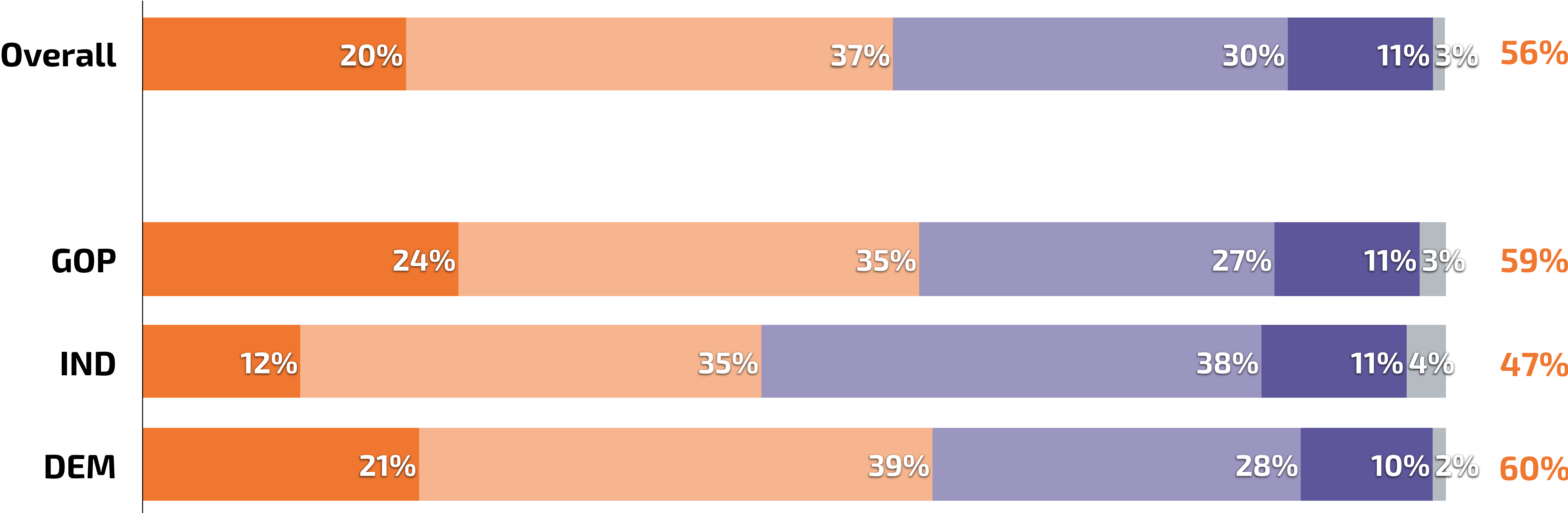

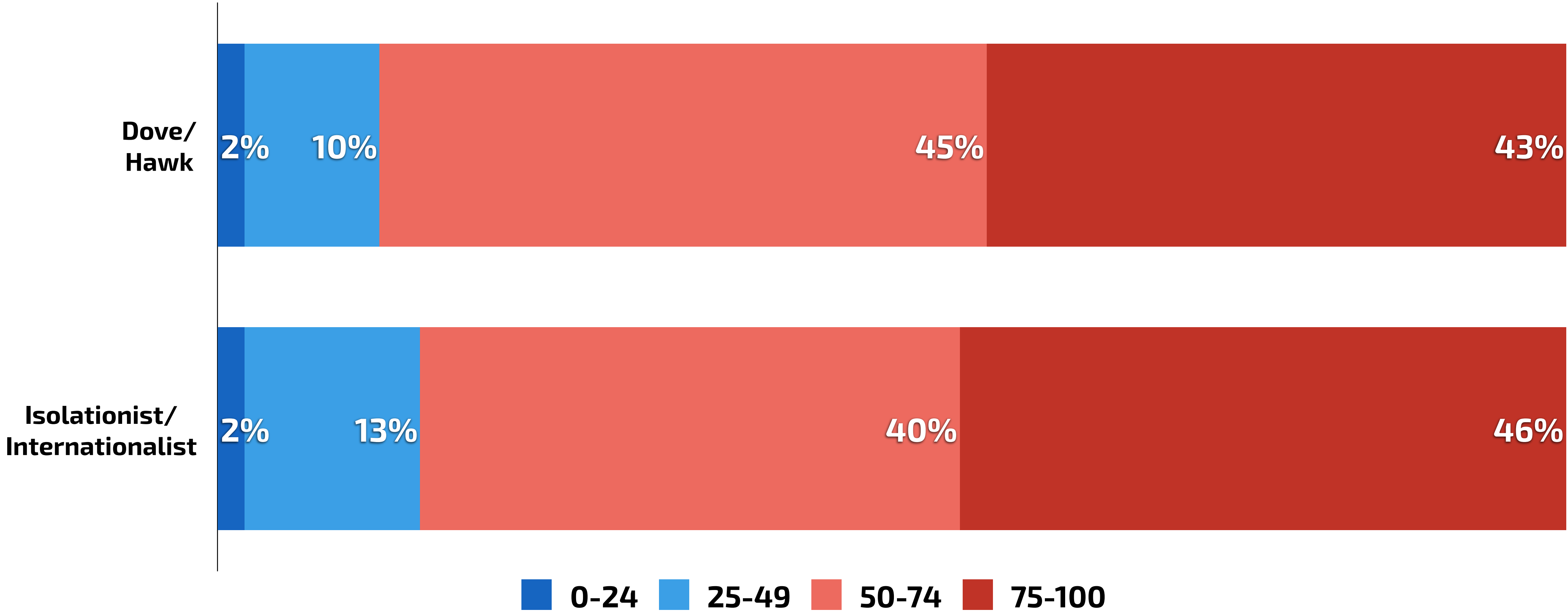

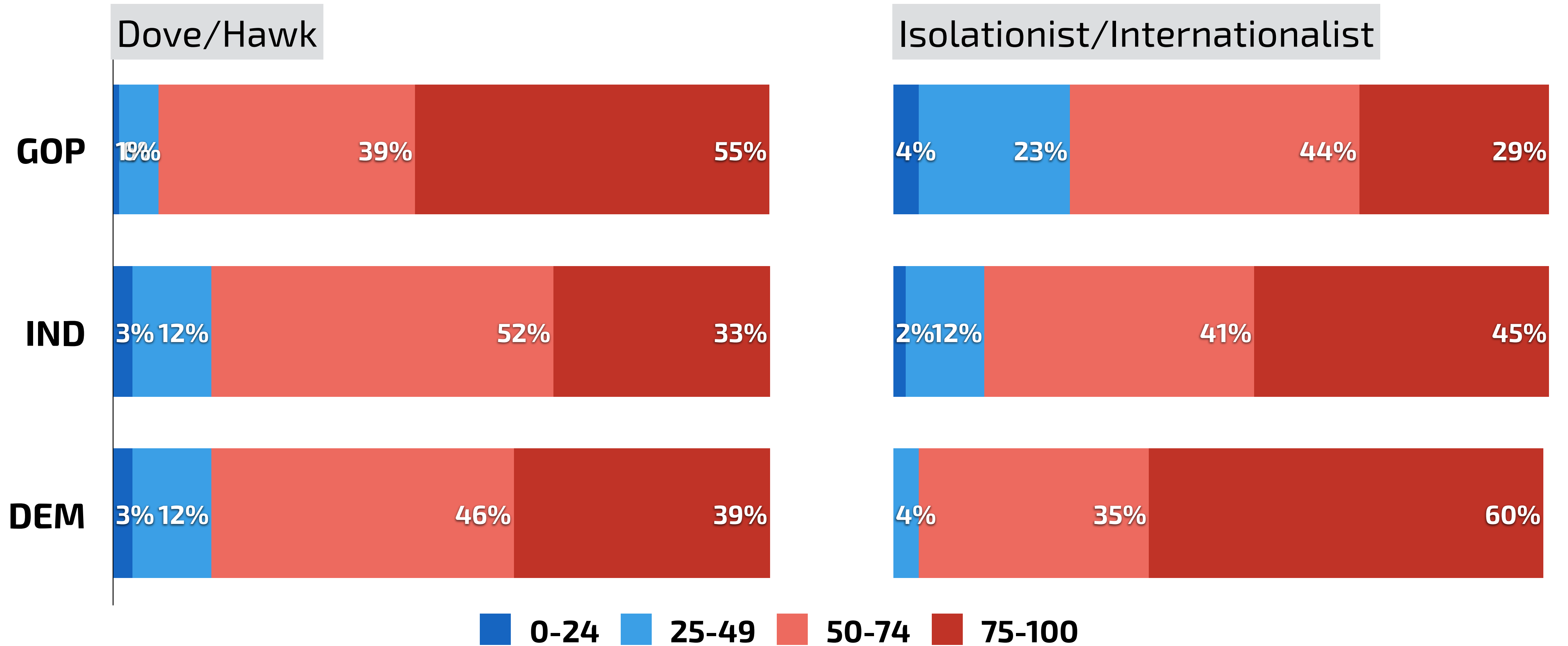

Americans Overwhelmingly Hawkish, Internationalist When It Comes To Foreign Policy



