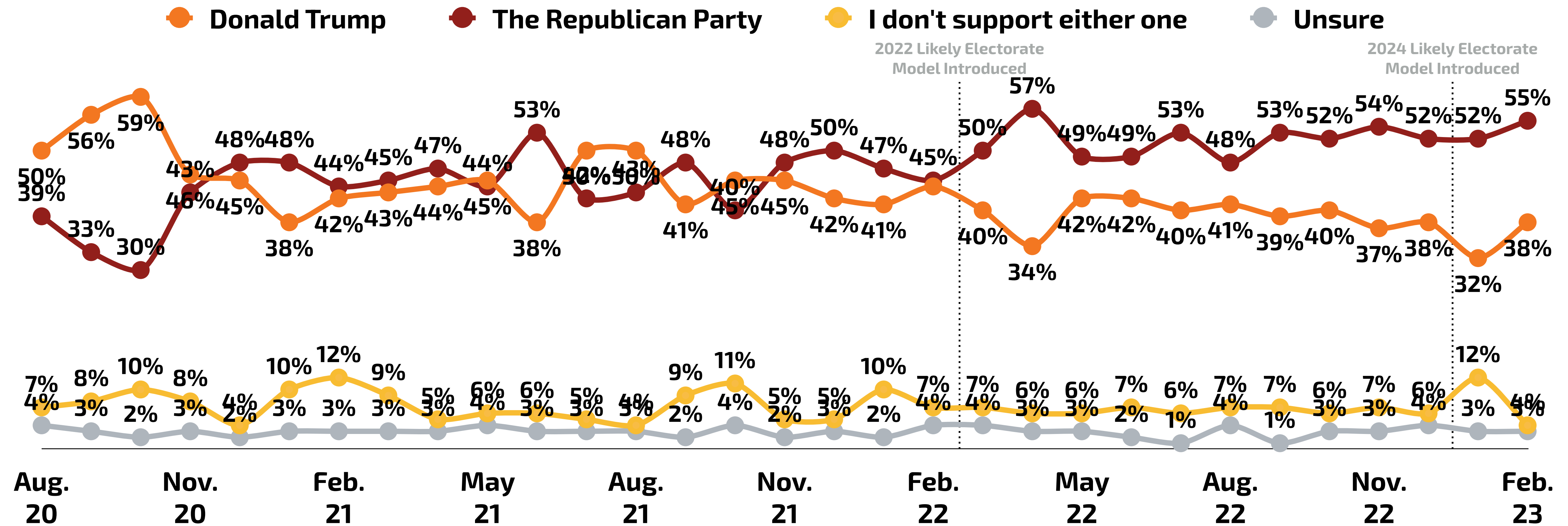

Party-First Republicans At Highest Level Since April 2022

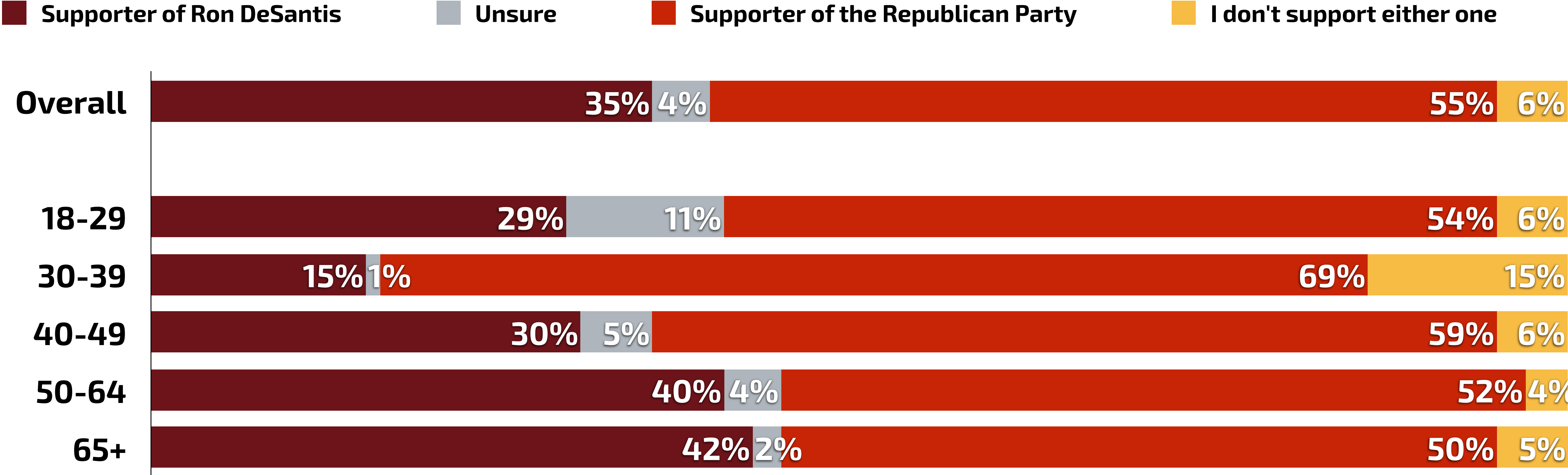

