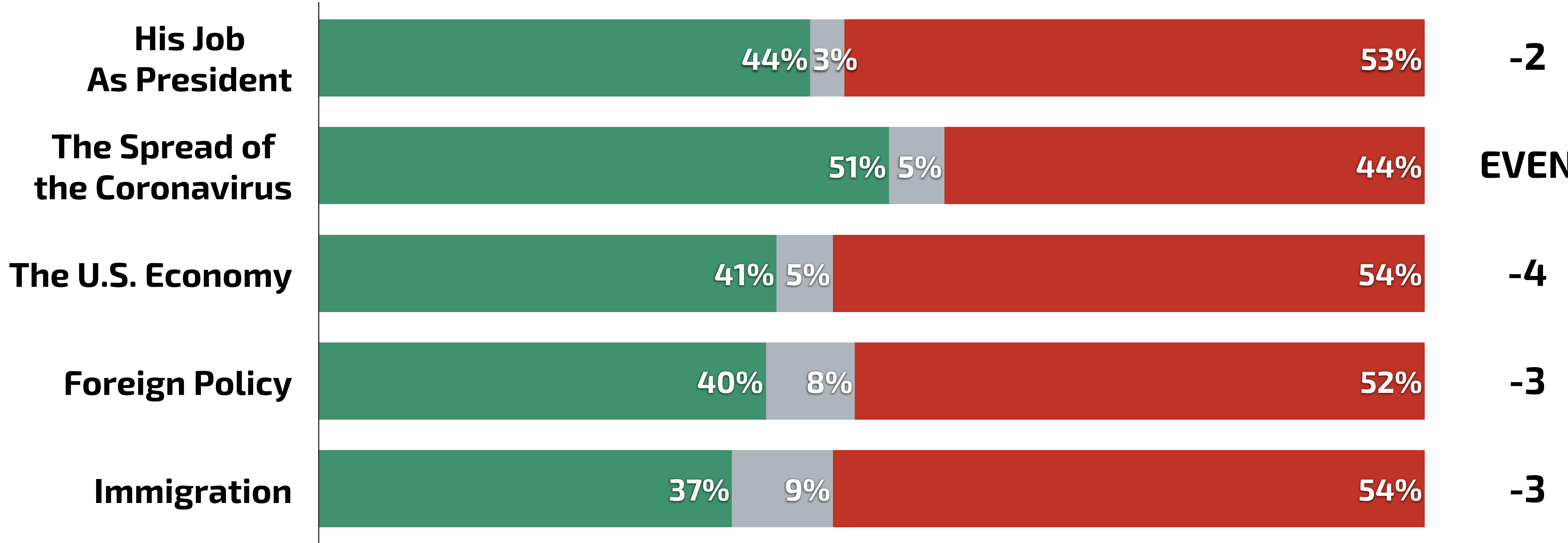

Approval Change From JANUARY

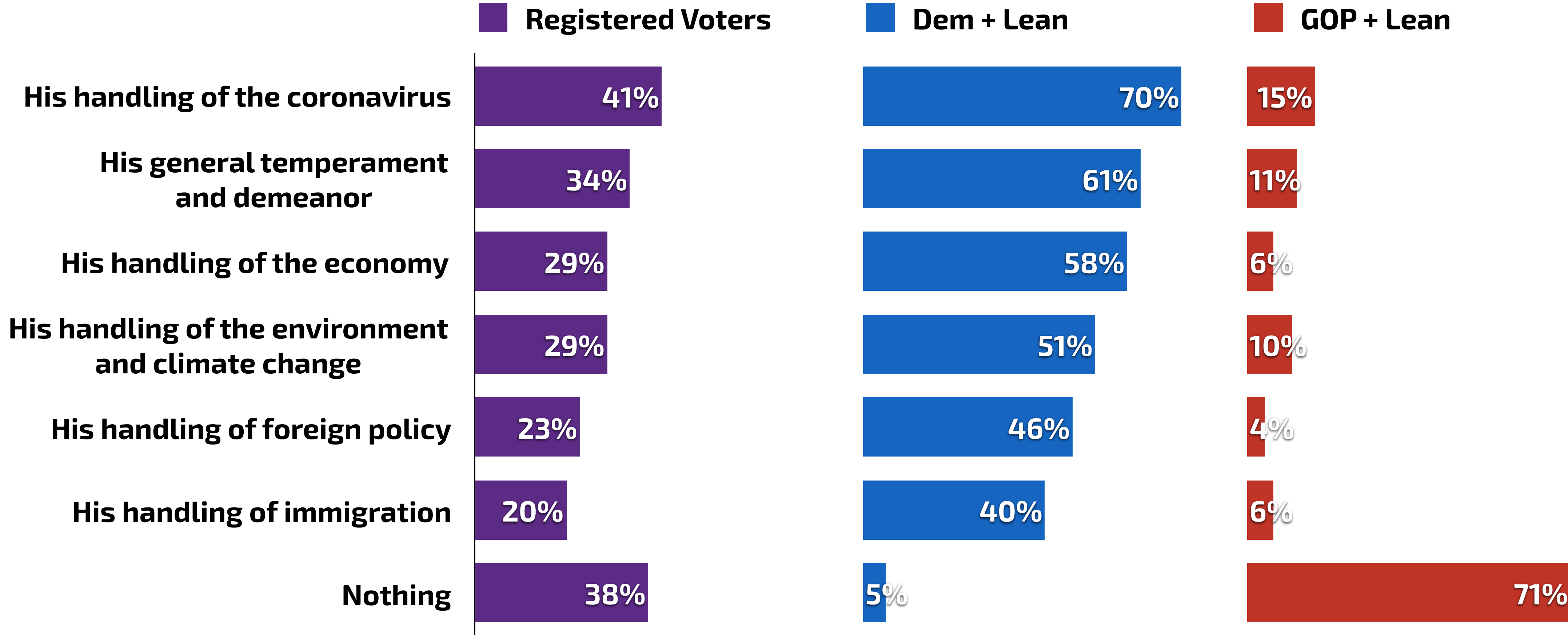

Q. What has Joe Biden done as president that you approve of? Choose all that apply.



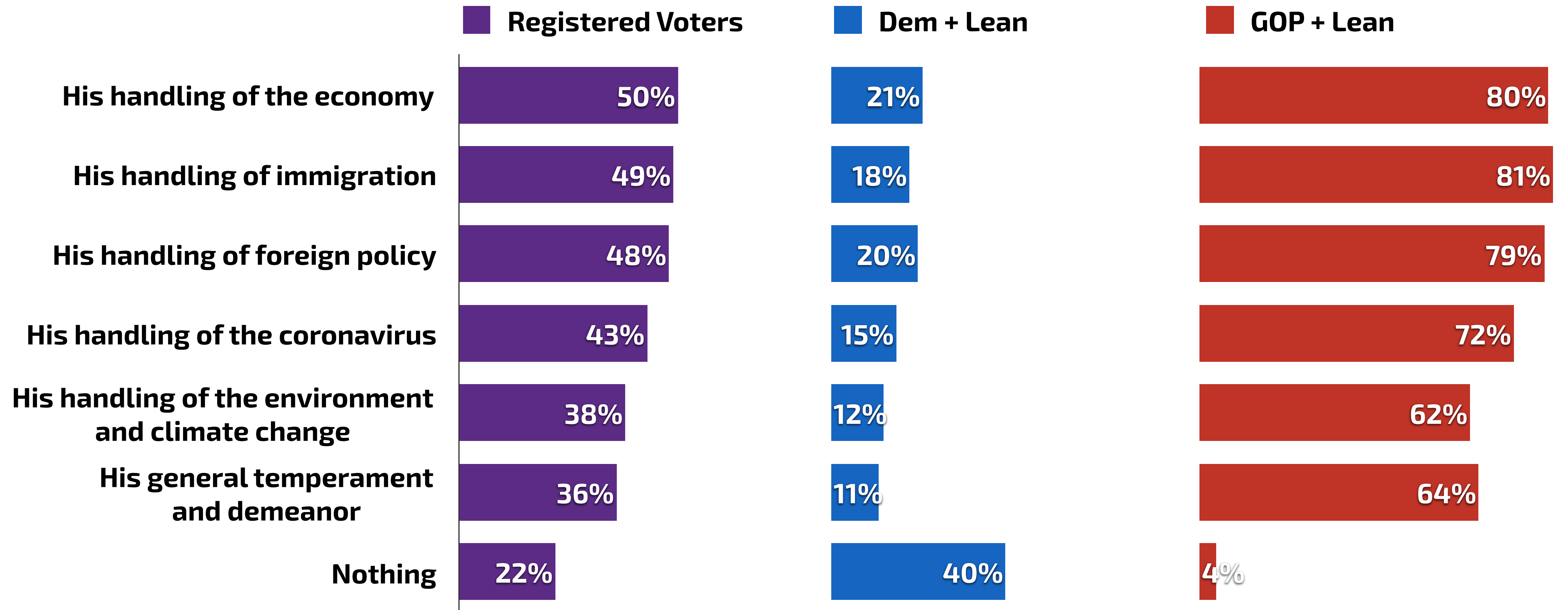

Q. What has Joe Biden done as president that you disapprove of? Choose all that apply.



