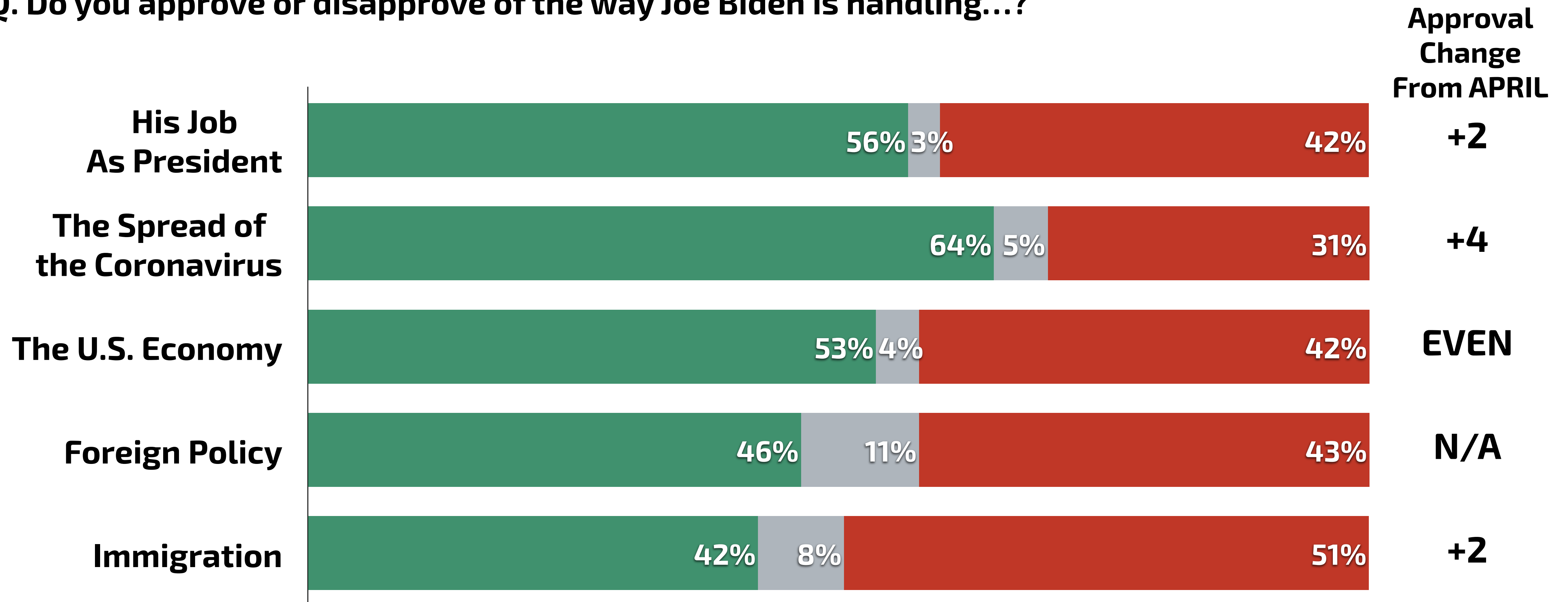

Strongly / Somewhat Approve

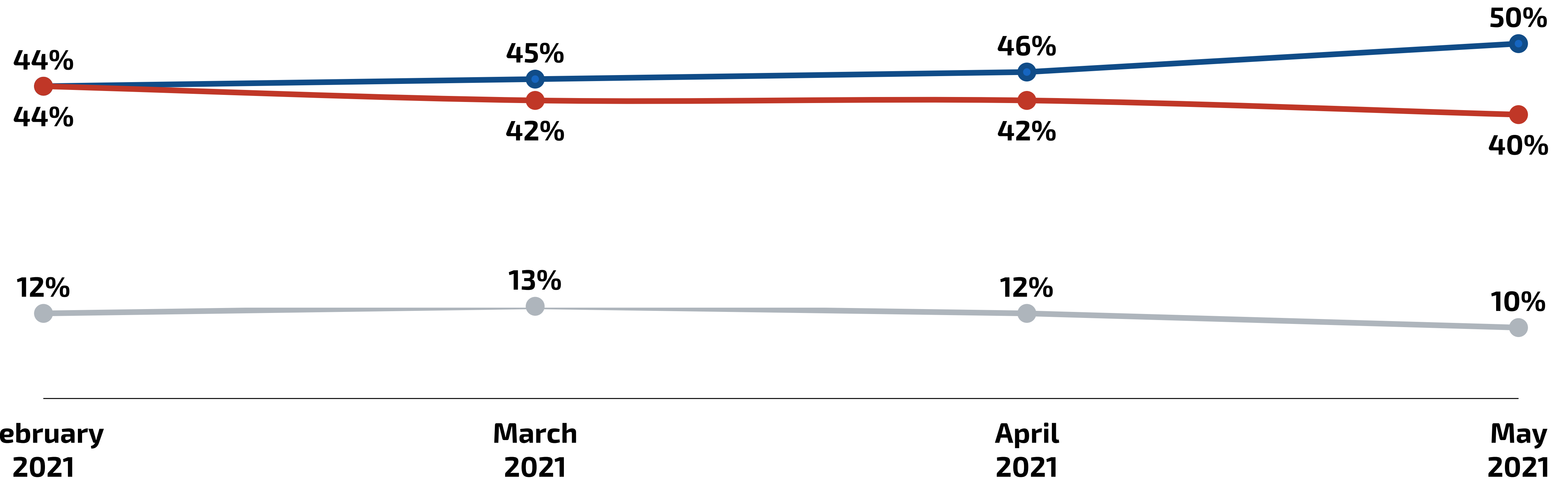

Democrats Lead Grows On Generic Congressional

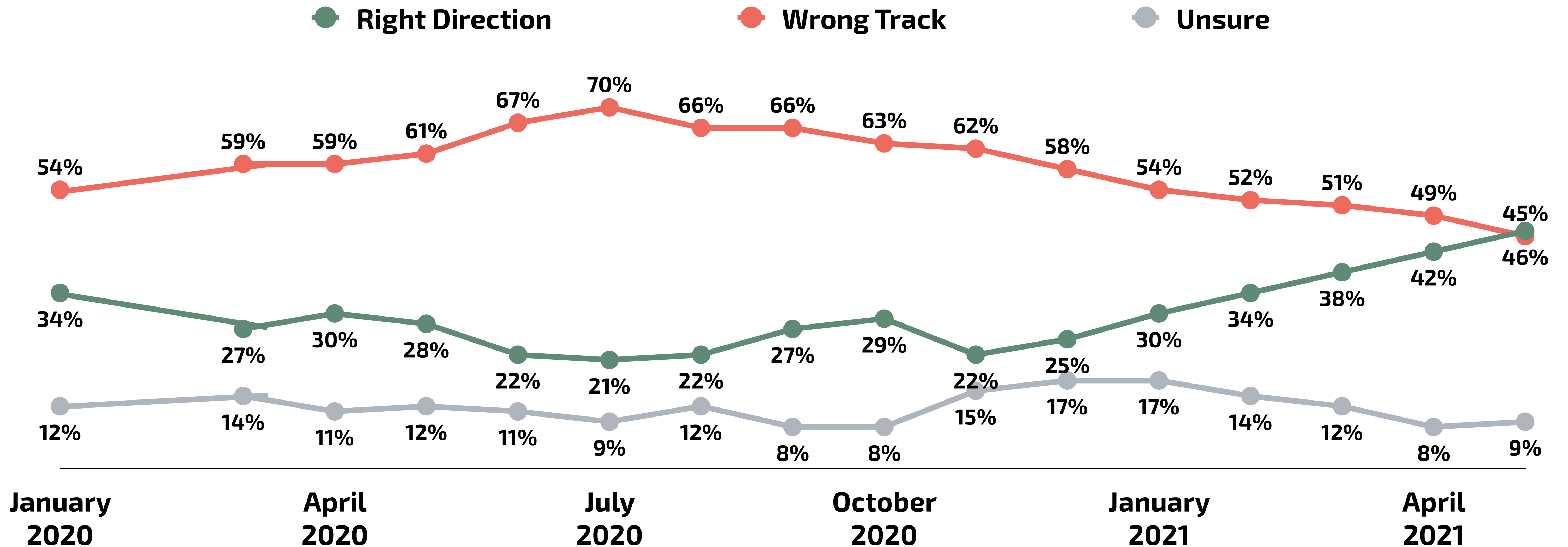
Q. If the election for Congress were held today and you had to make a choice, for whom would you vote?

