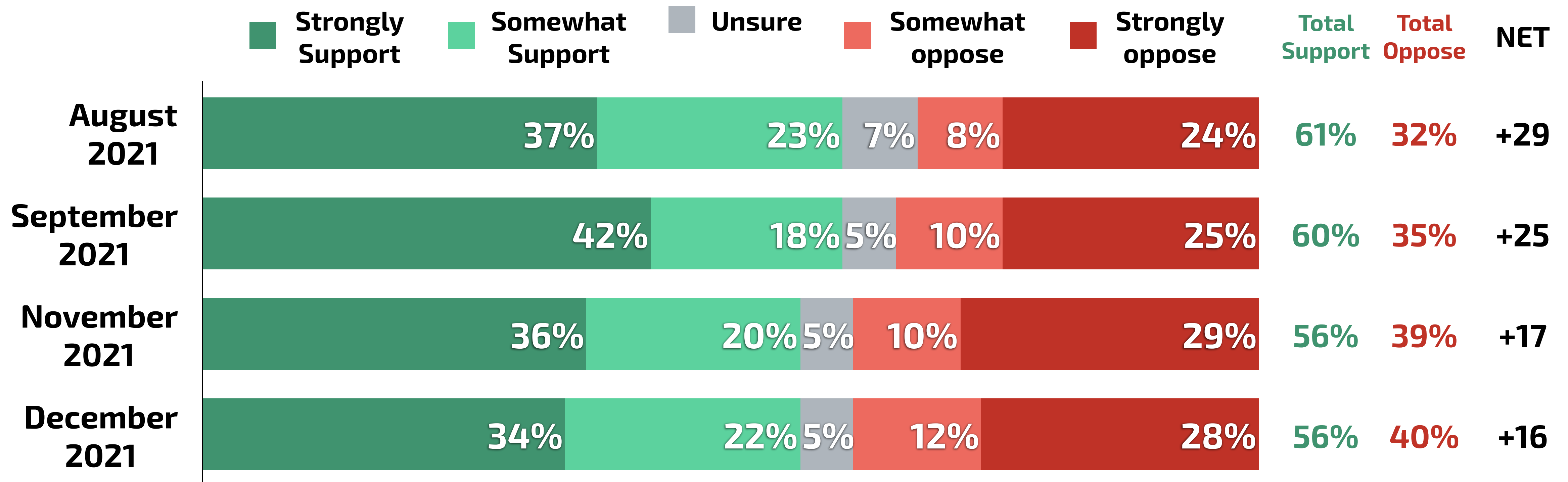
Q. Would you support or oppose mandating COVID-19 vaccines in order to do normal day-to-day activities again, like eating indoors at restaurants or going to the gym?

Q. Would you support or oppose mandating COVID-19 vaccines in order to do normal day-to-day activities again, like eating indoors at restaurants or going to the gym?

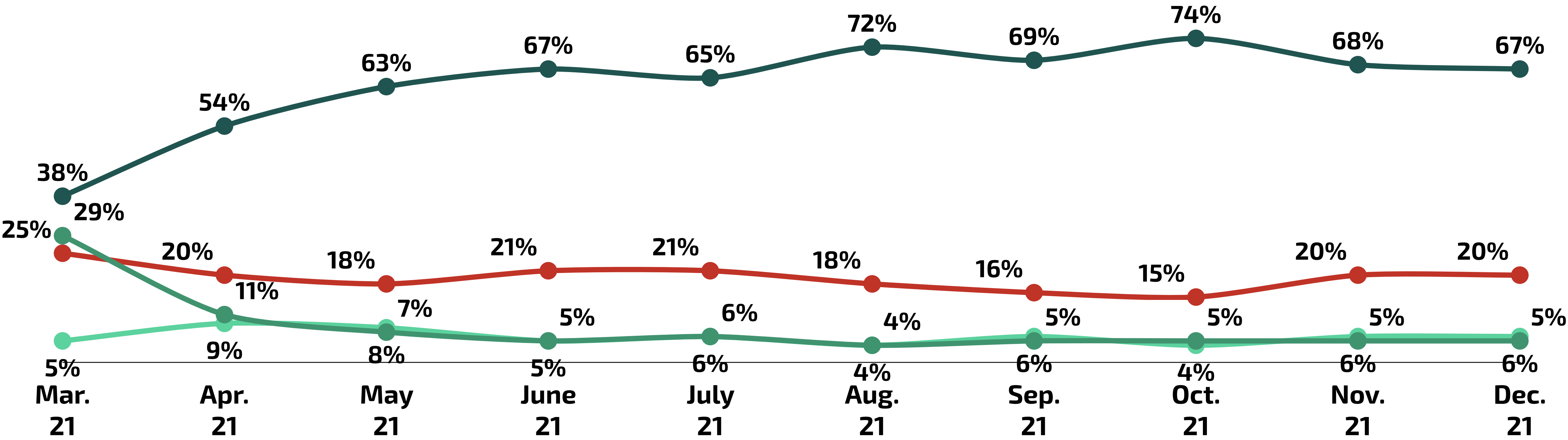


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Around 7 In 10 Voters Report Being Vaccinated