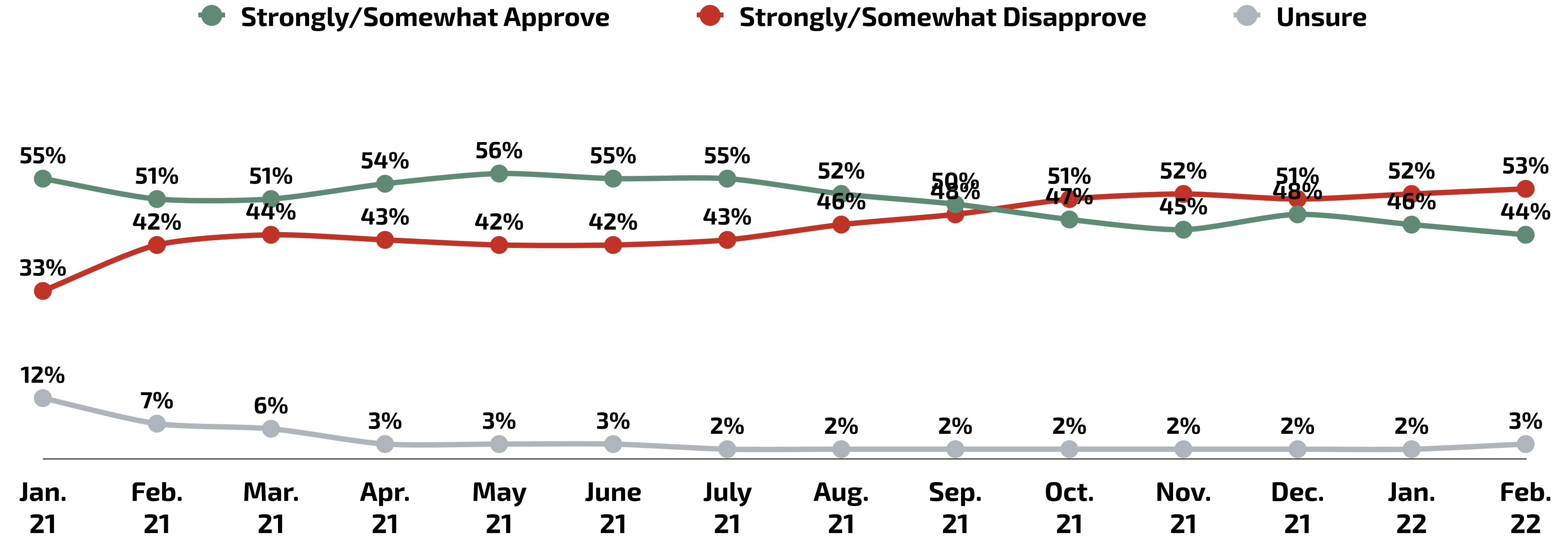

Biden Job Approval Reaches Low Of Presidency

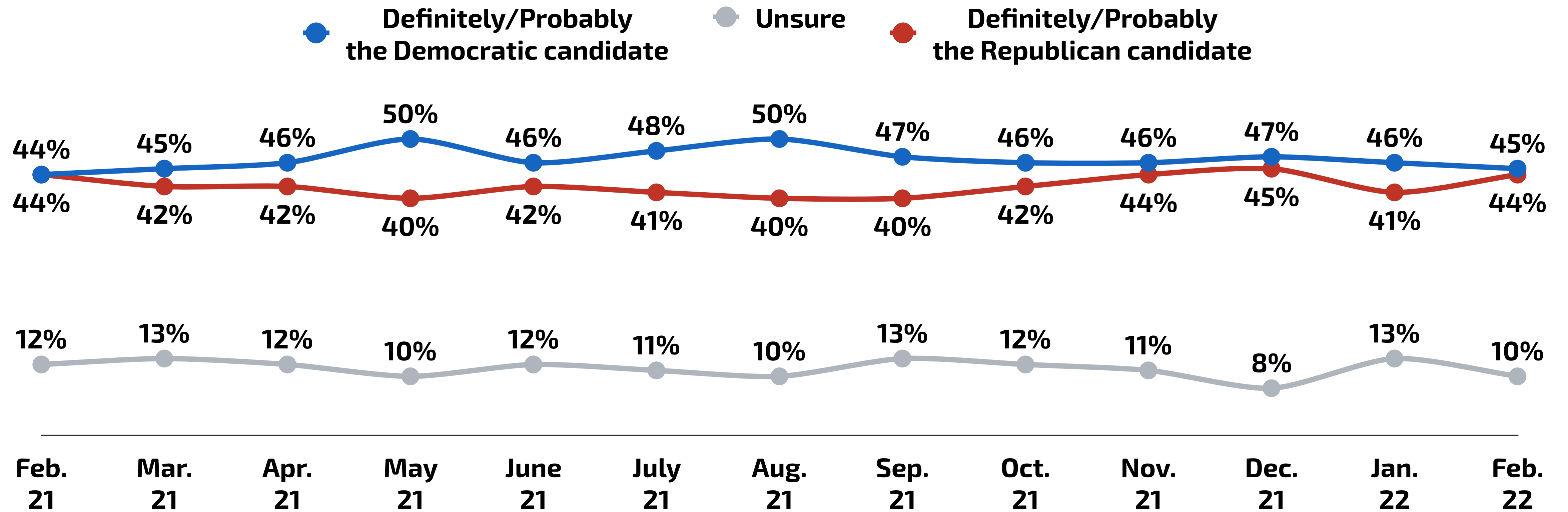

Republicans Gain Ground On Generic Ballot

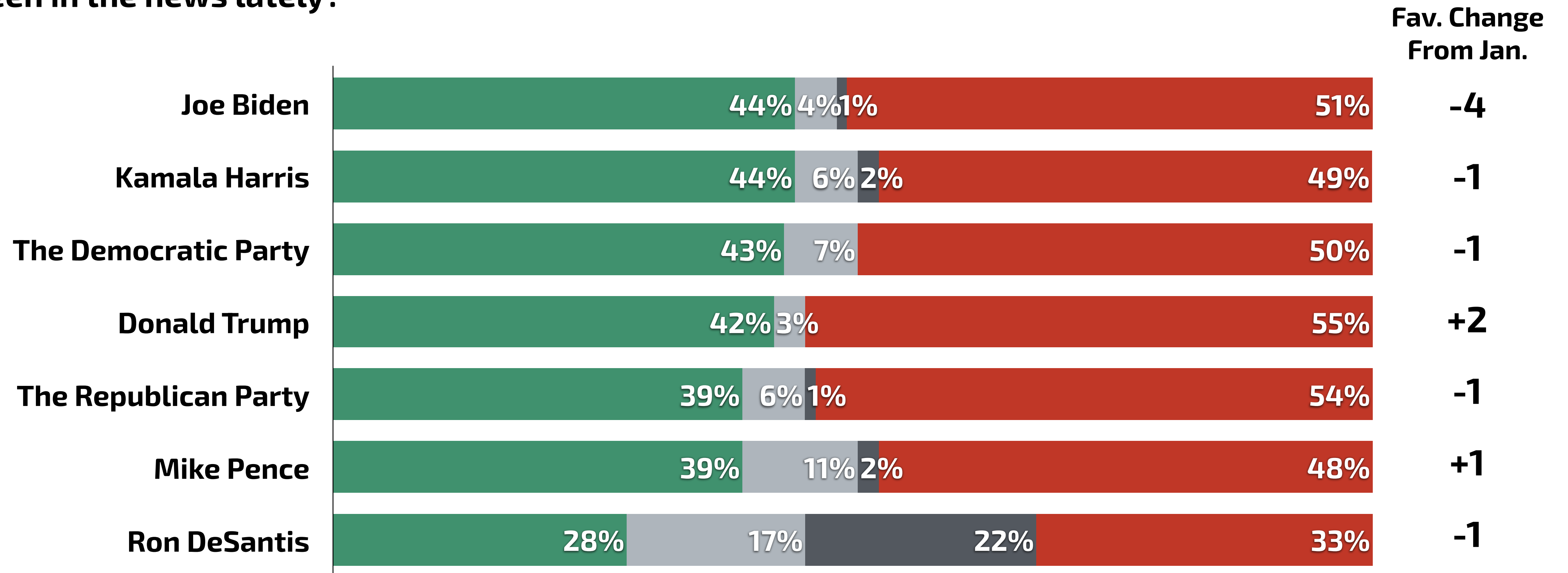
Q. If the election for Congress were held today and you had to make a choice, for whom would you vote?