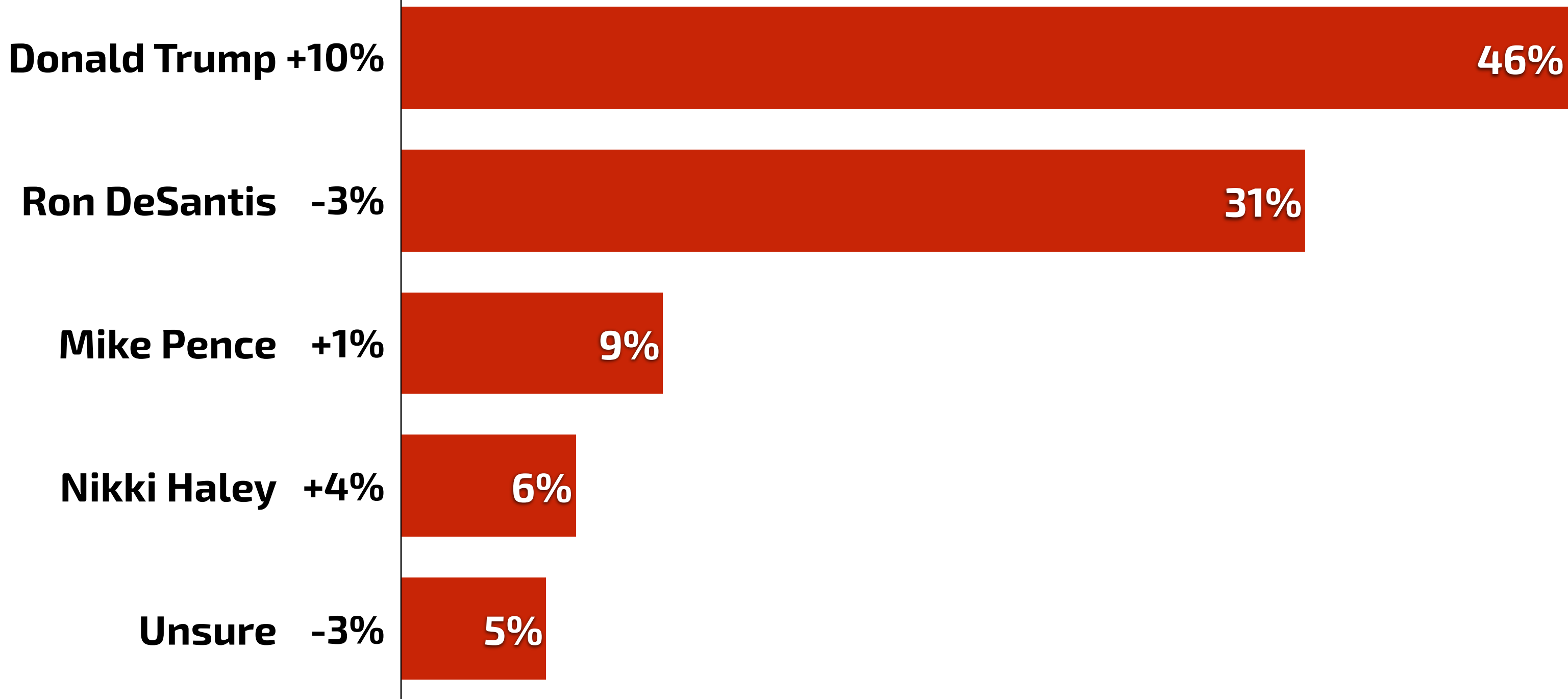

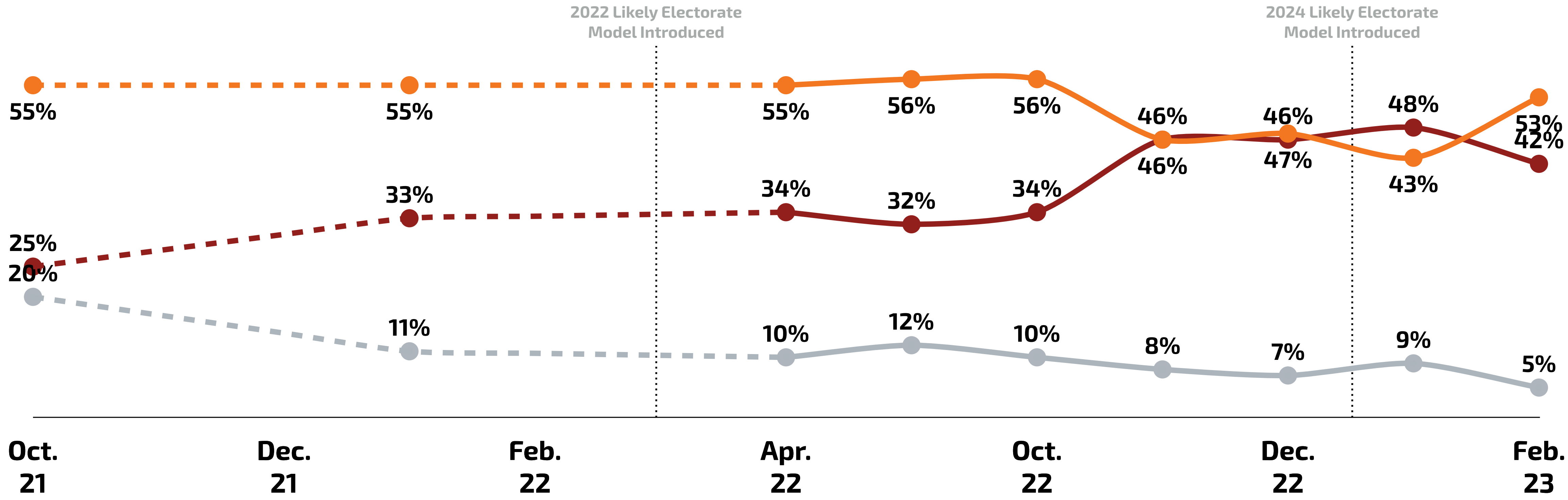

Q. If the 2024 Republican presidential primaries were being held today and you had