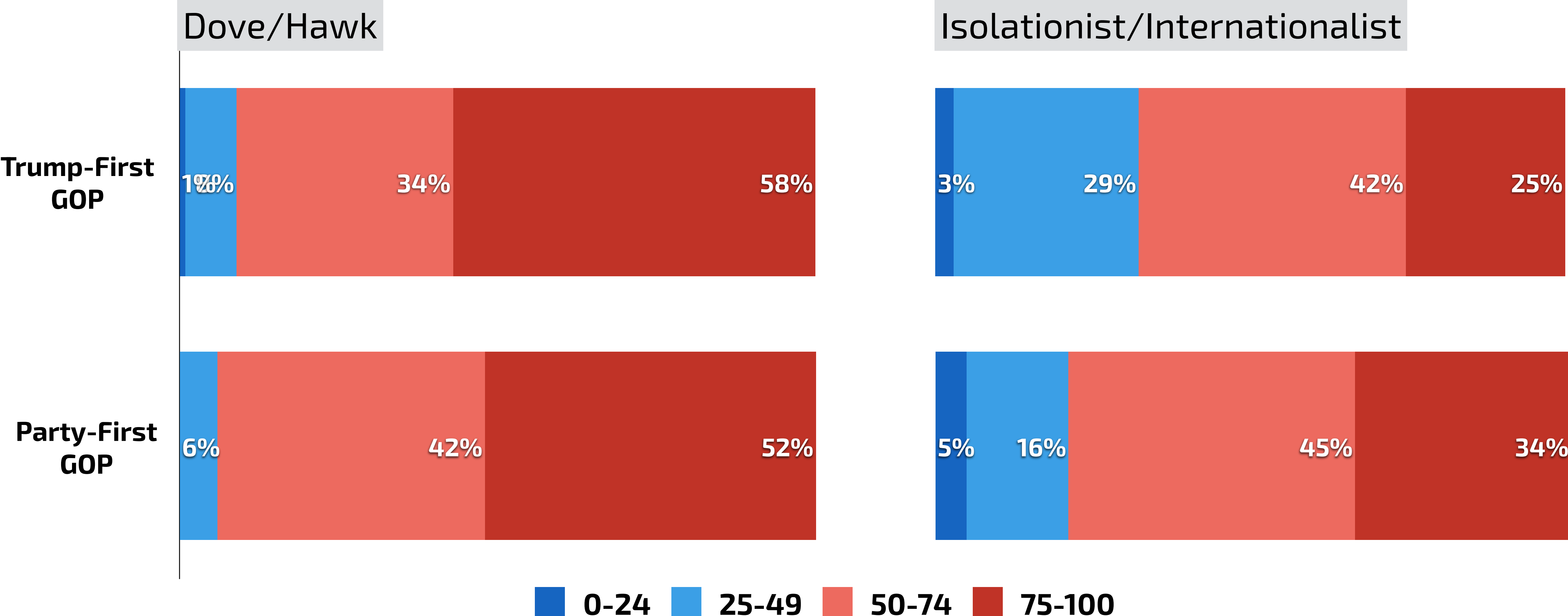

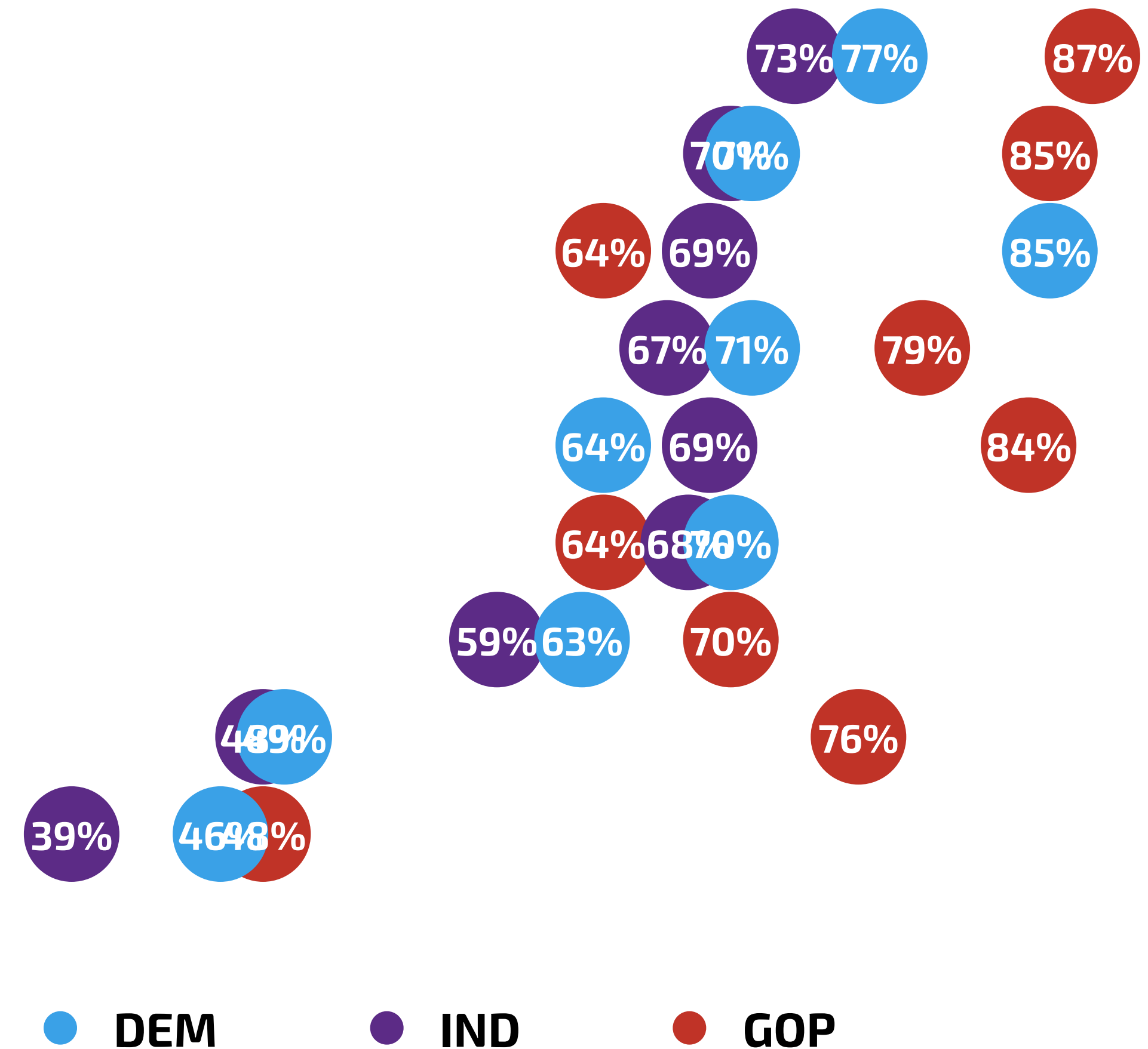