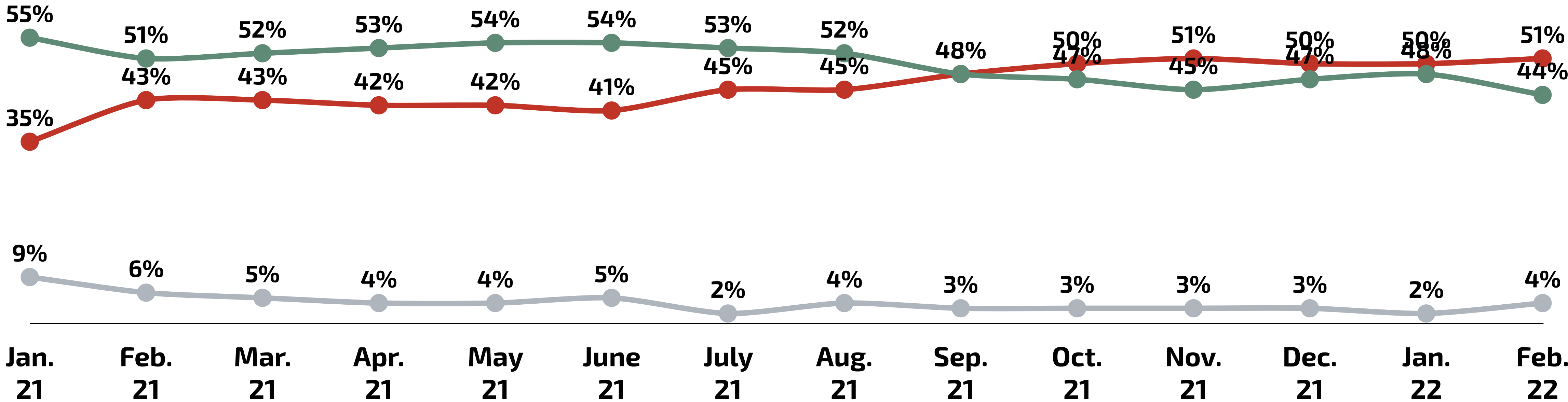

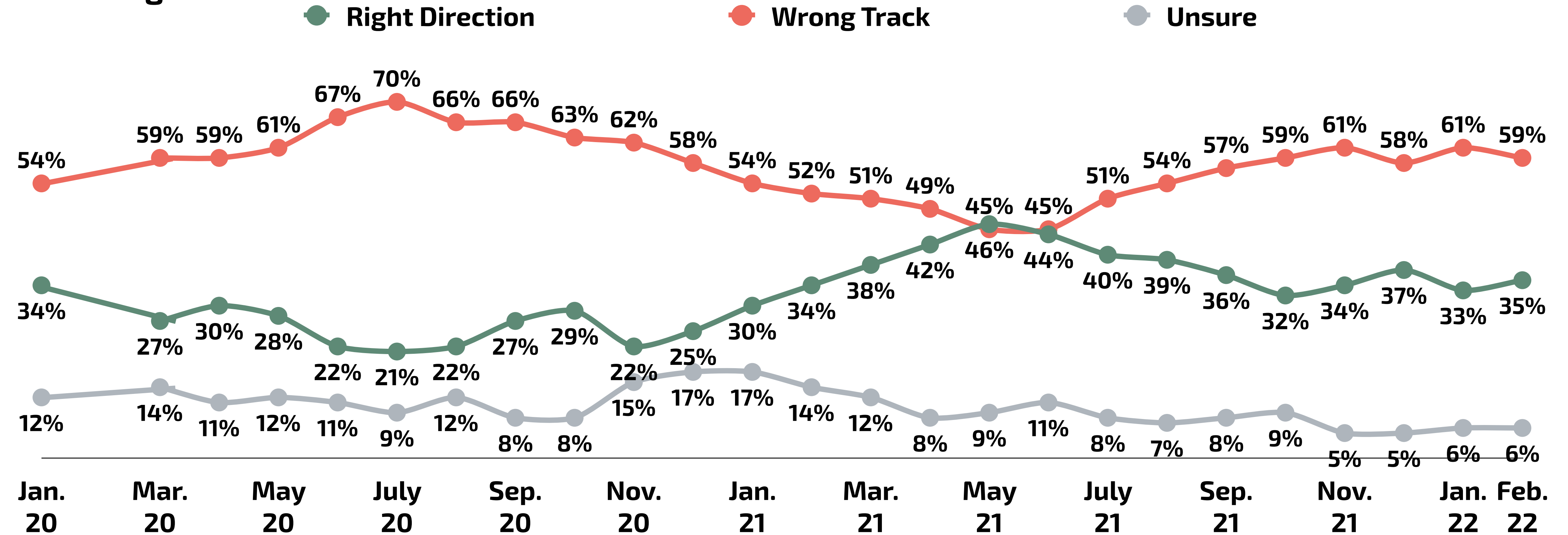

6 In 10 Say That The Country Is On The Wrong Track

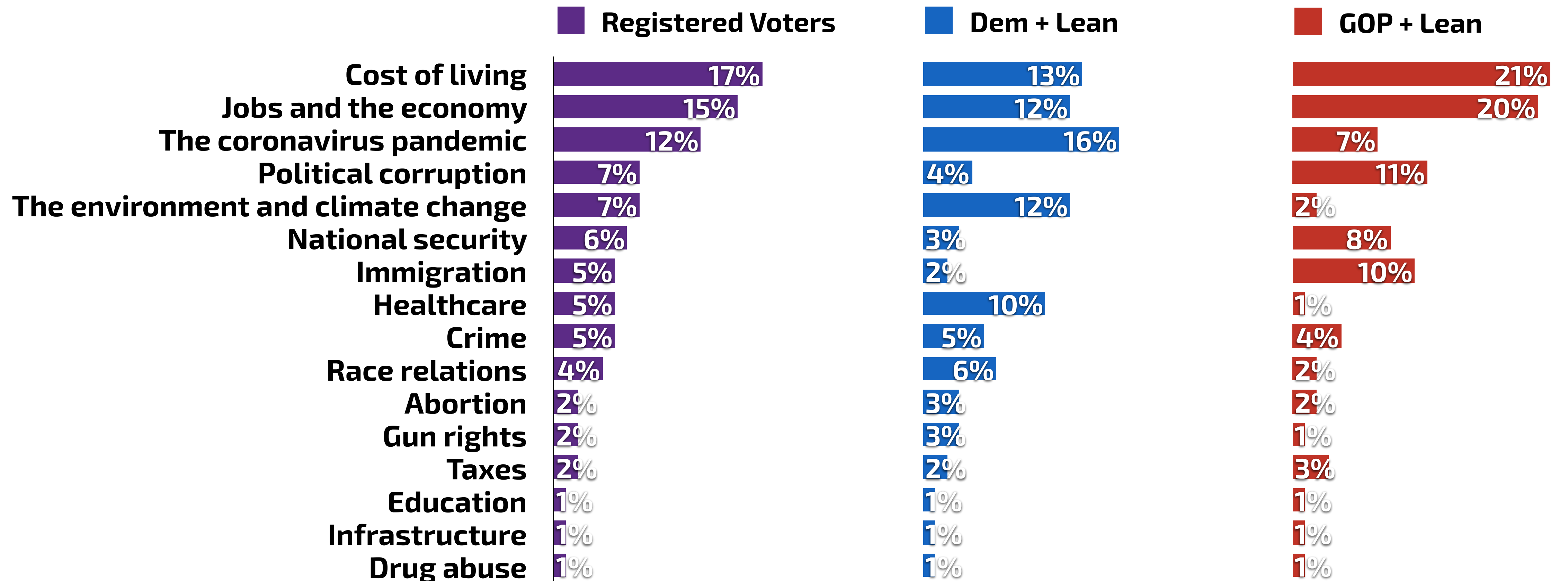
Q. Would you say things in the United States are headed in the right direction, or is the country off on the wrong track?