- Definitely/Probably the Democratic candidate



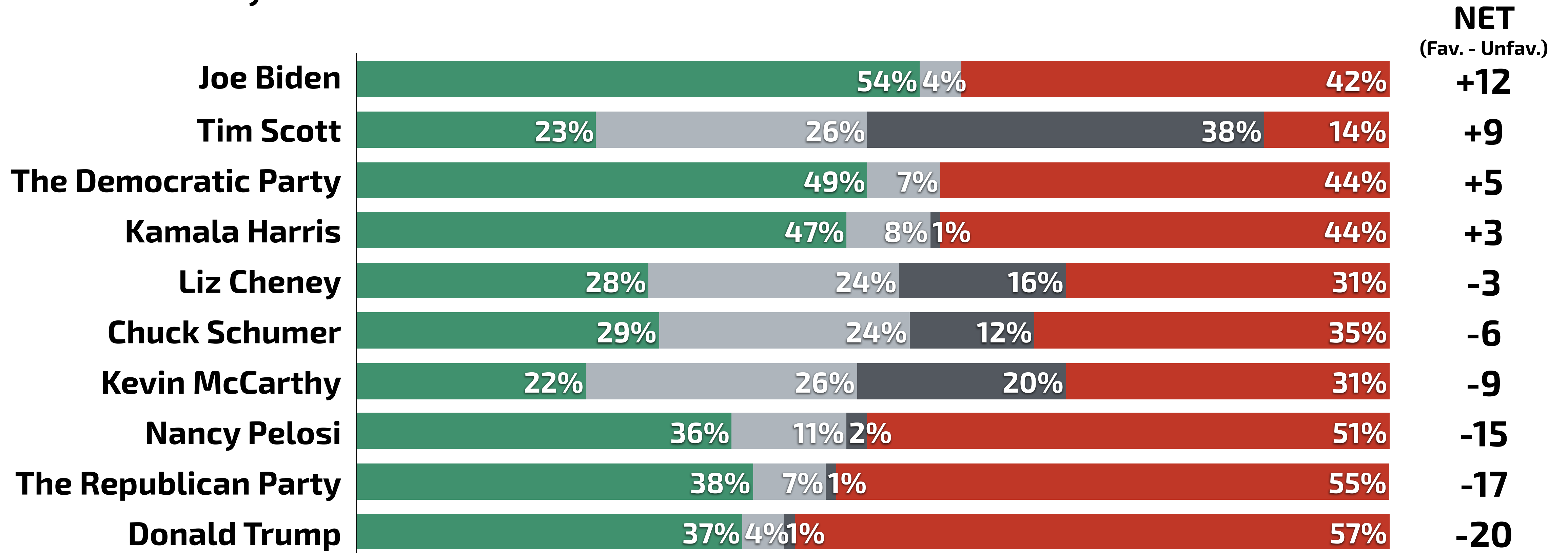
Recently, More Say Things In U.S. Are Headed In Right Direction

Q. Do you have a favorable or unfavorable view of the following individuals or groups which have been in the news lately?