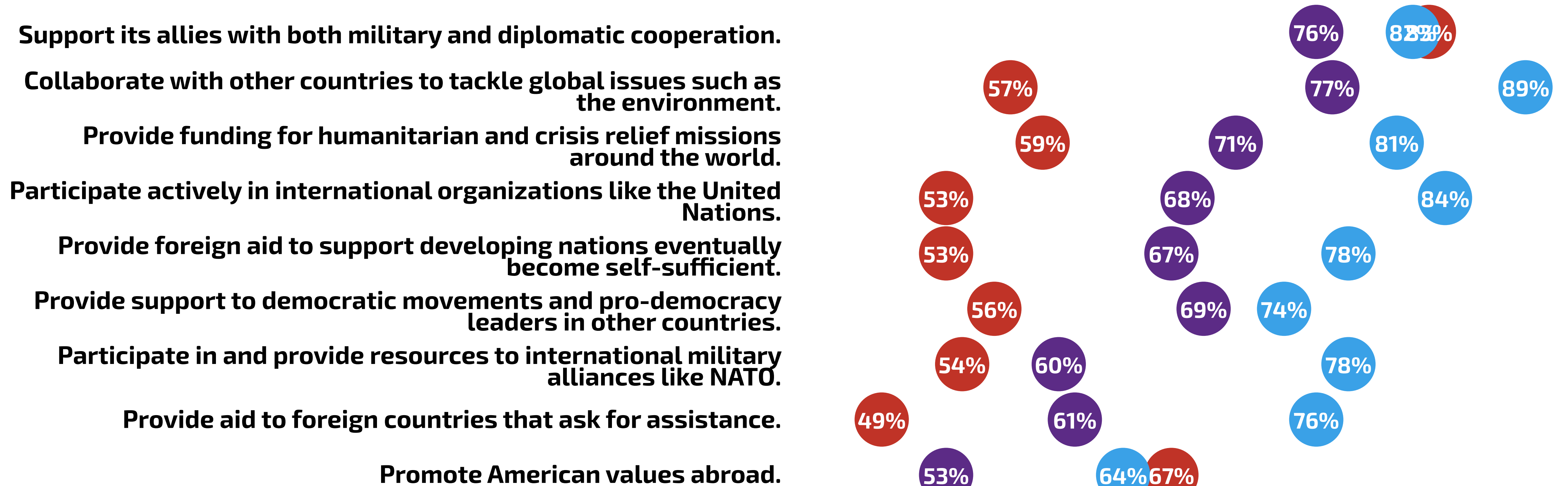
Americans Largely Agree With Internationalist Stances