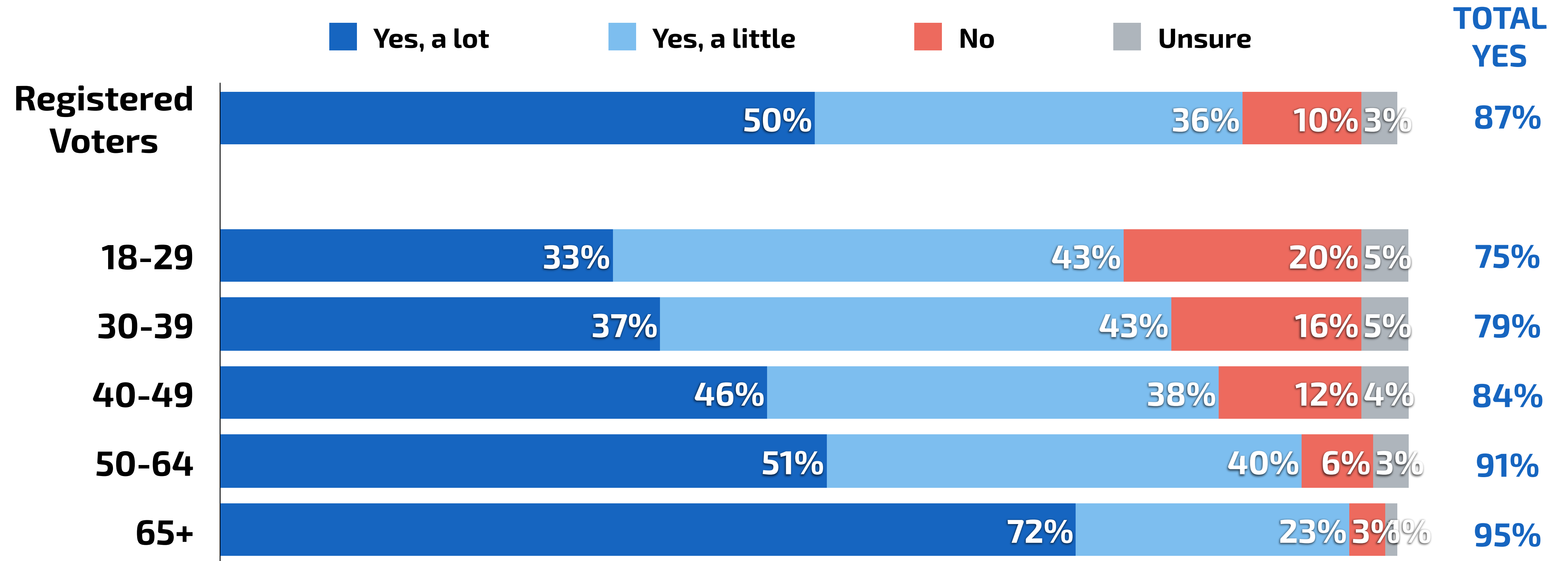

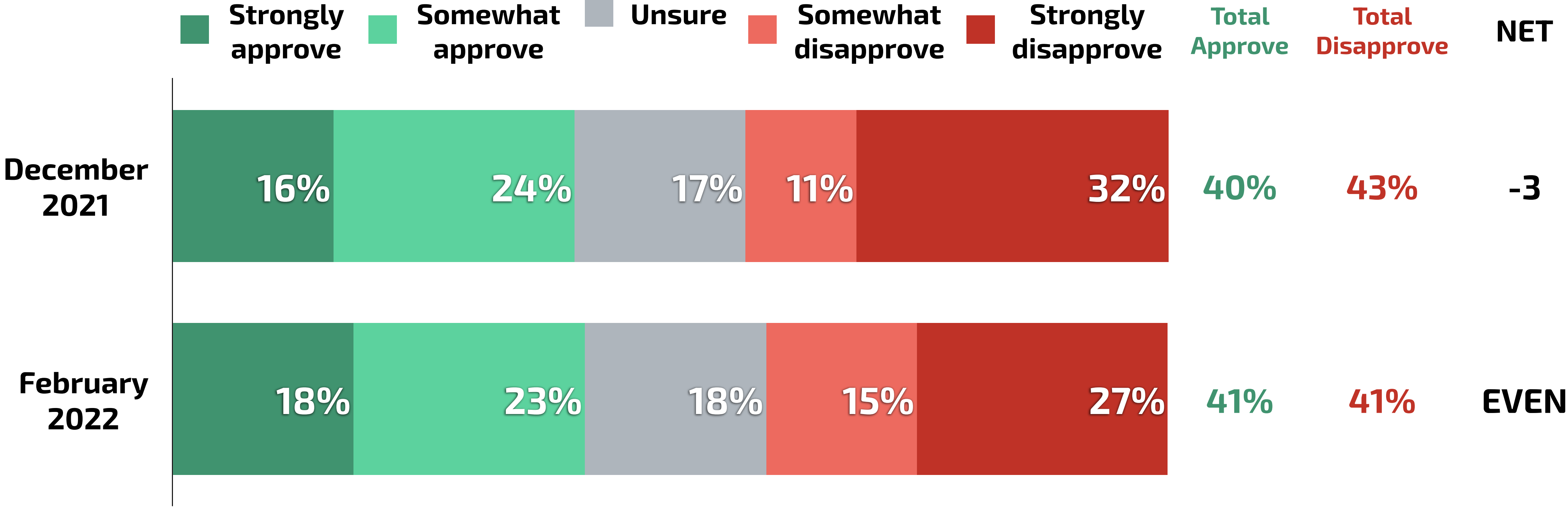

Voters Split On Biden's Handling Of Russia-Ukraine Situation

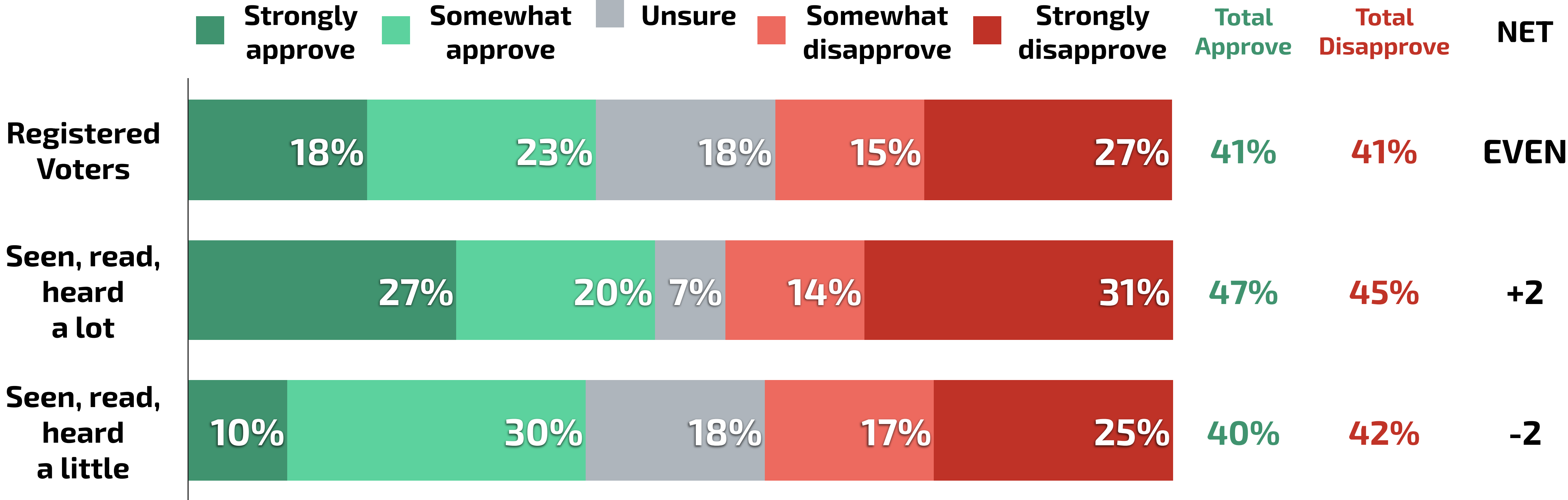
Q. Do you approve or disapprove of the way Joe Biden is handling the situation involving Russia and Ukraine?

Those Paying Close Attention More Approving Of Biden's Handling Of Russia-Ukraine Situation

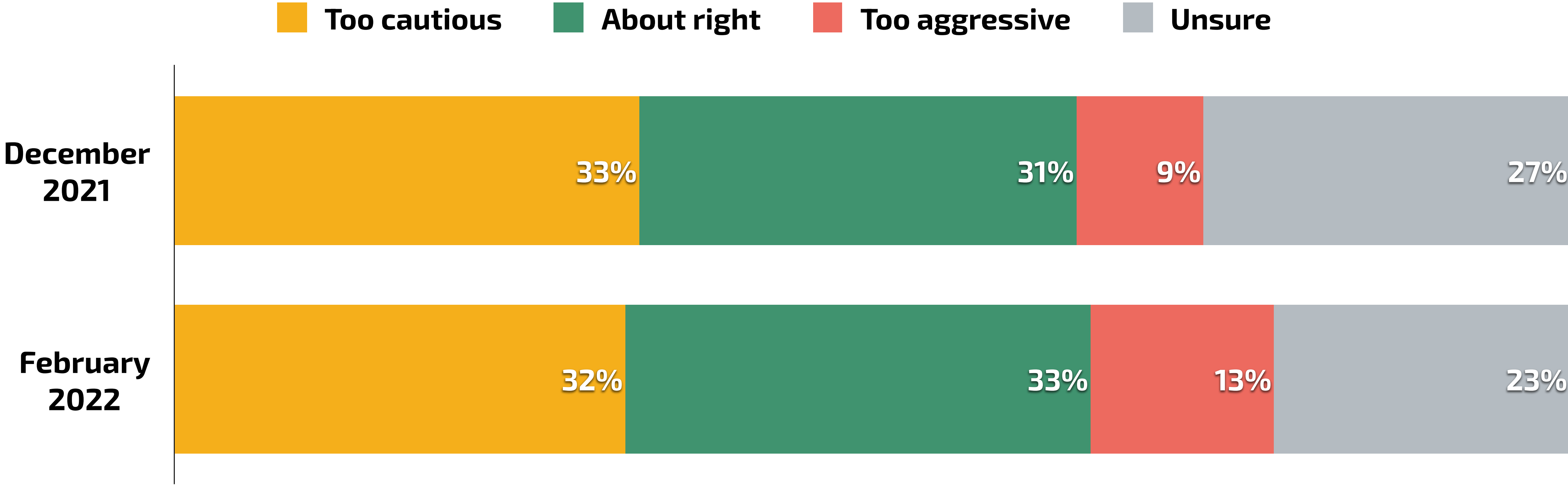

More Say Biden Has Too Cautious Than Too Aggressive

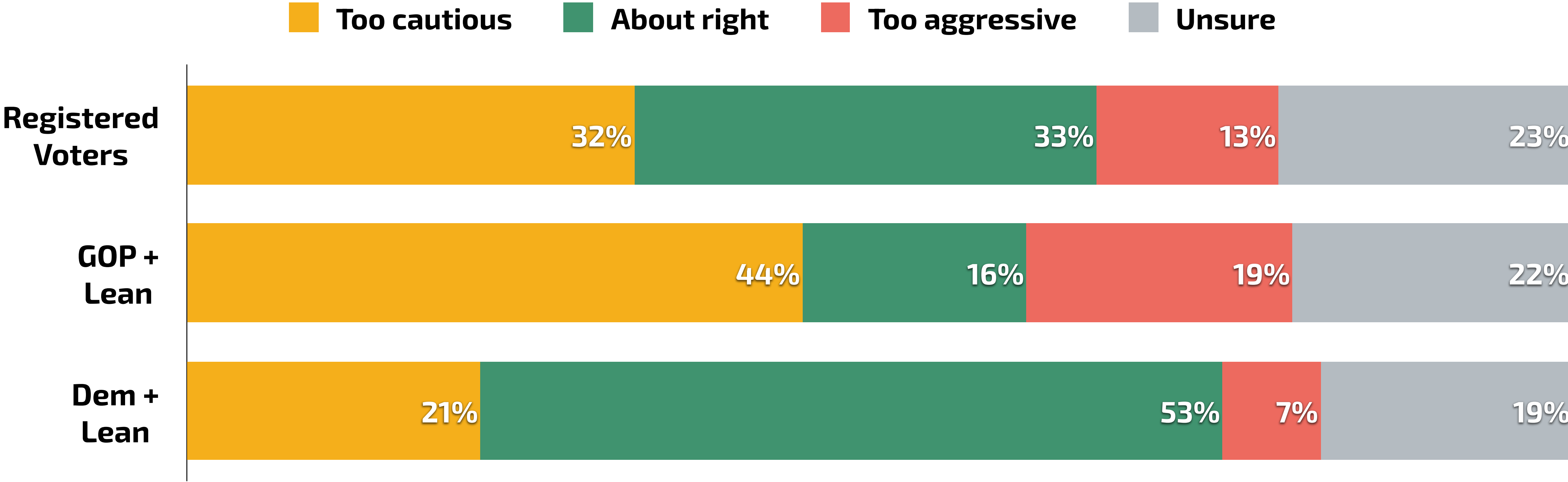
Q. In dealing with the situation involving Russia and Ukraine, do you feel that Joe Biden has been too cautious, too aggressive, or has he handled this about right?