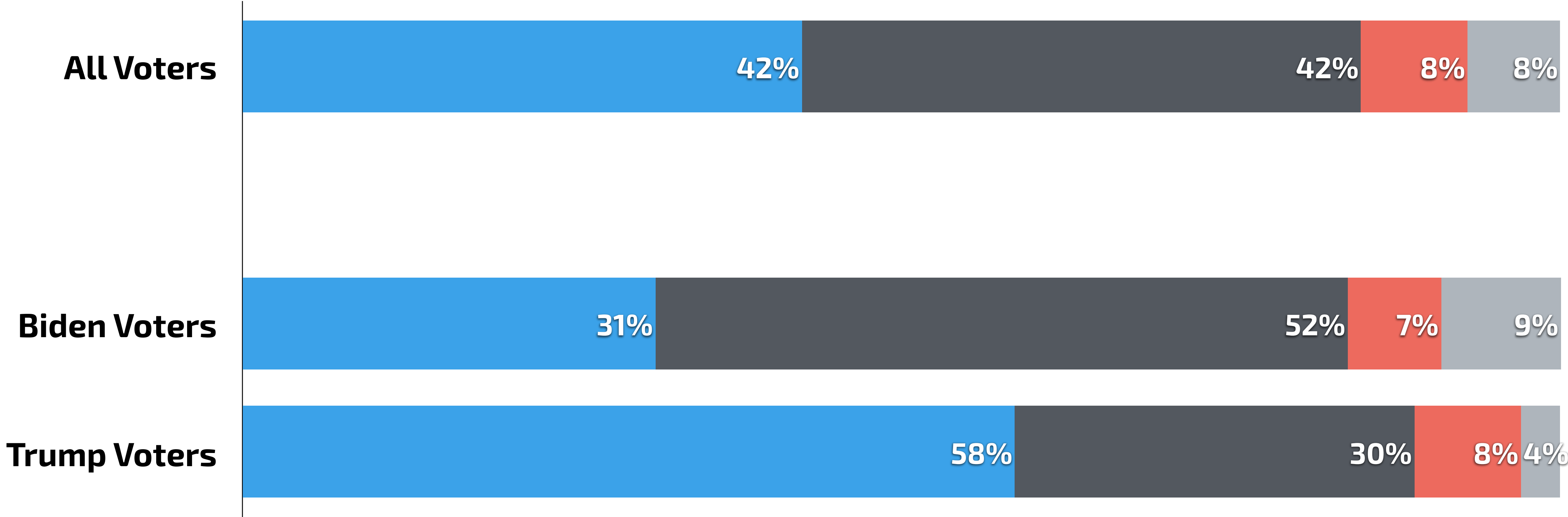

Q. Relative to your expectations when he was elected, would you say Joe Biden has been more or less liberal as president than you expected?

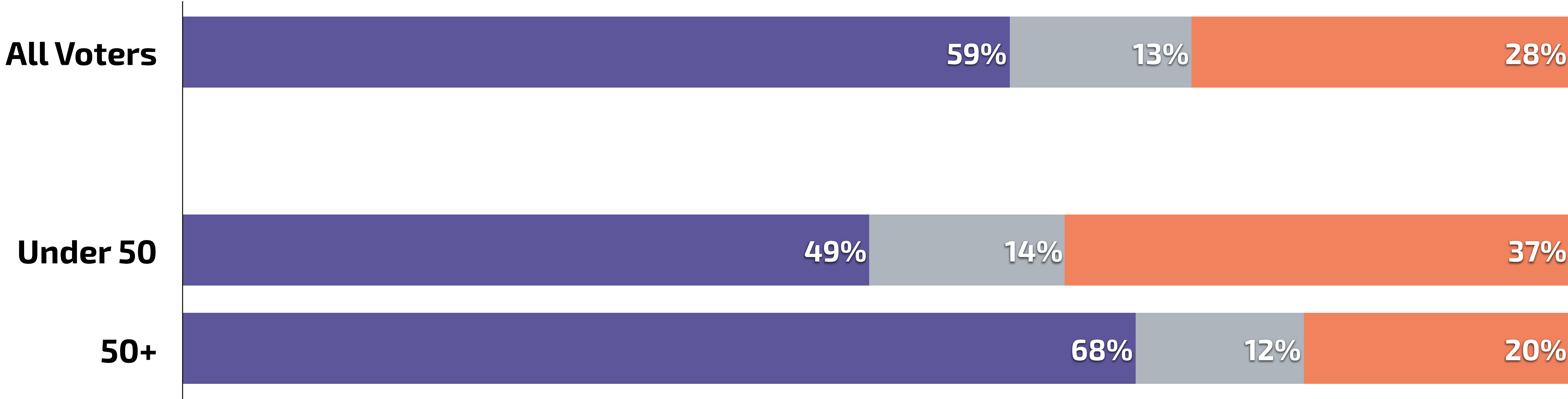

- Always vote based on his or her own views and principles, even if they sometimes differ from the views of the voters in his or her district



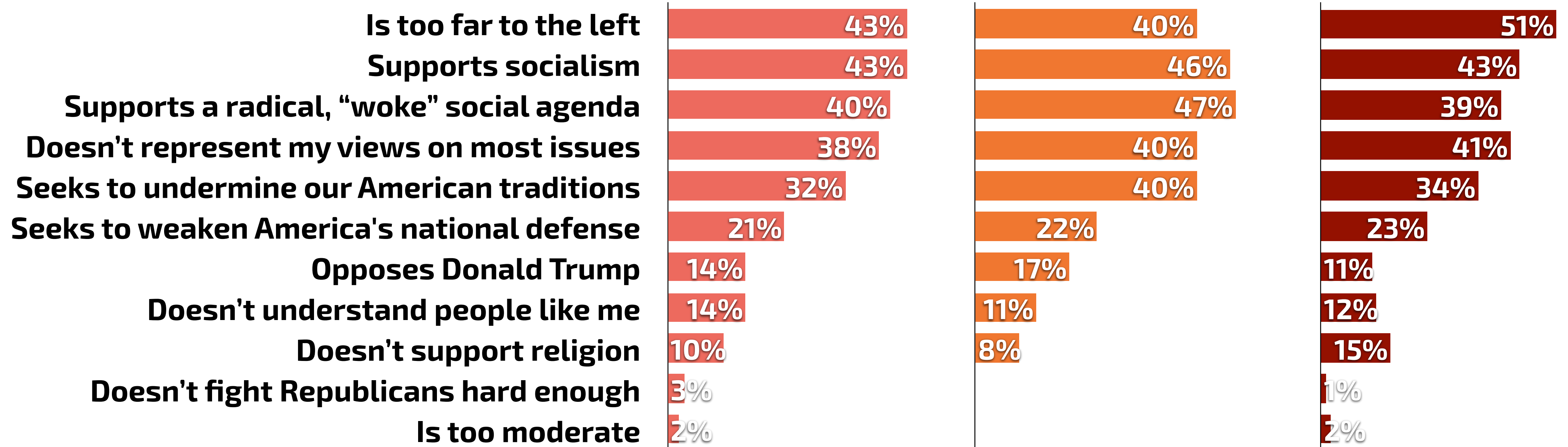
Trump- And Party-First GOP Say Democratic Party Is Too Far Left