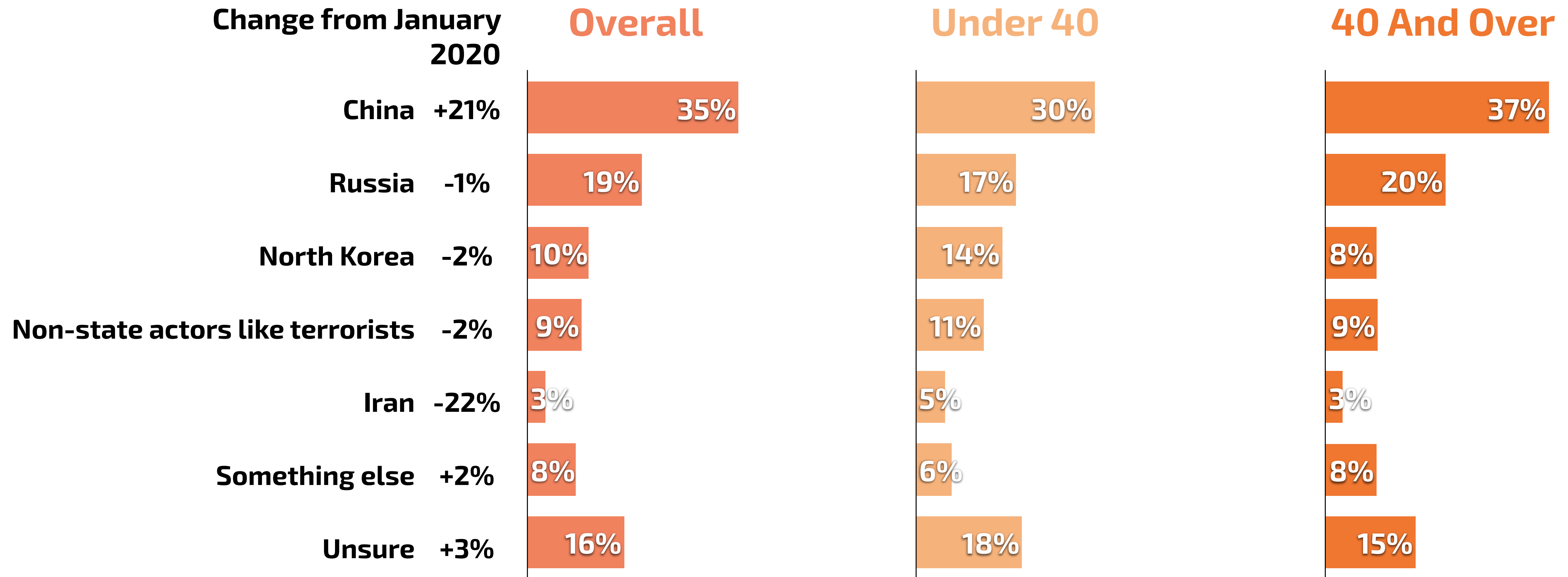

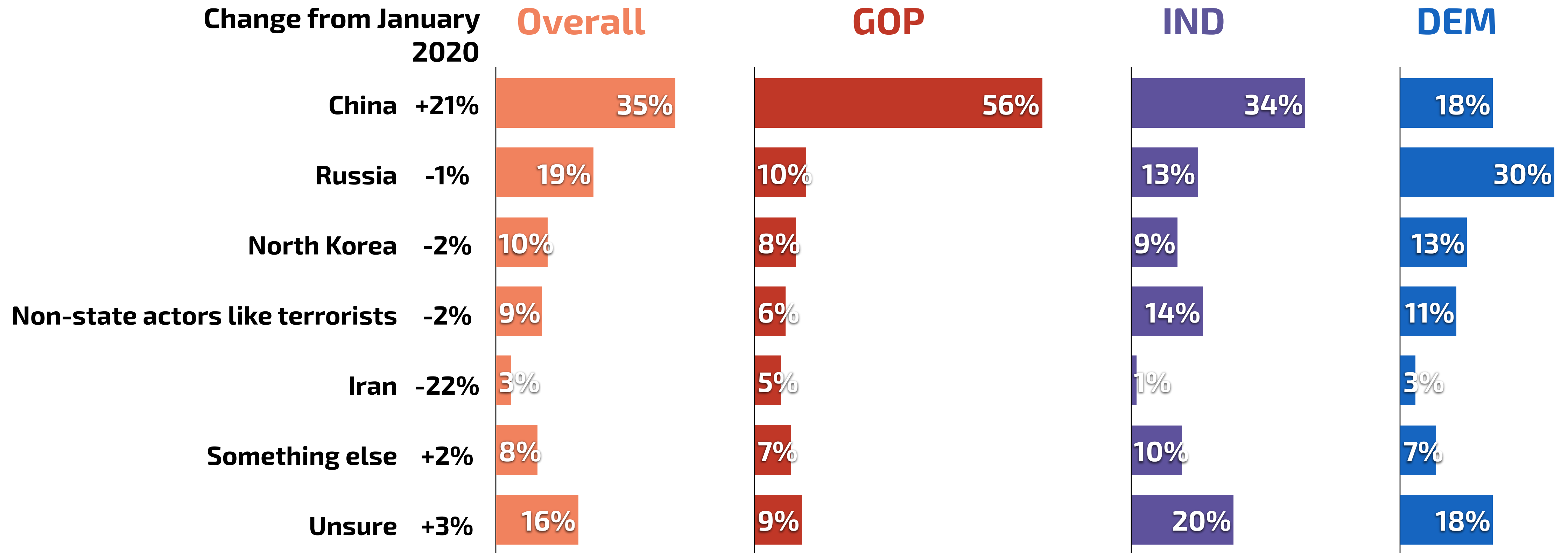
Voters Most Worried About China In 2021

Half Of GOP Says China Is Top Threat; Democrats Focused On Russia

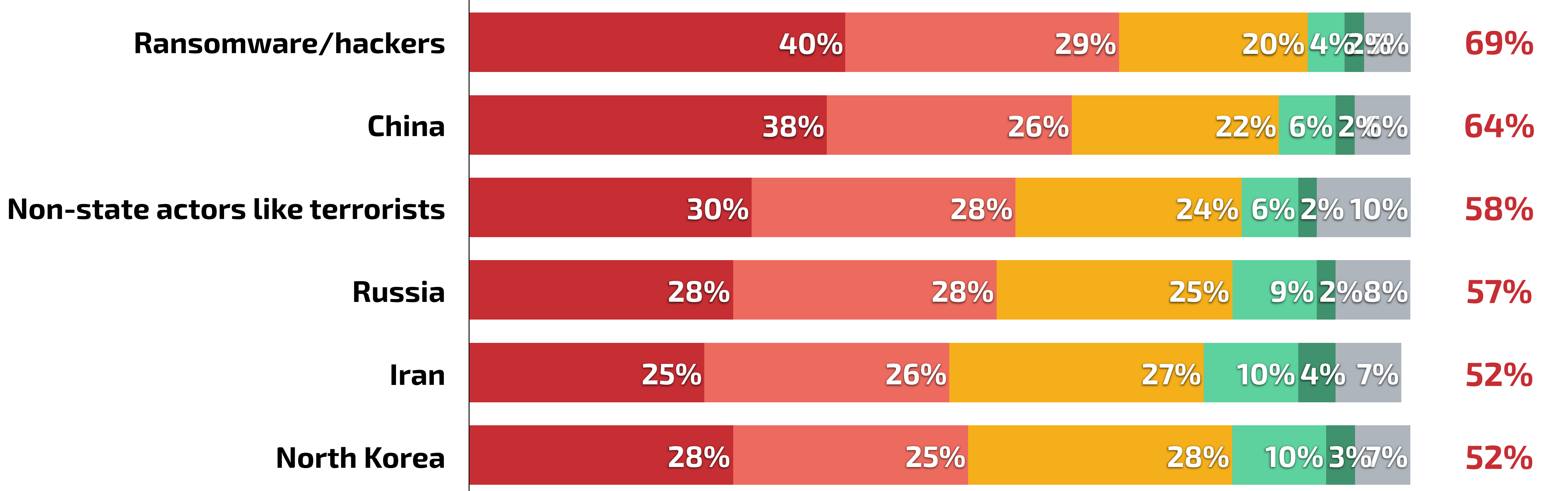

Q. How concerned are you, if at all, about the threat each