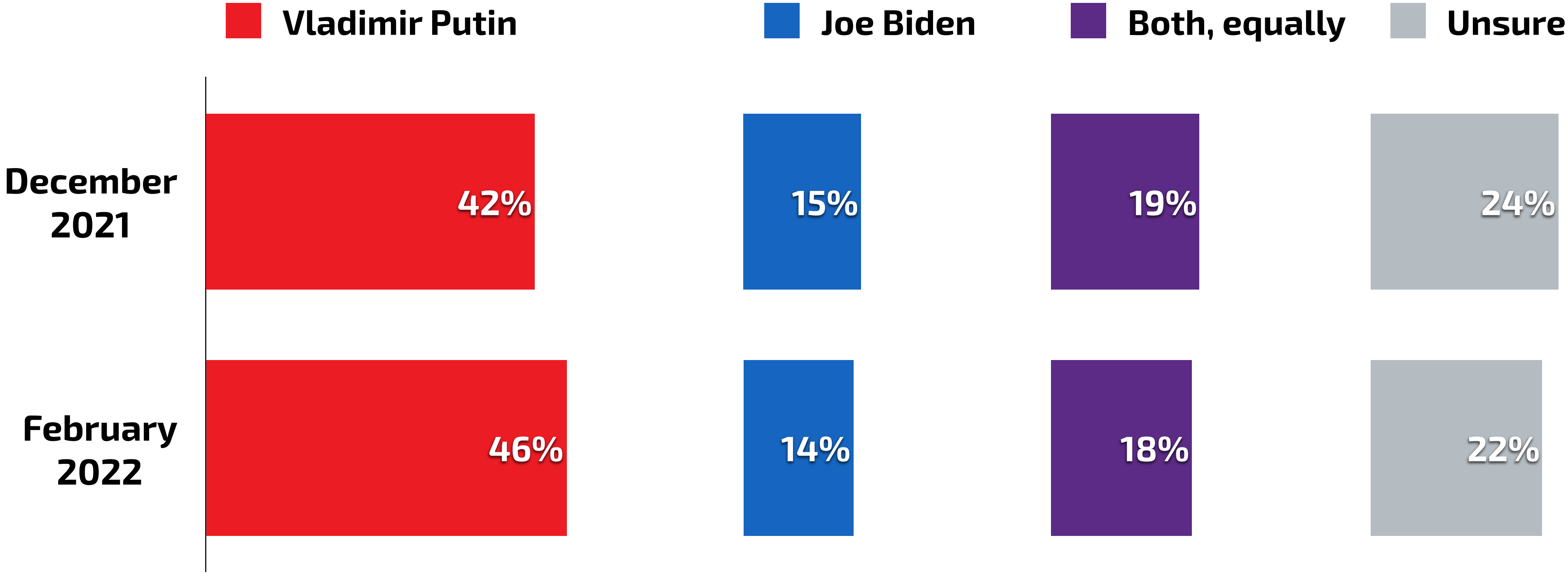

Plurality Of Voters Say Putin Has Upper Hand Over Biden On Russia-Ukraine Situation

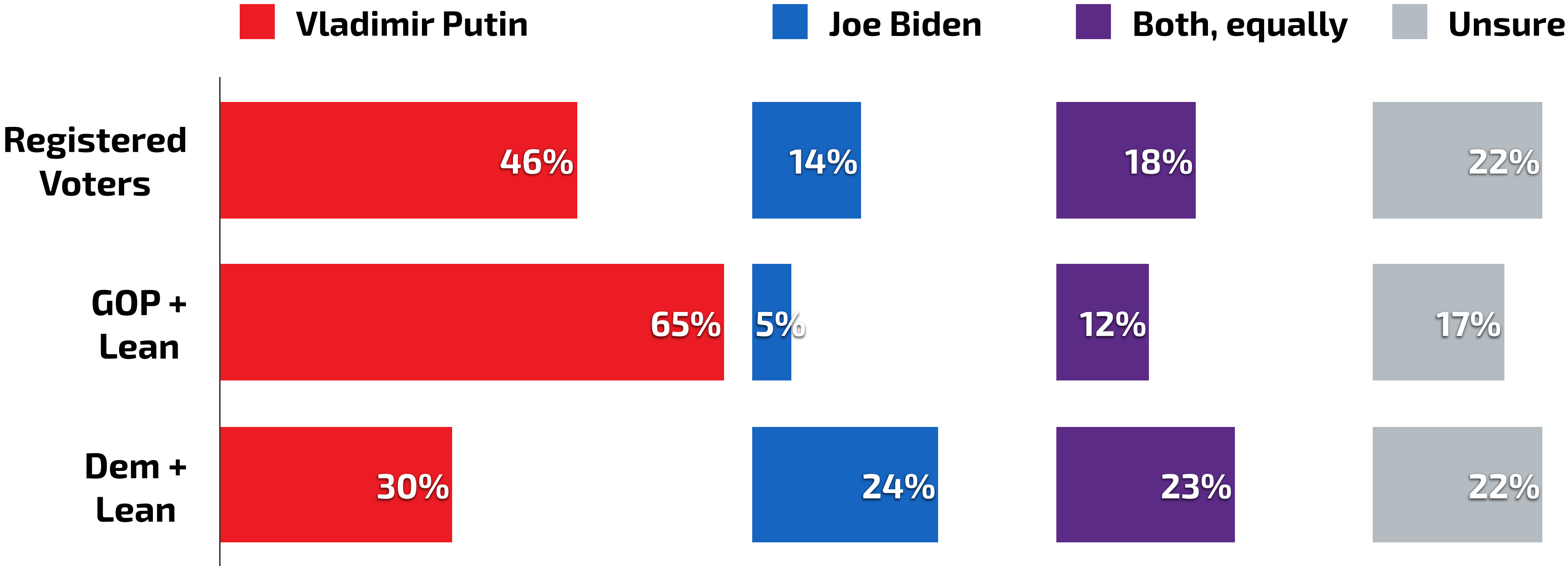
Q. Who do you think has the upper hand in the situation involving Russia and Ukraine?

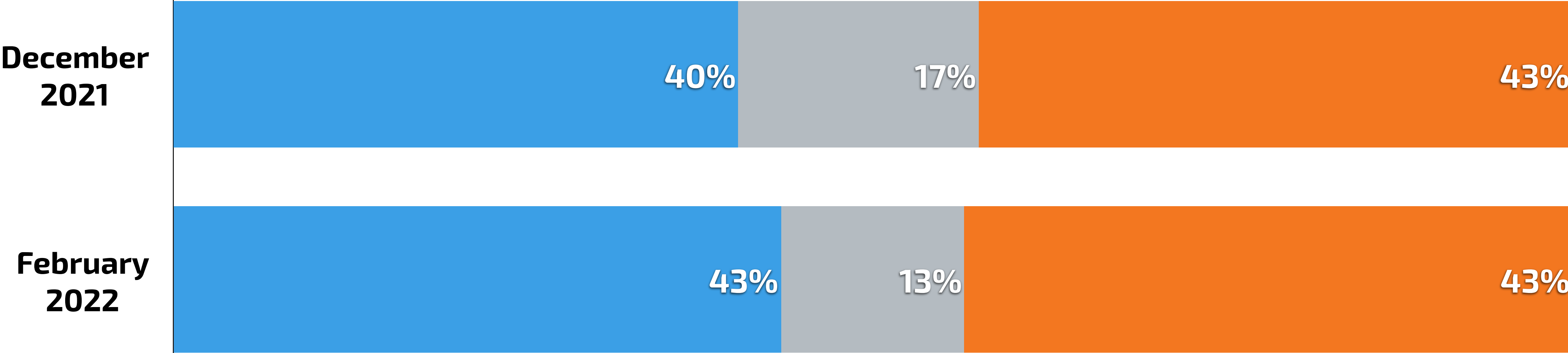
Voters Split On US Responsibility To Defend Ukraine