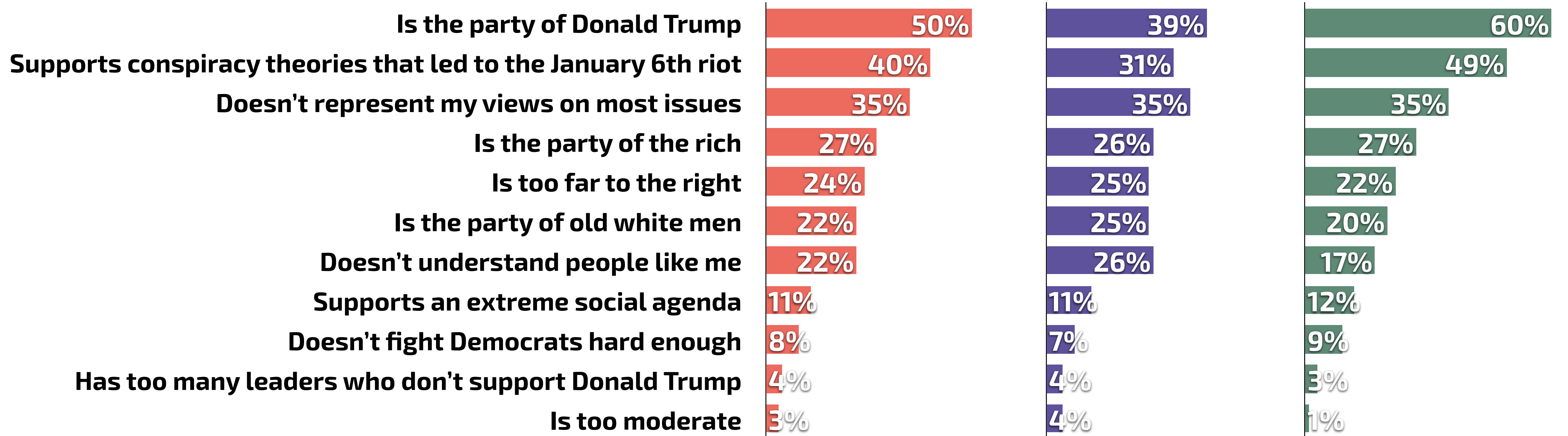
“Party Of Donald Trump” Drives GOP Unfavorability