of the following pose to the United States' security?

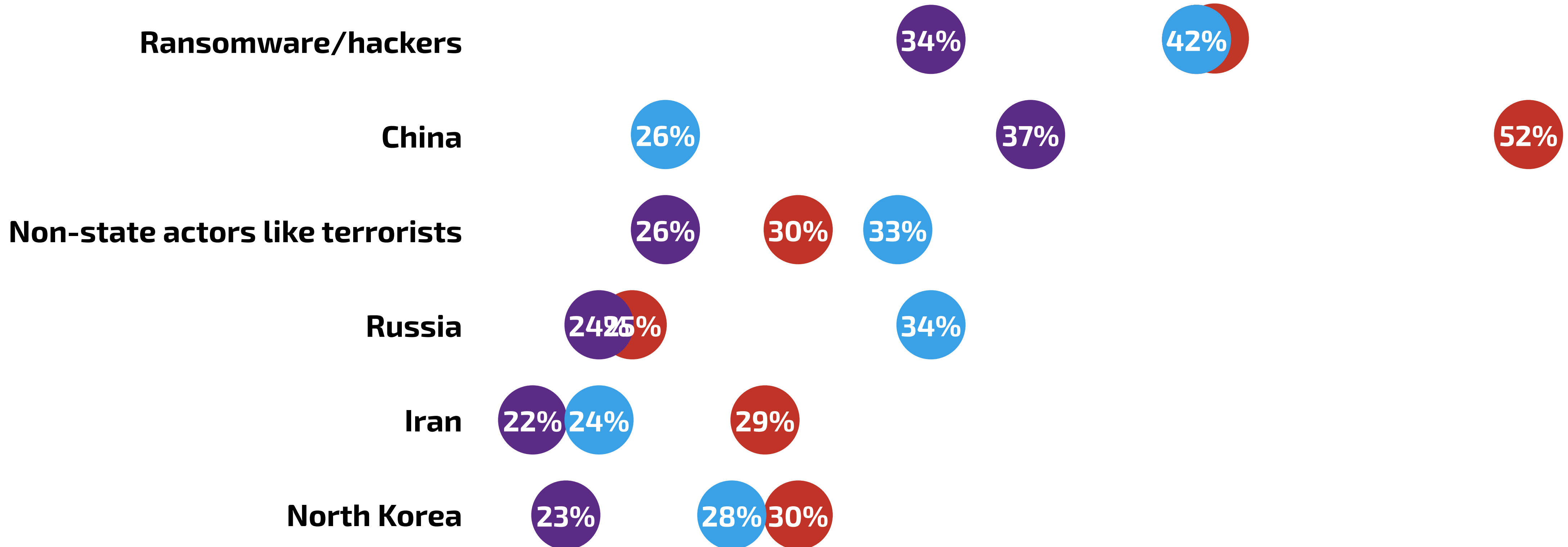

% Extremely Worried

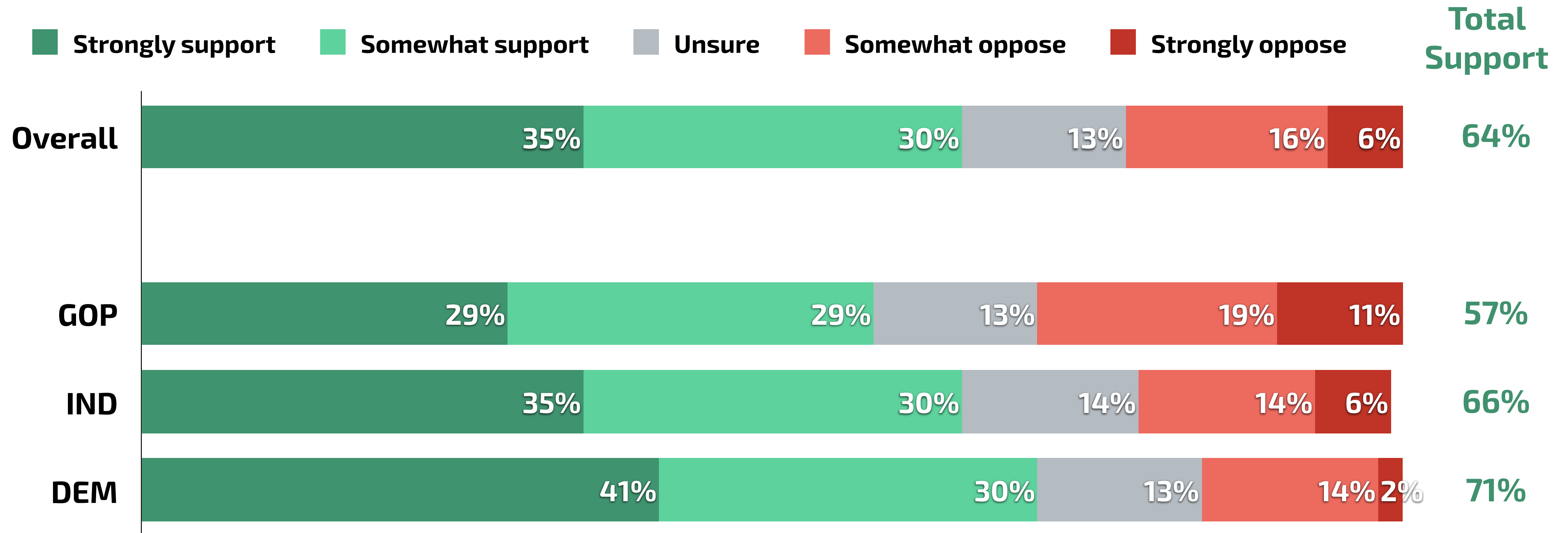

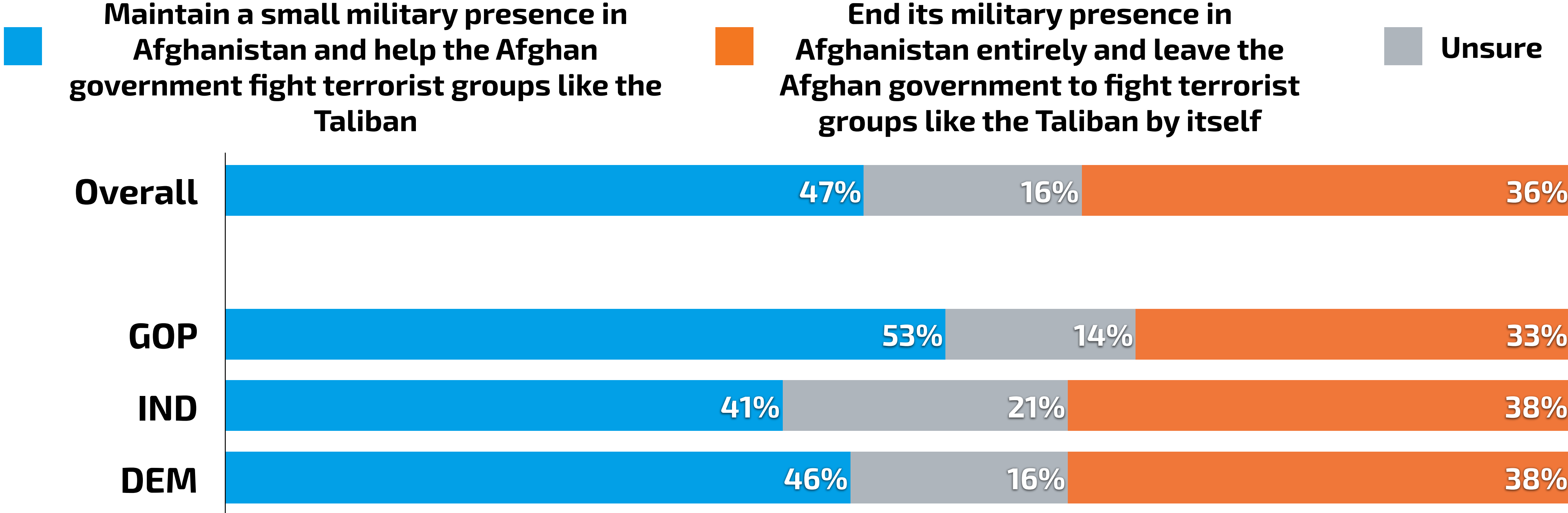
Majority Of Voters Support Ending Presence In Afghanistan