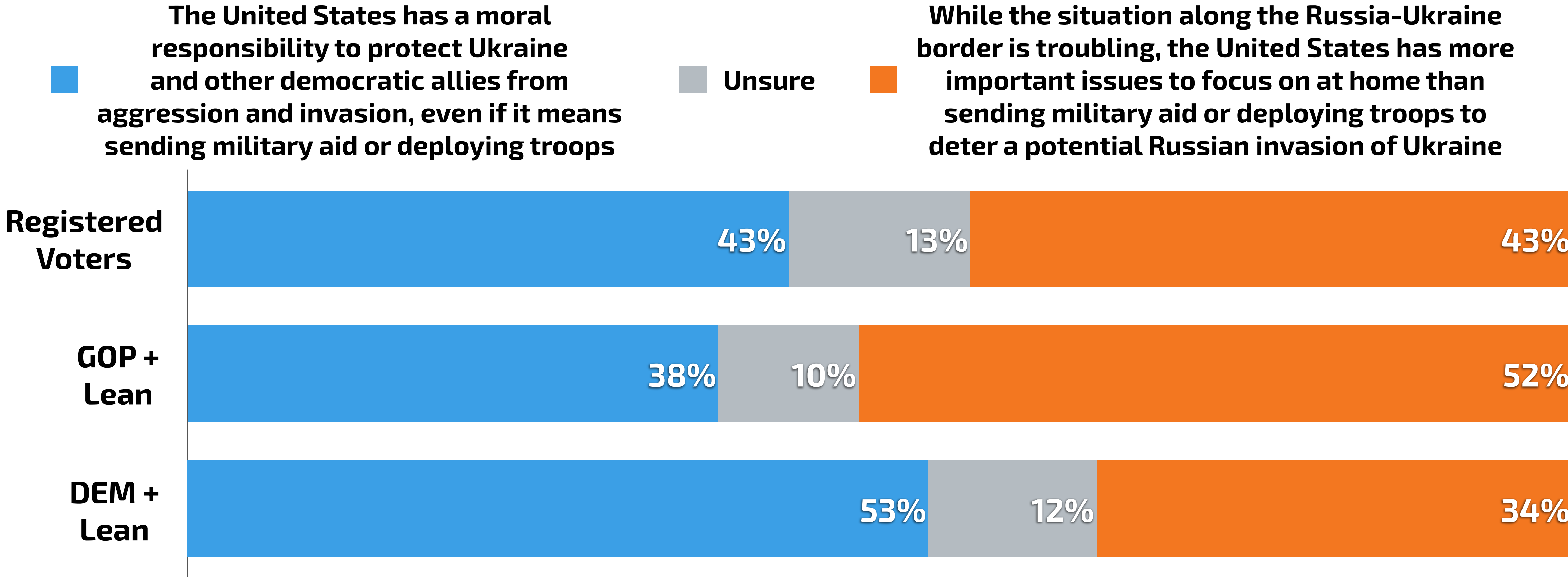

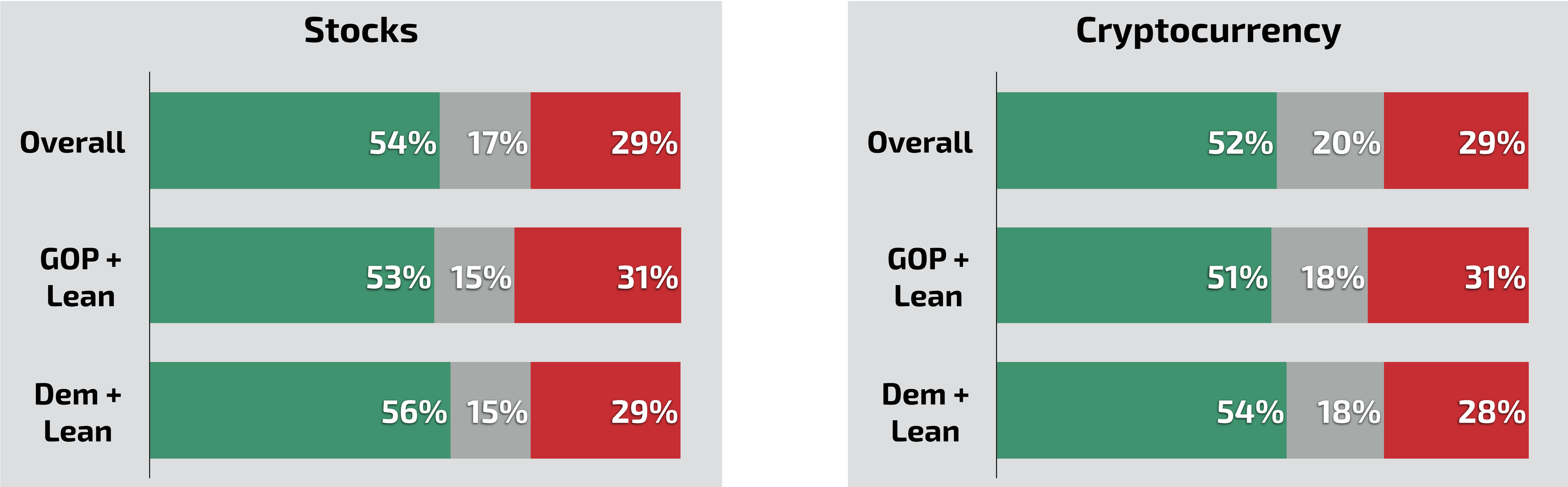

Q. Do you support or oppose banning Members of Congress from actively trading ... while in office?

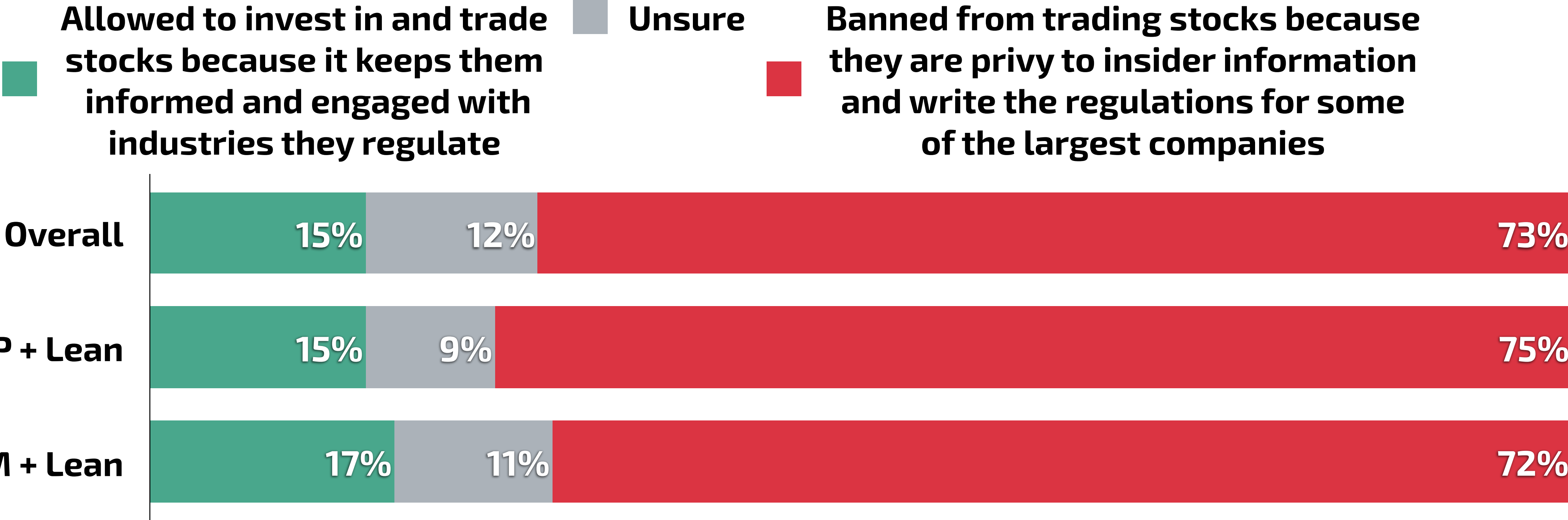

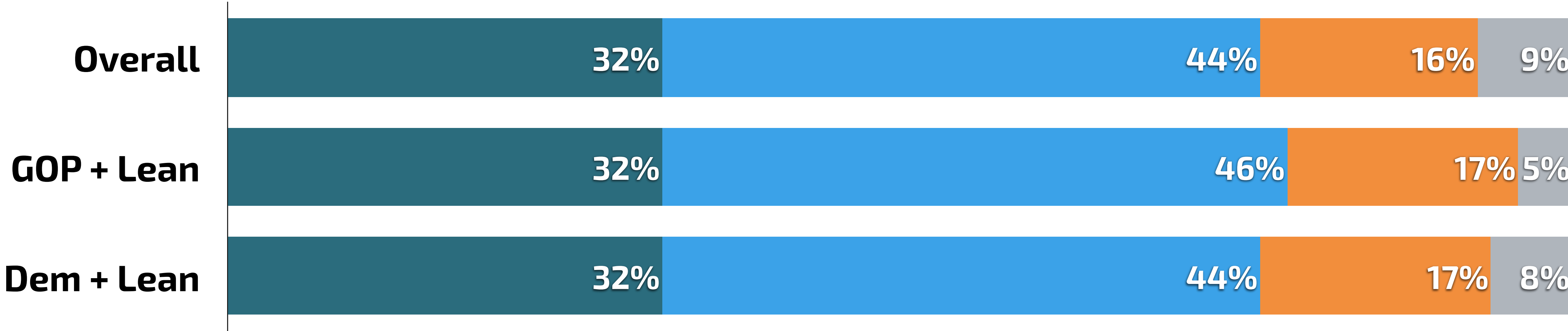

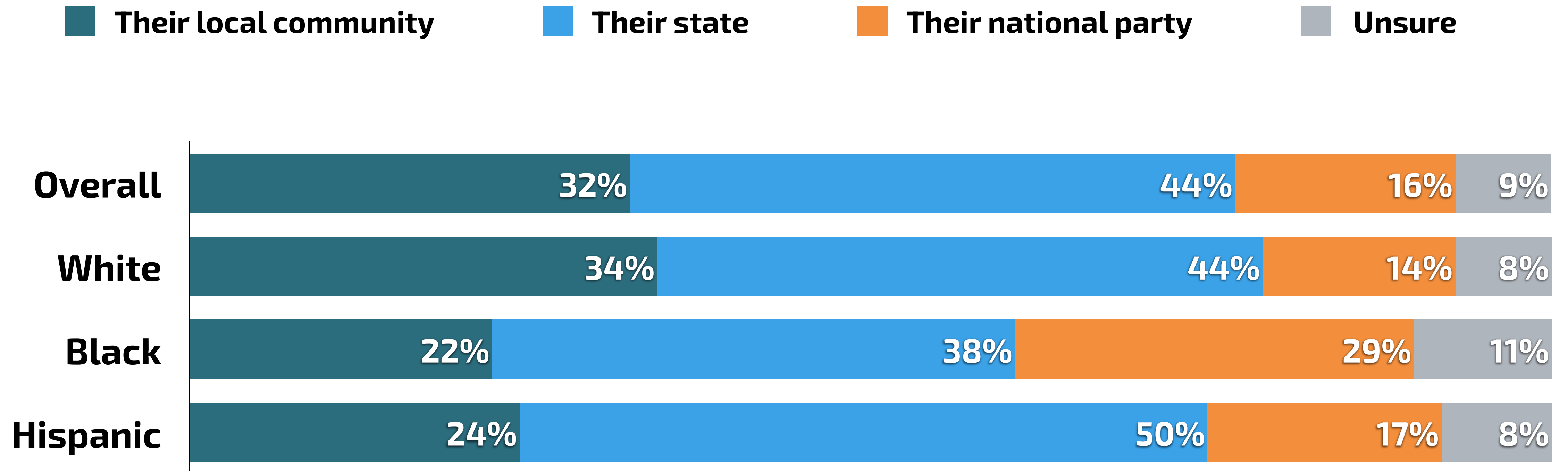