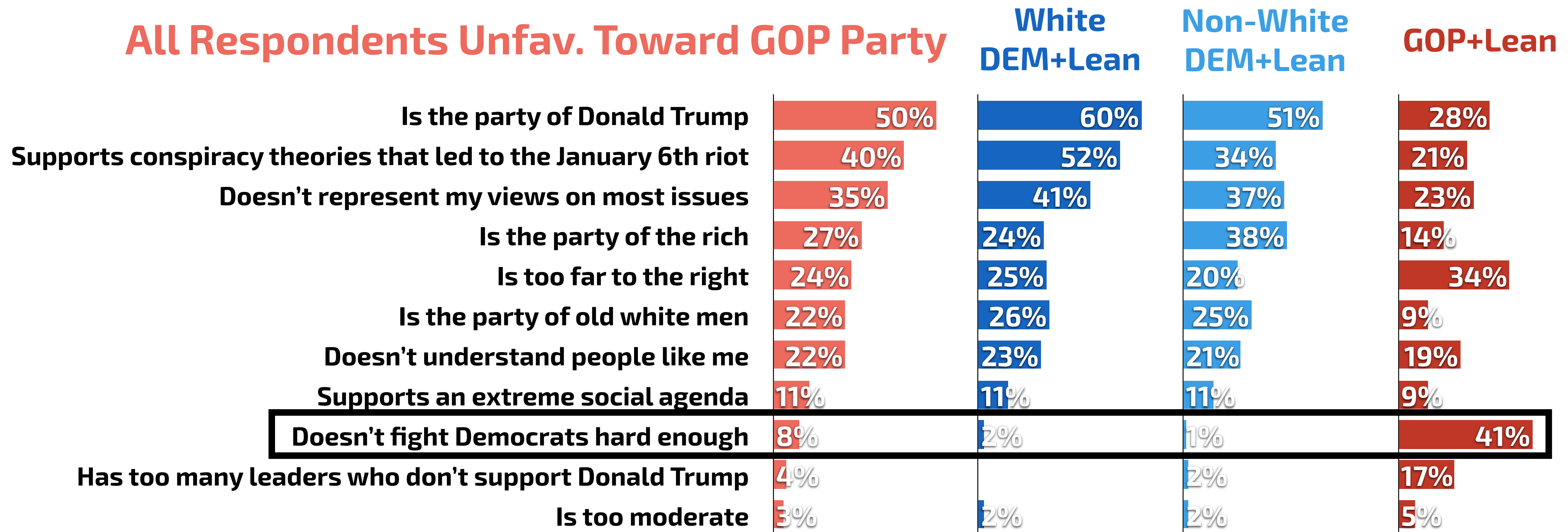

All Respondents Unfav. Toward GOP Party



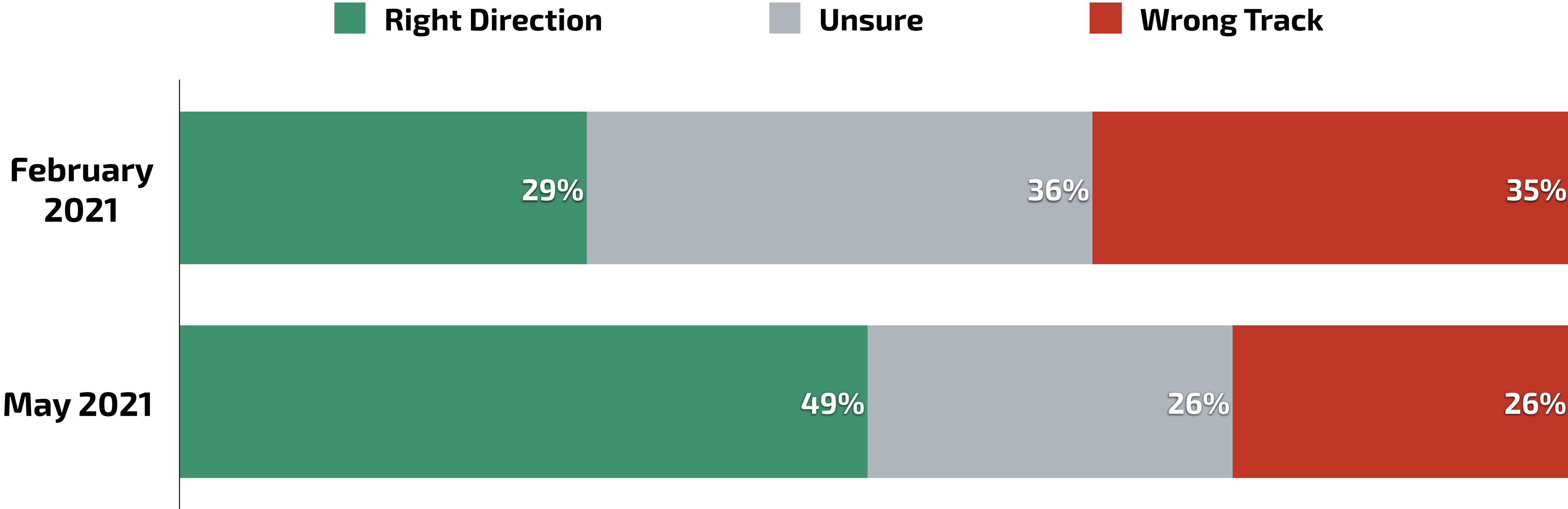

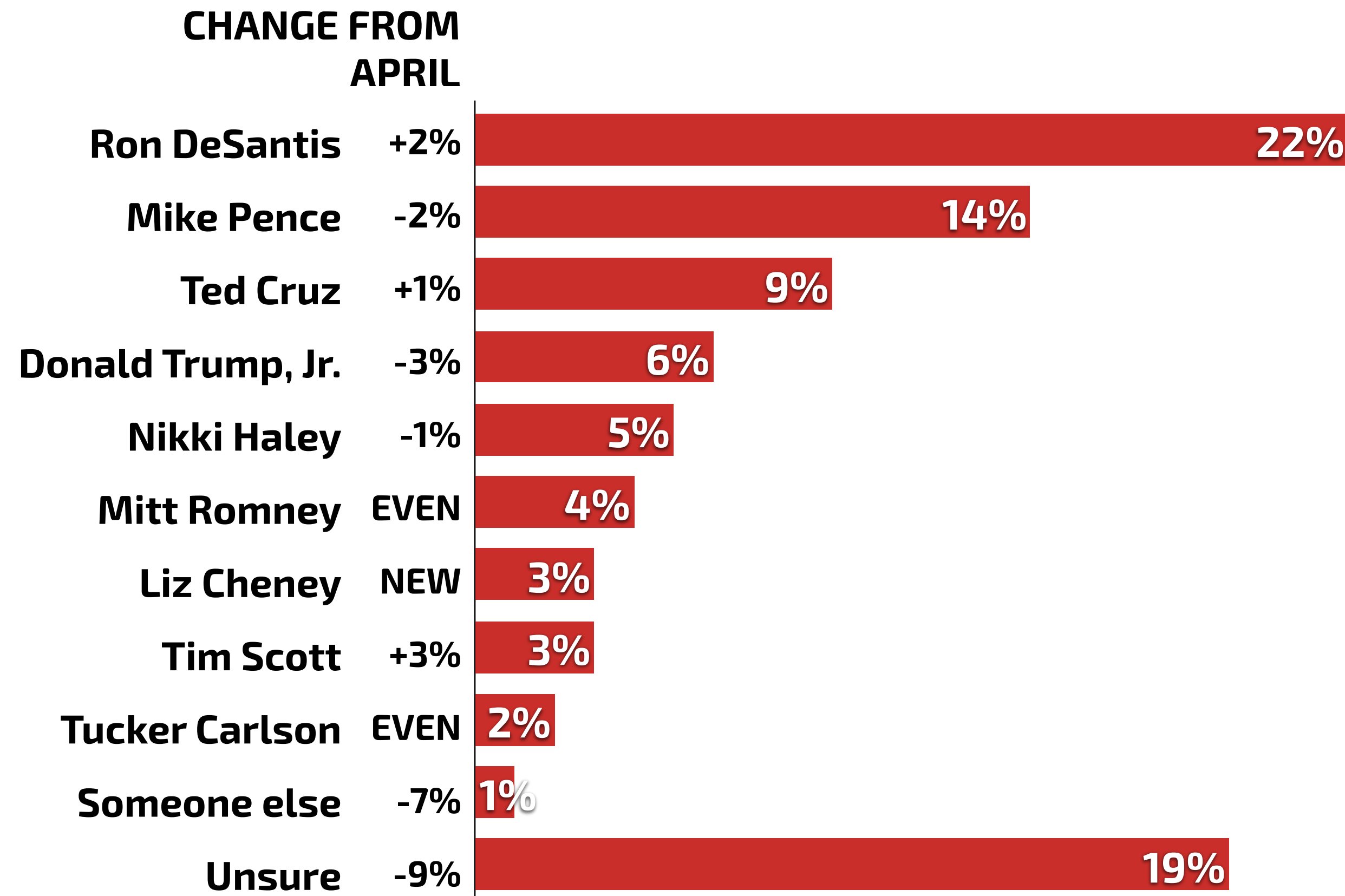
Half Of Republicans Say GOP Is Headed In Right Direction