Q. Do you support or oppose the decision for the United States military to end its mission in Afghanistan and end the presence of American troops in the country?



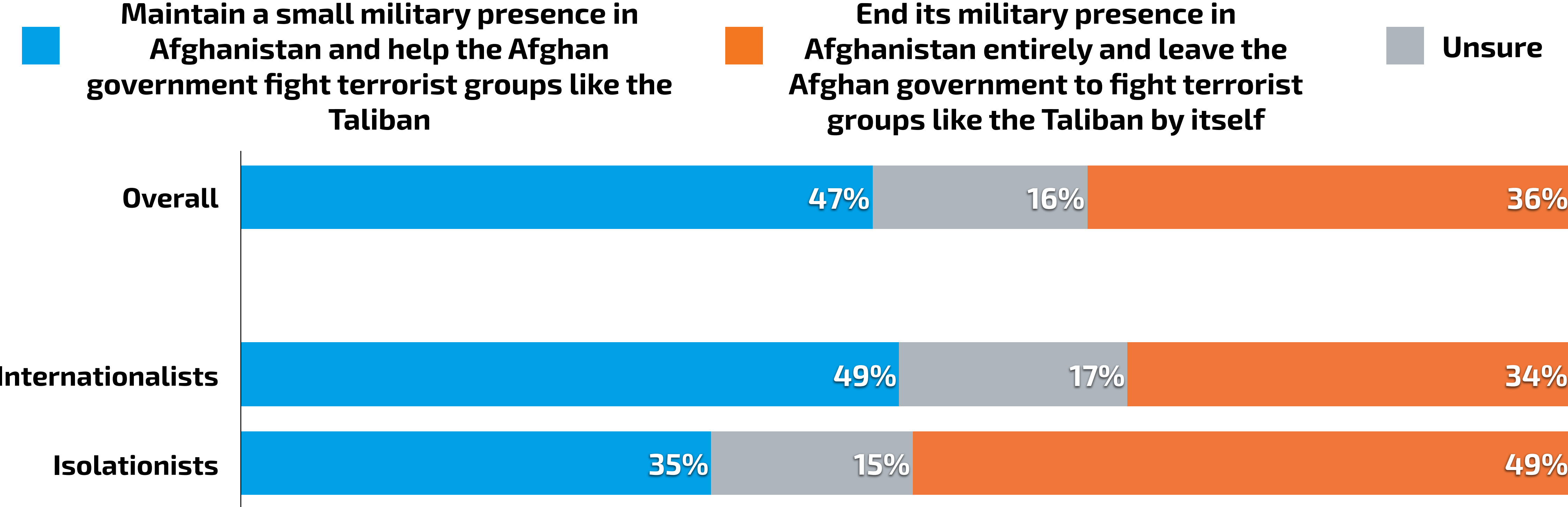
When The Alternative Is “A Small Presence,” Slightly More Voters Say Stay In Afghanistan - Even Across Party Lines