Black Voters Most Interested In Members Representing Views Of The Party Overall

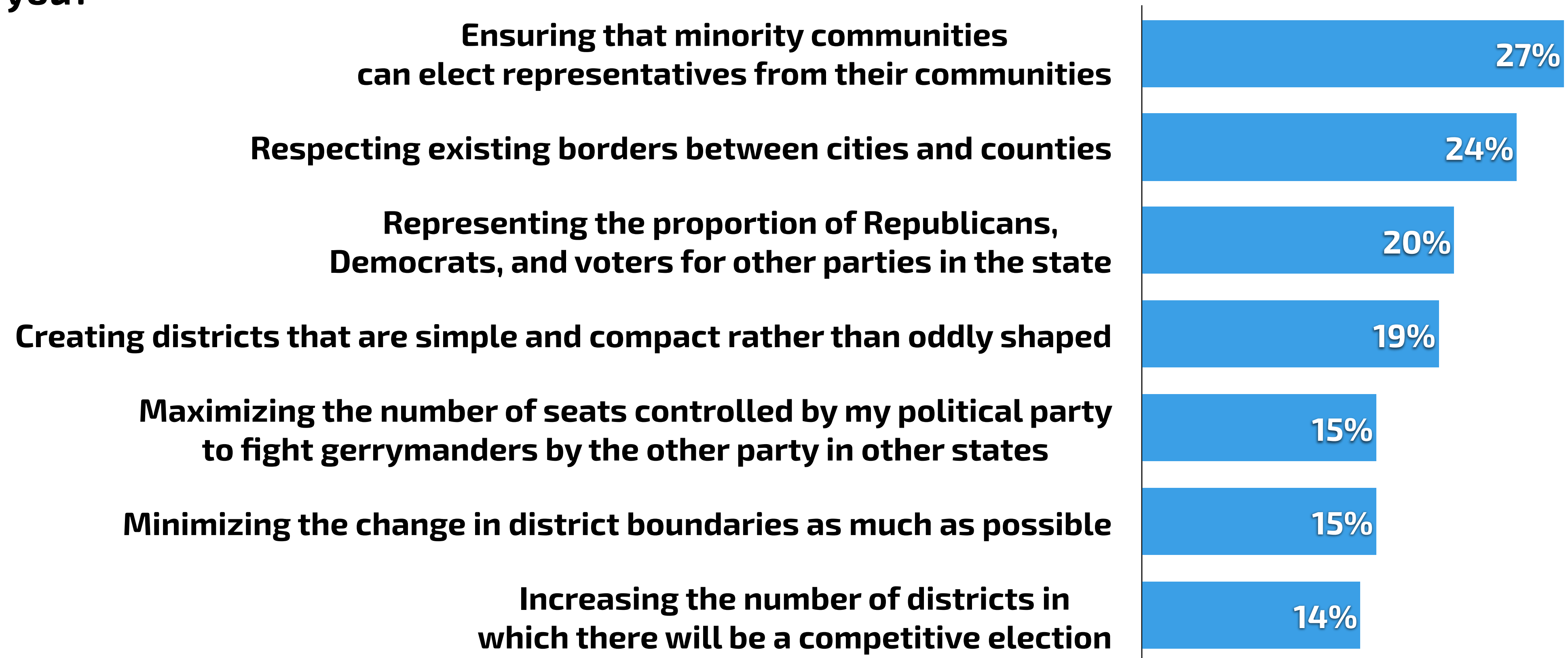

Q. When new congressional districts are drawn, which of the following goals are most important to you?

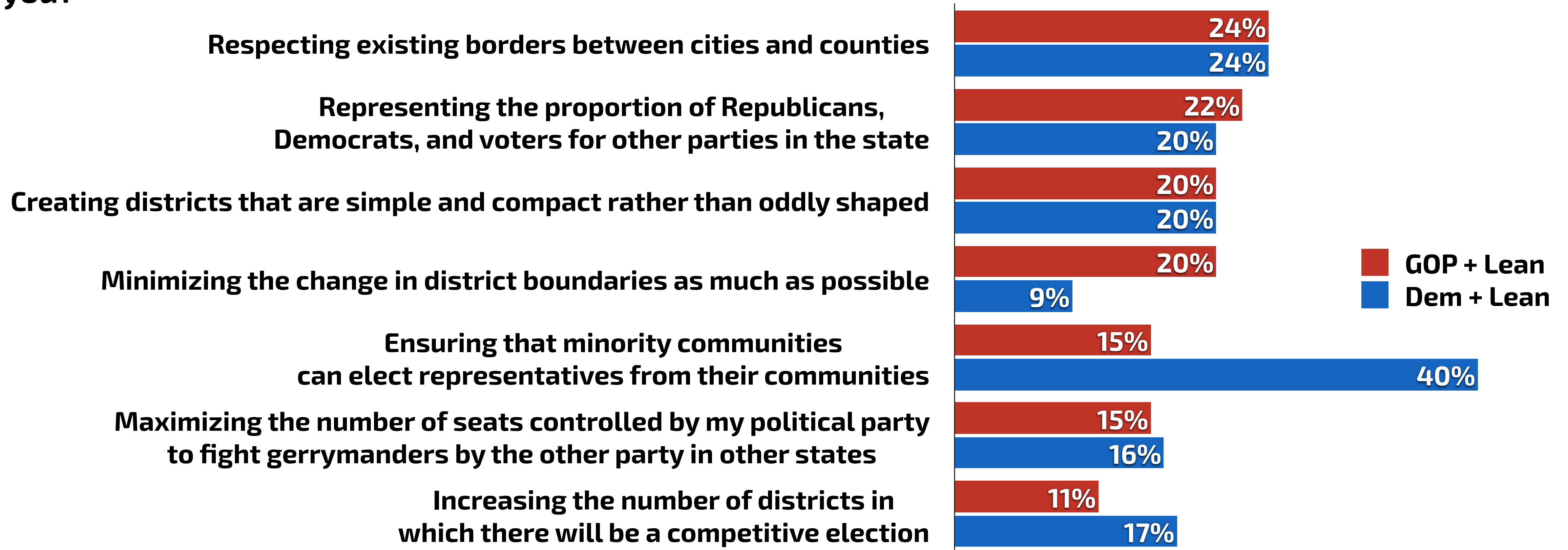