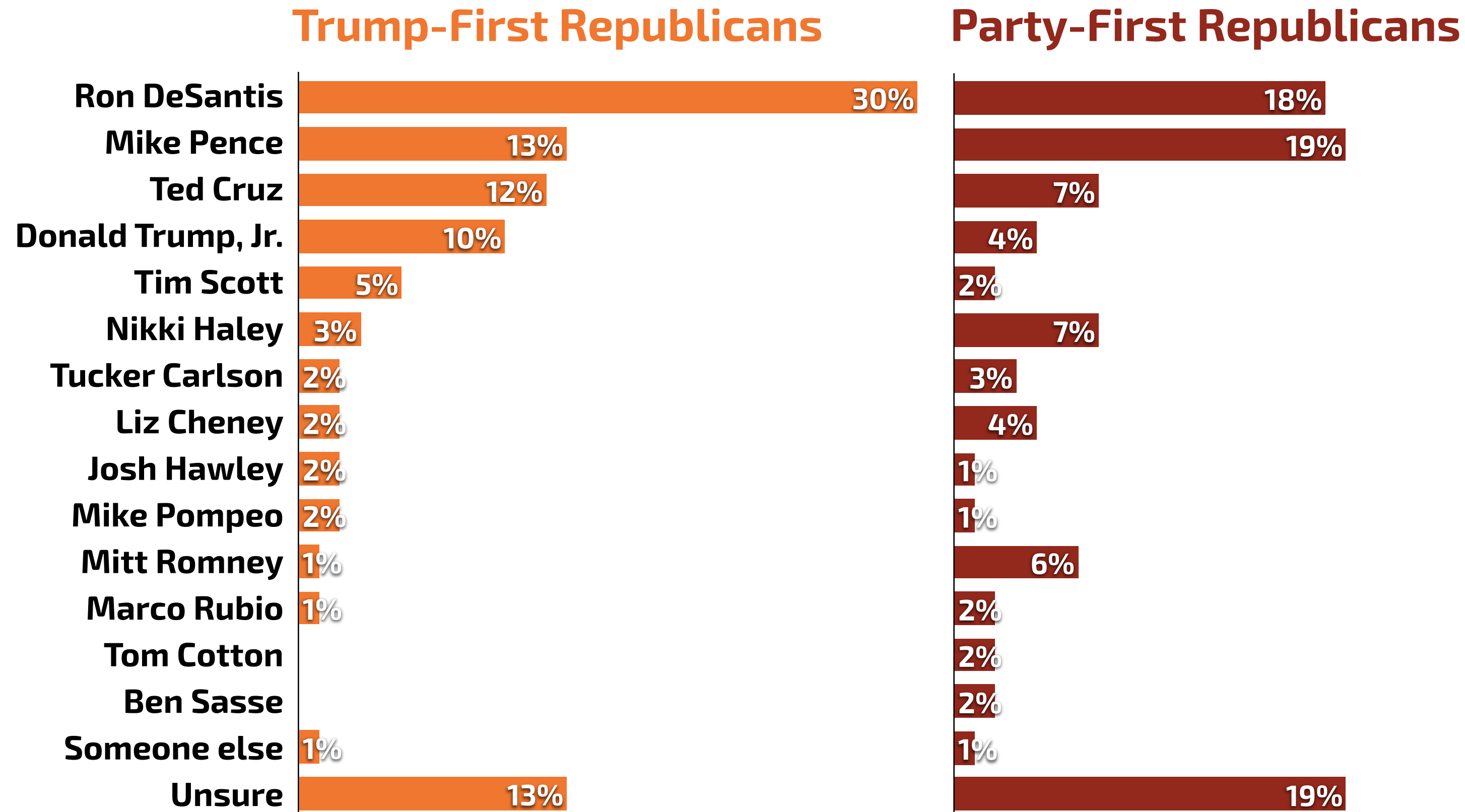

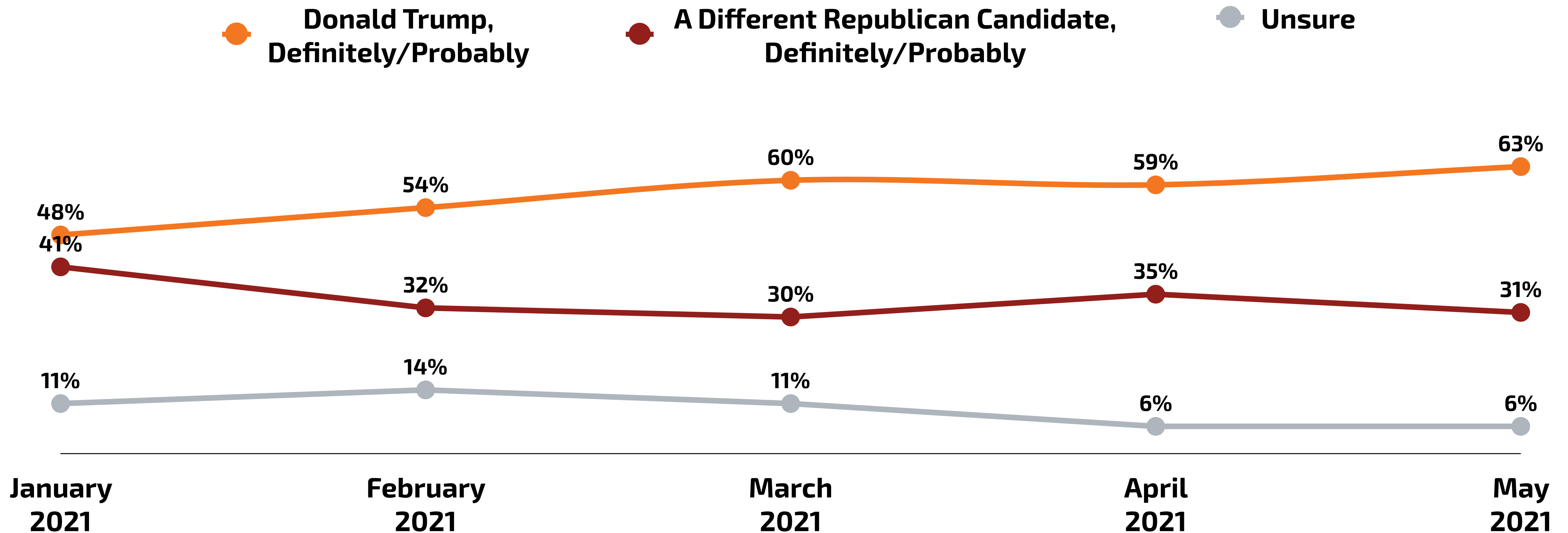

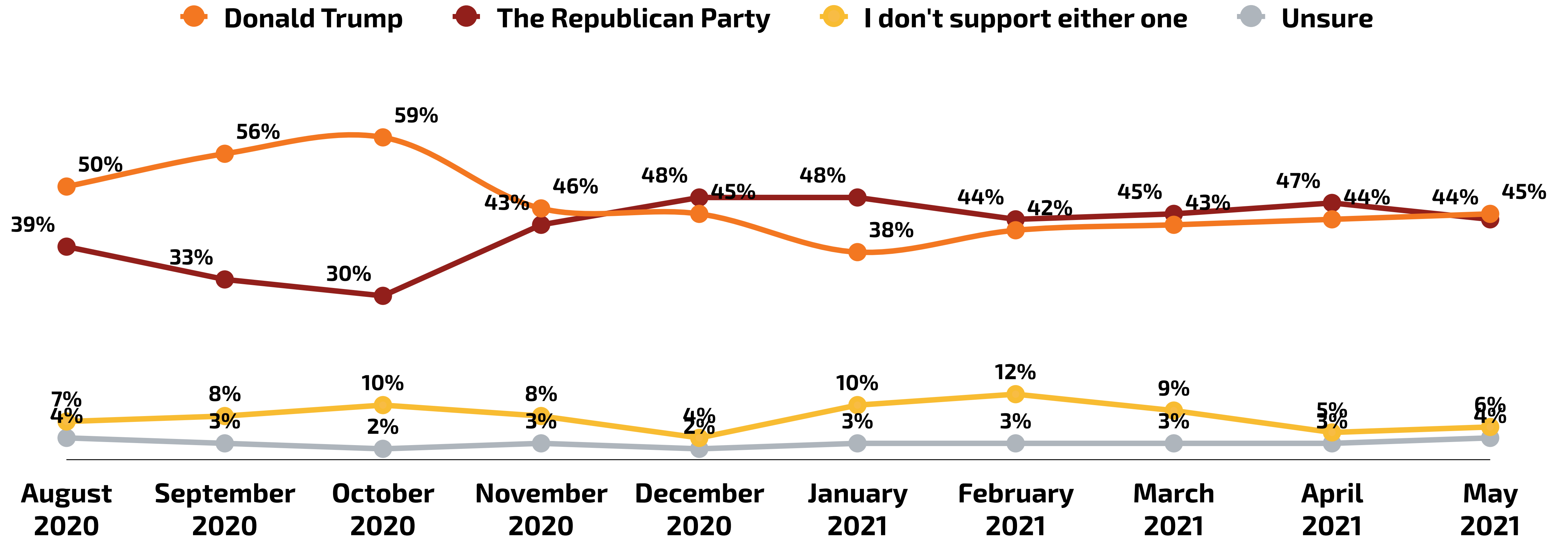
In May, Trump Gains Ground In GOP Primary