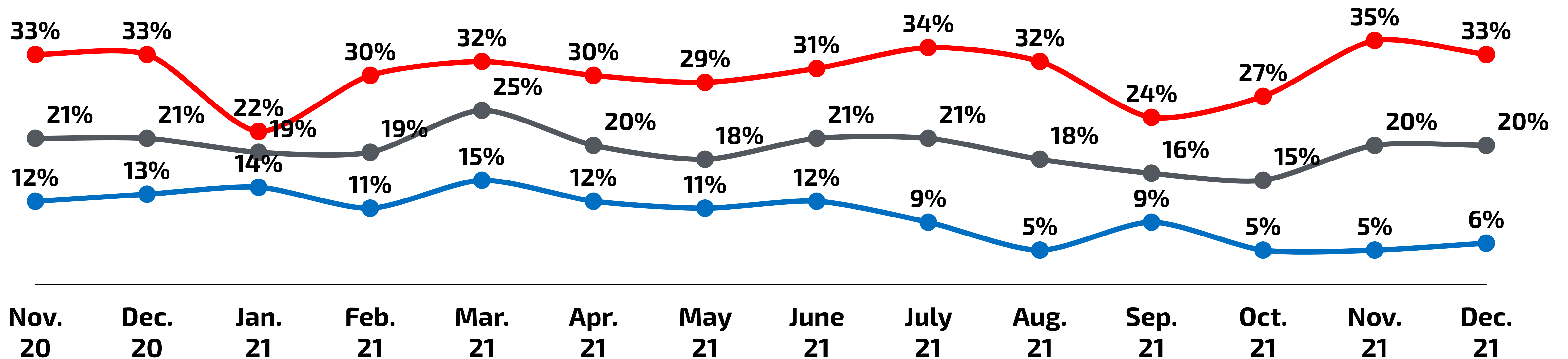
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Vaccine Refusal Among Republicans Ticks Down In December