to make a choice, for whom would you vote? *[Asked of GOP+Lean Voters]*

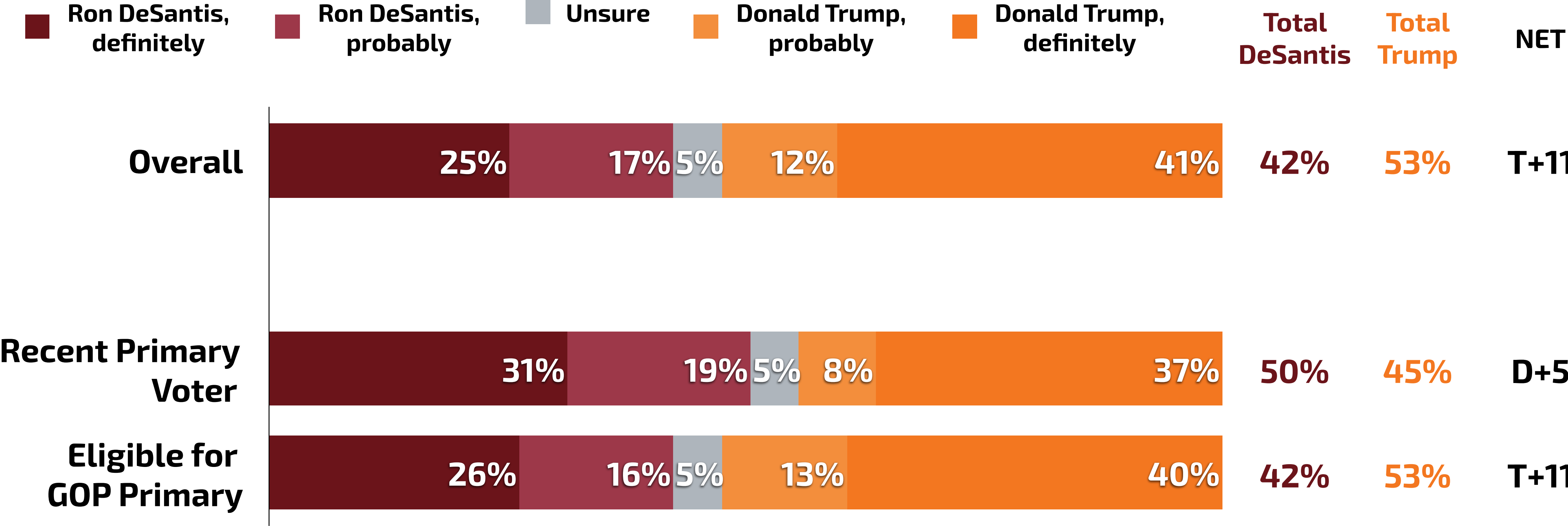
● Donald Trump ● Ron DeSantis ● Unsure