Q. When new congressional districts are drawn, which of the following goals are most important to you?



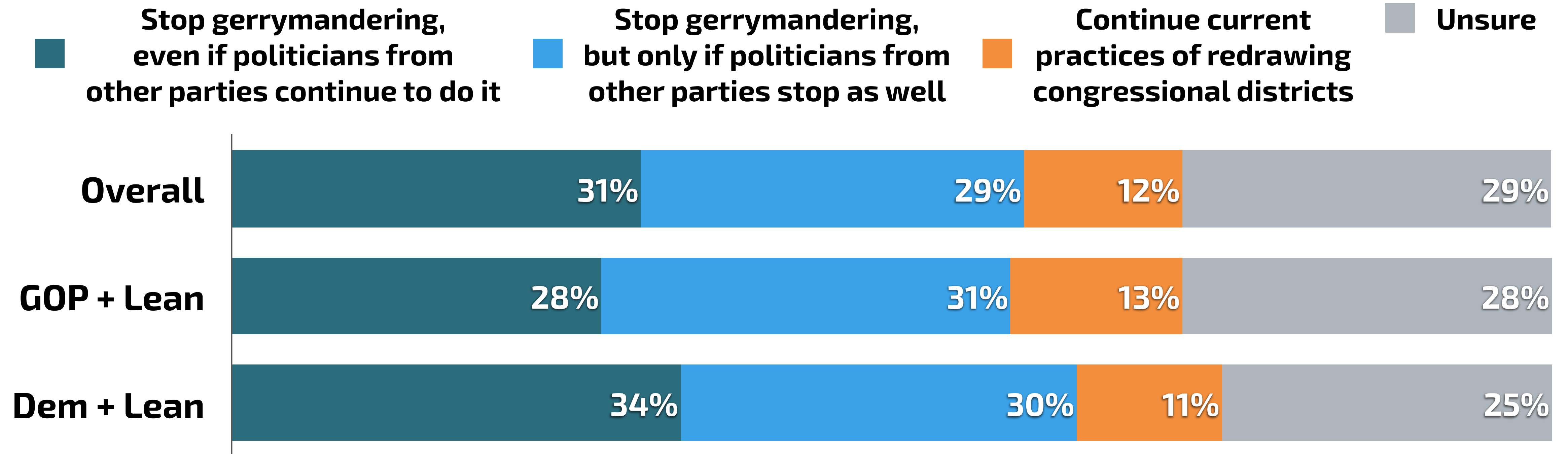

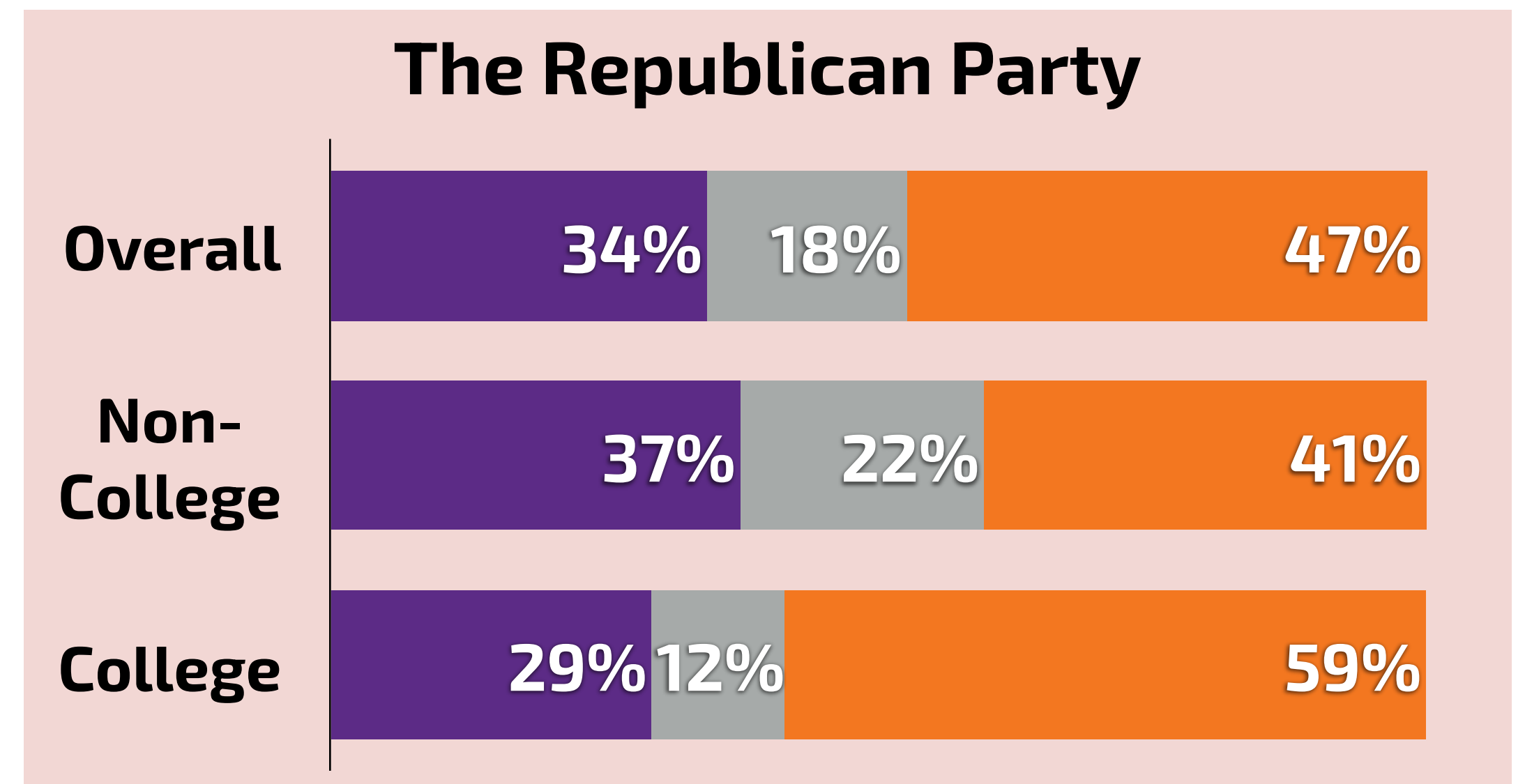
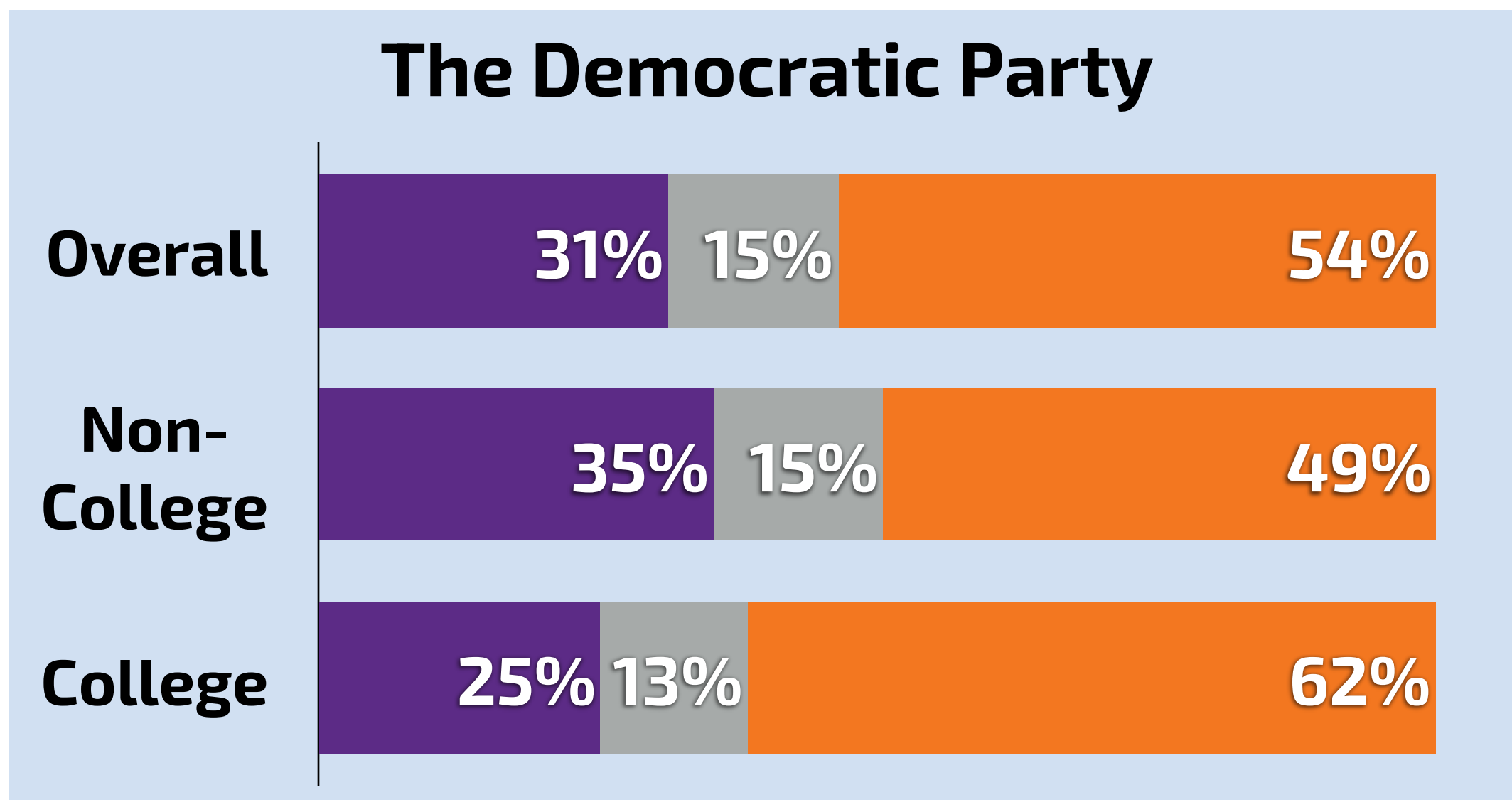
More GOP, Dems Say Party Should Draw Proportionally Representative Seats