Q. If the 2024 Republican presidential primaries were being held today and you had to make a choice, for whom would you vote? [Asked of Republican+Lean Voters]



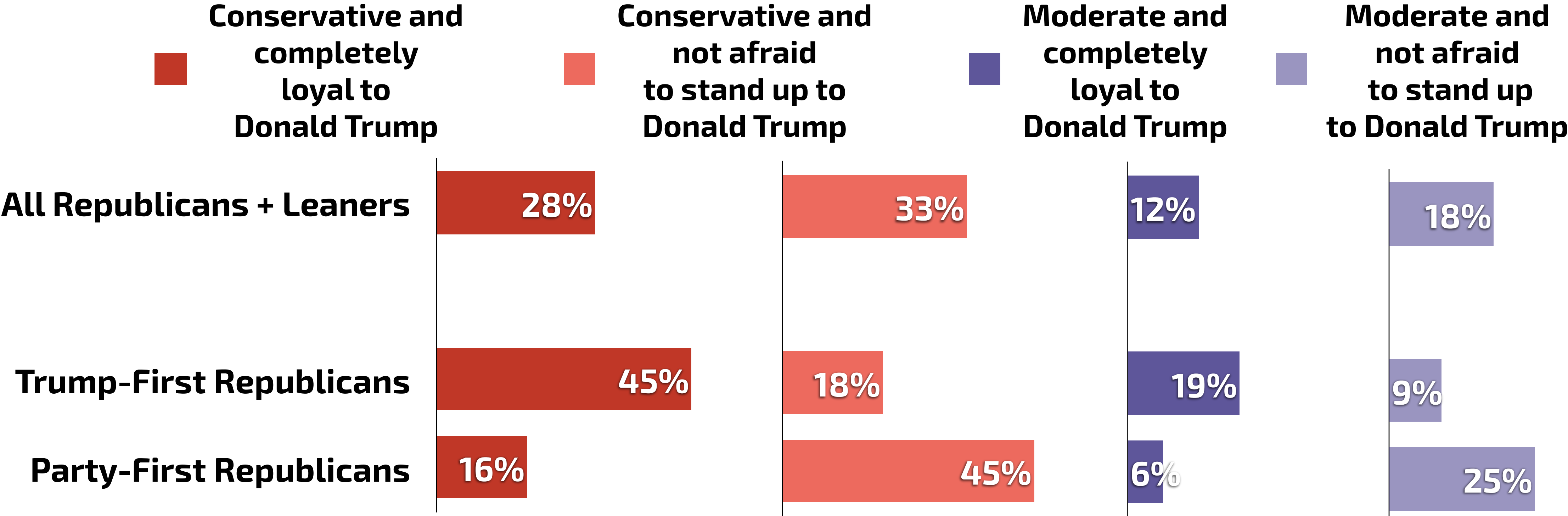
“Trump” and “Party” Republicans Are Evenly Matched