● All Registered Voters ● Republicans ● Democrats



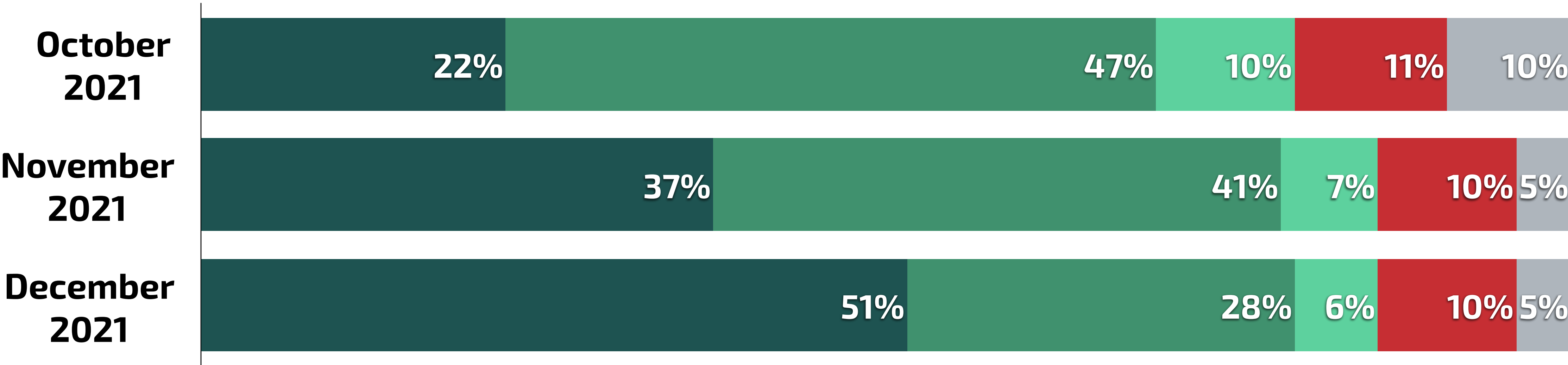

- Unsure

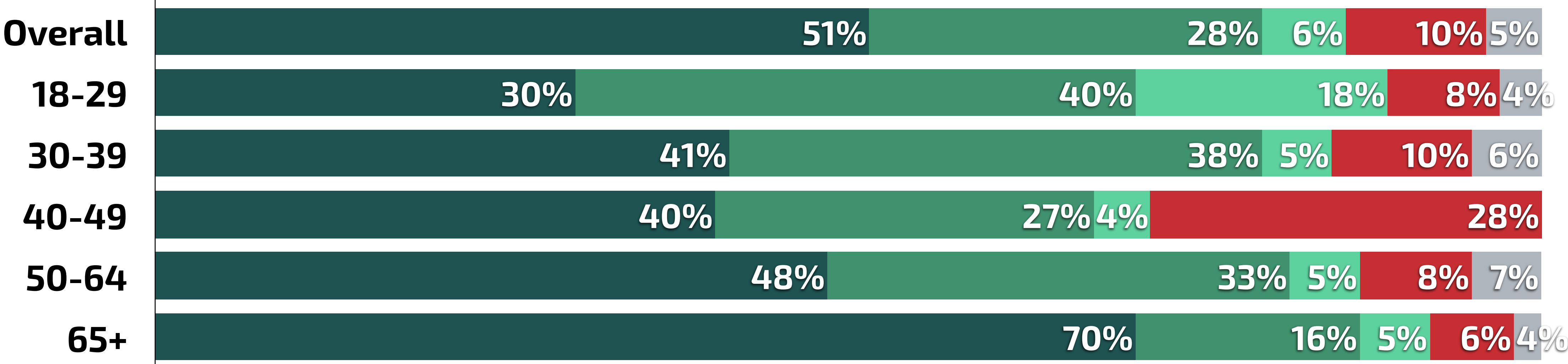


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7 In 10 Vaccinated Voters 65+ Have Received Booster

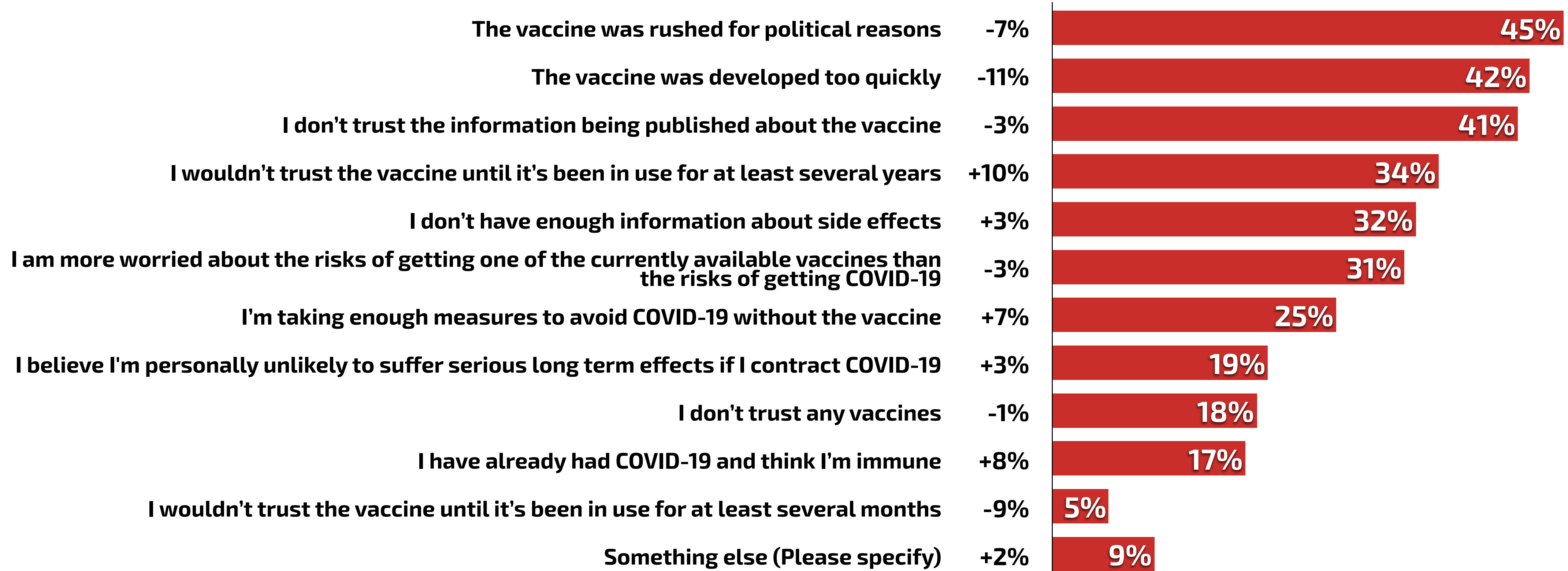


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Speed Of Vaccine Development, Rush For Political Reasons Top Reasons For Vaccine Hesitancy In December