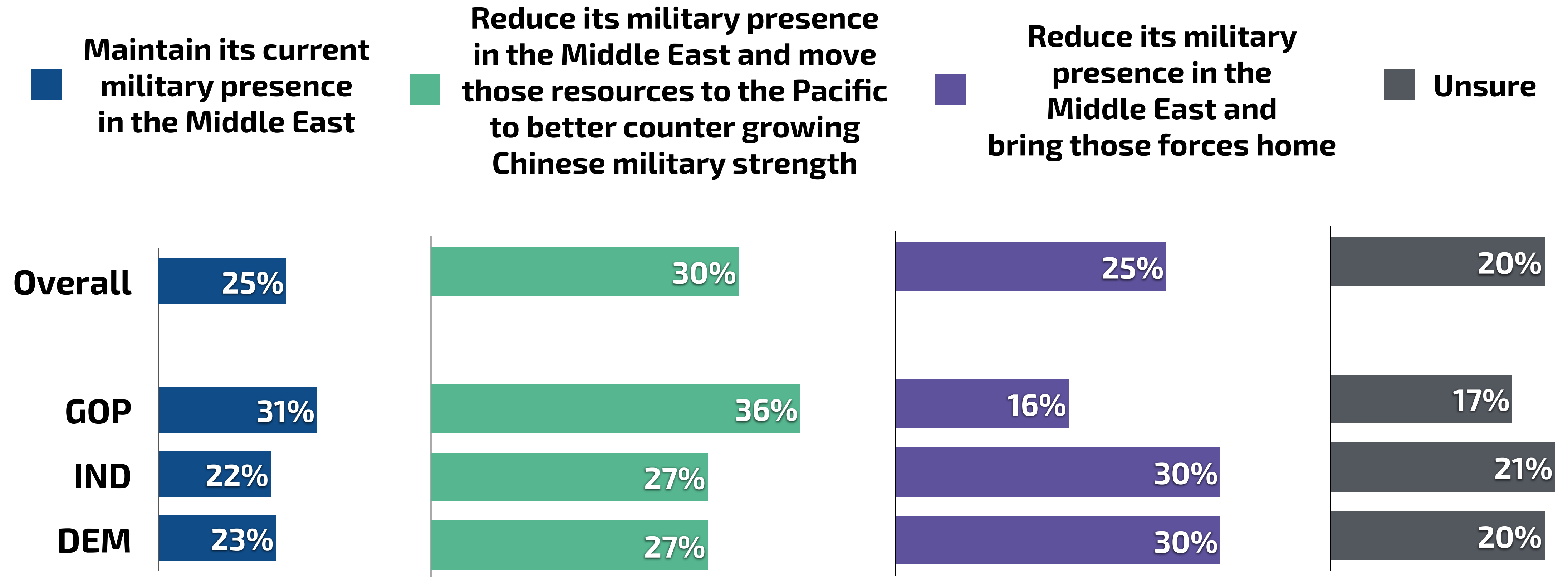
Stark Divides Between Isolationists, Internationalists On Military Presence In Afghanistan

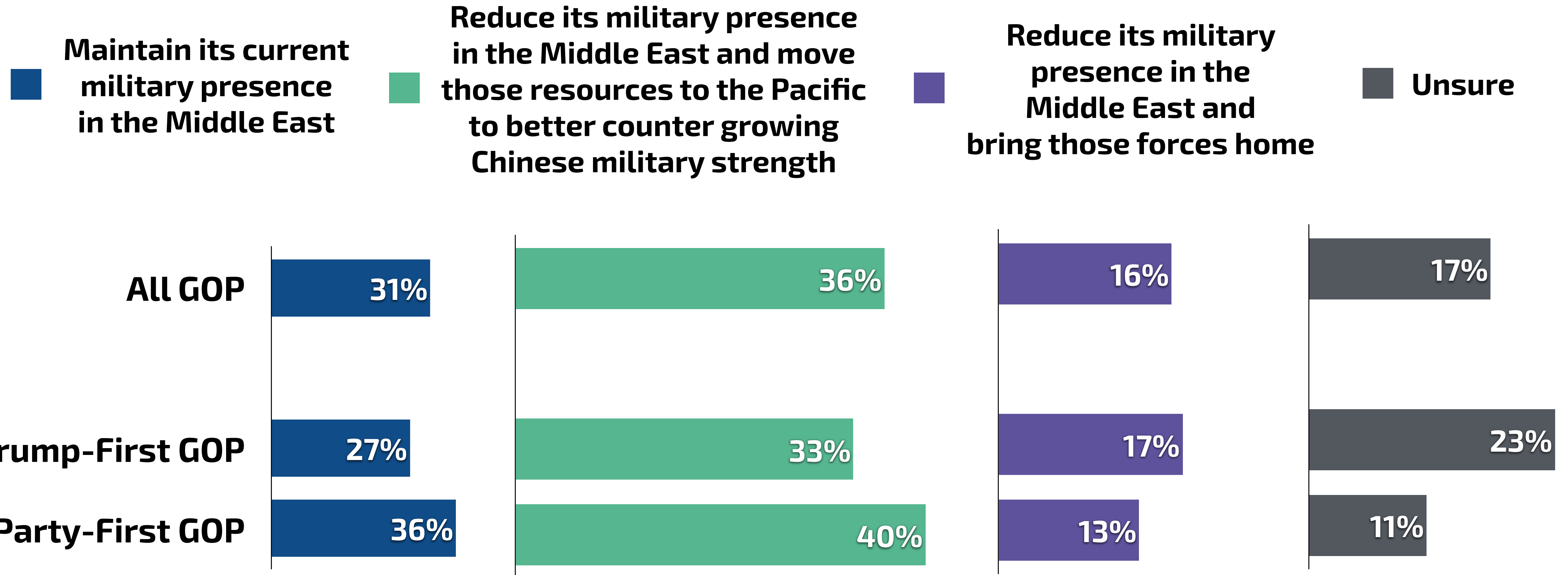
3 In 10 Say Move Extra Forces To Counter China