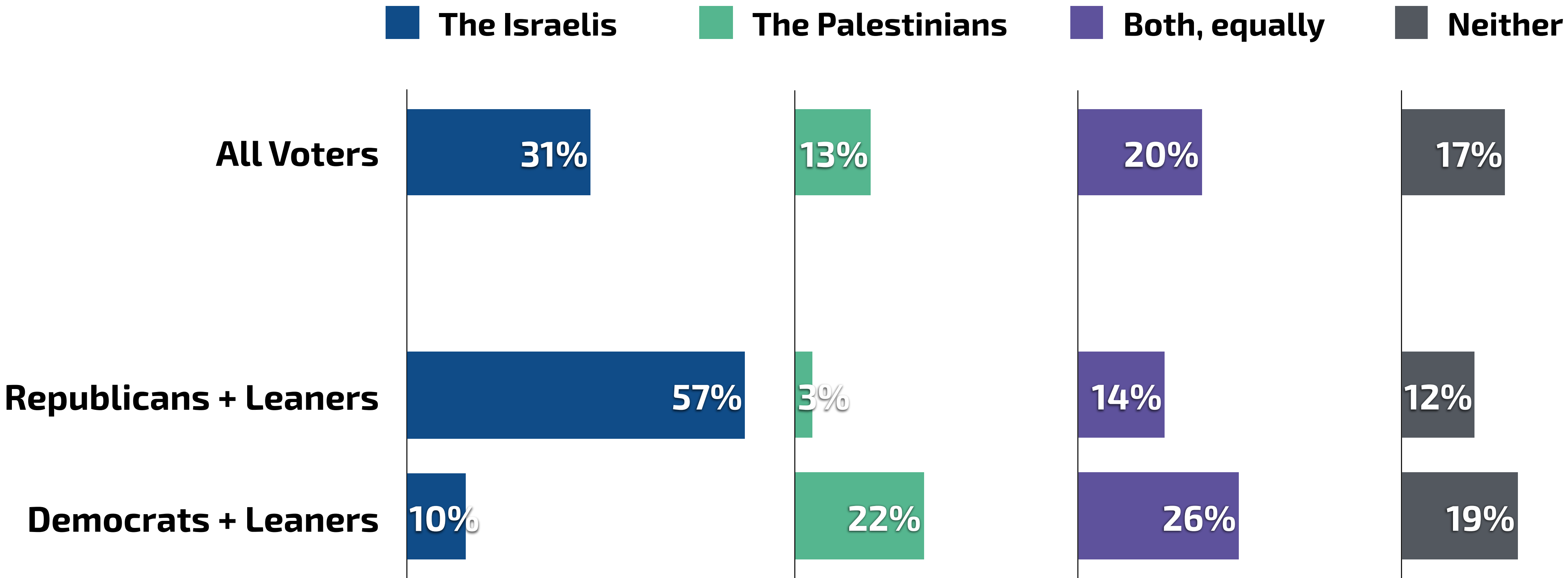

Democrats Sympathize With Palestinians More Than Israelis

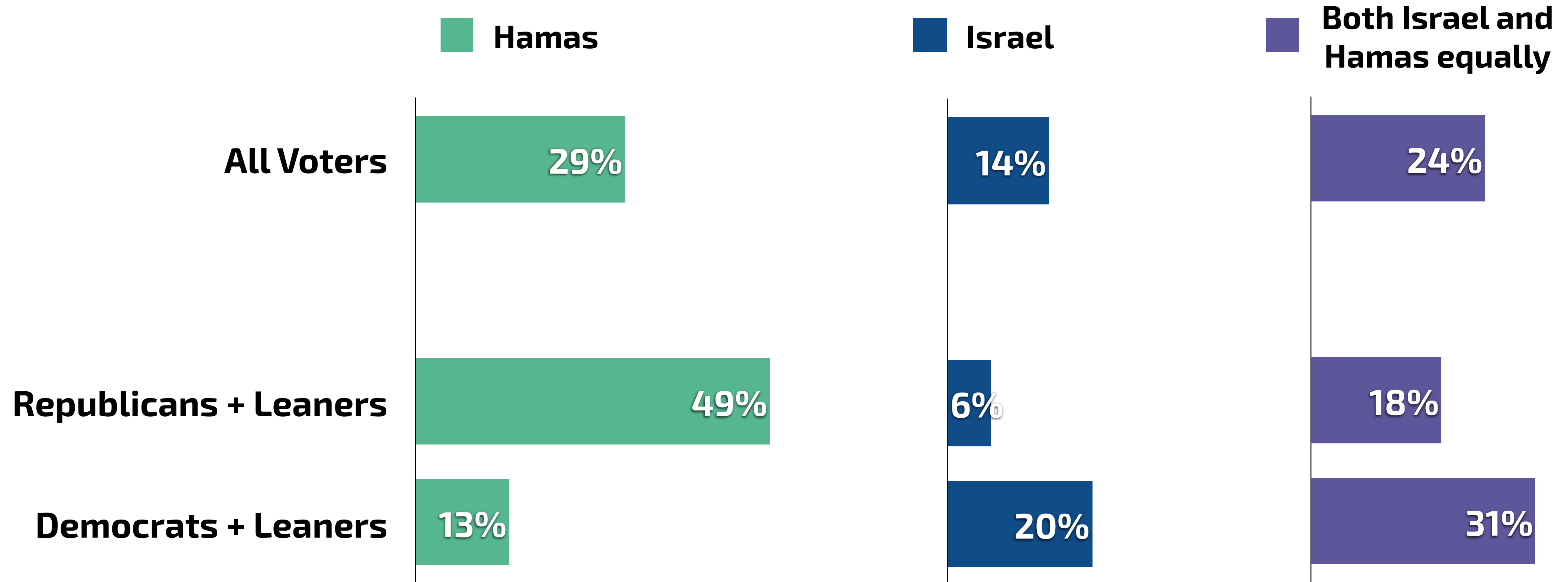
Q. In the dispute between Israel and the Palestinians, which side do you sympathize with more, the Israelis or the Palestinians?

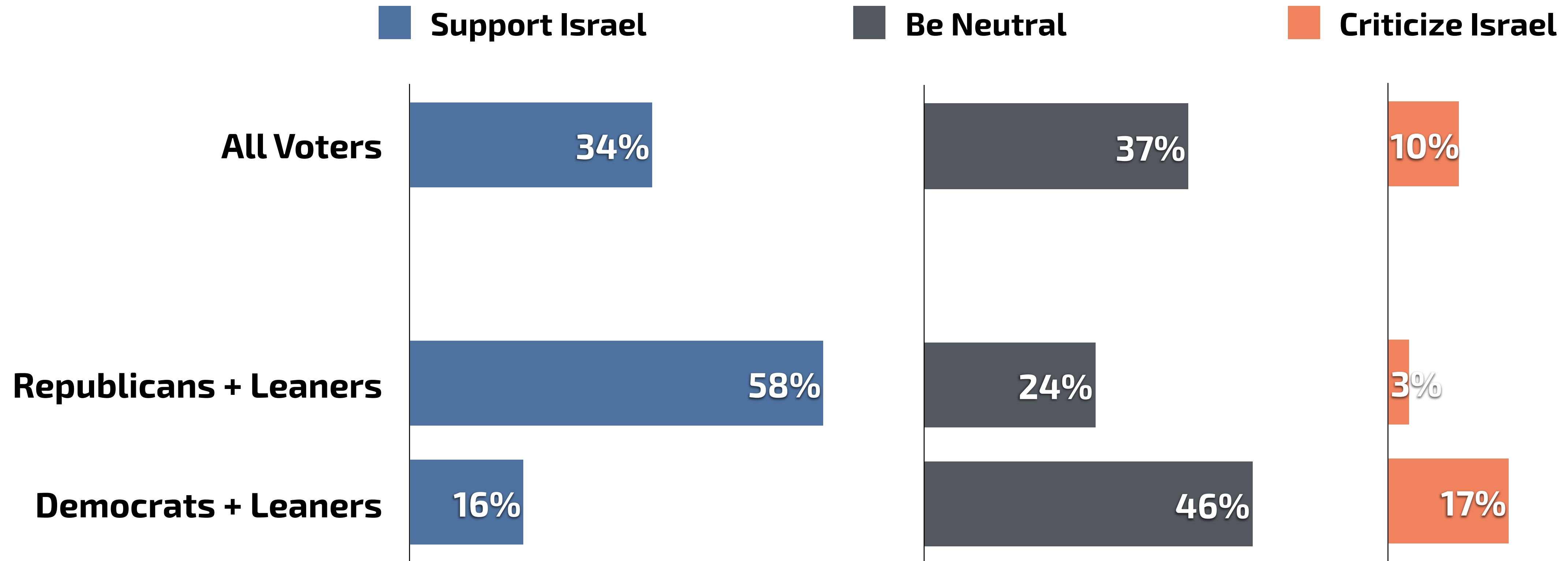
Democrats Blame Israel For Recent Conflict More Than Hamas
