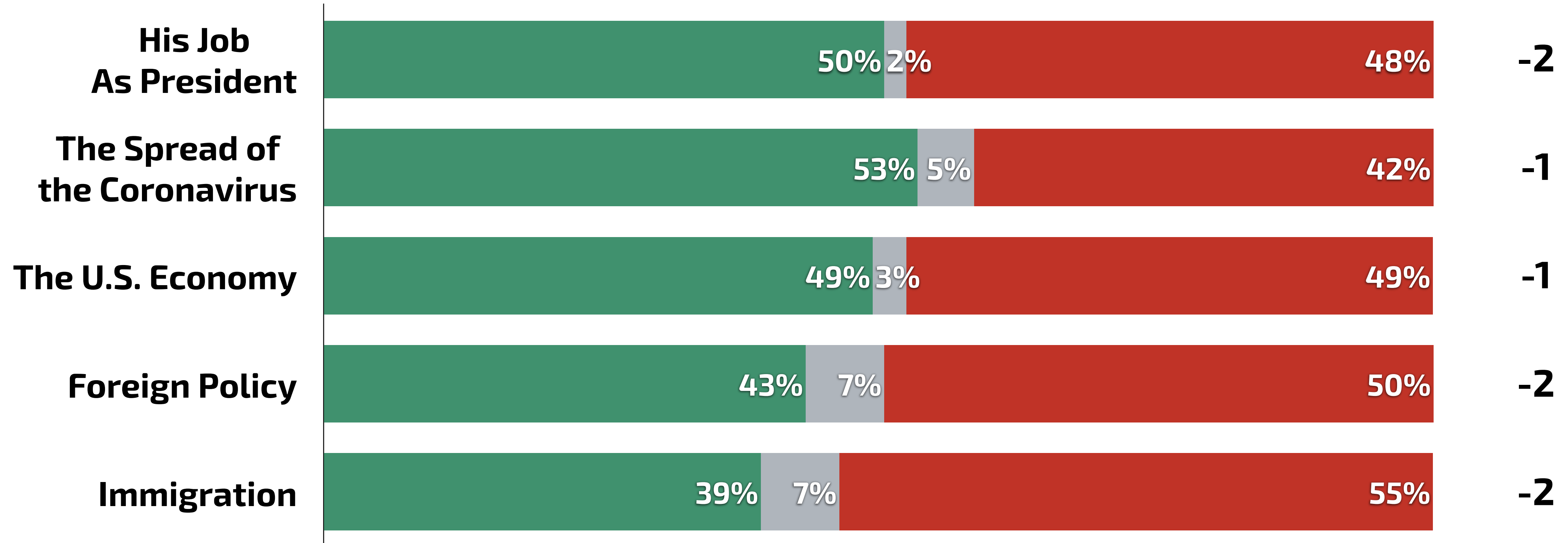

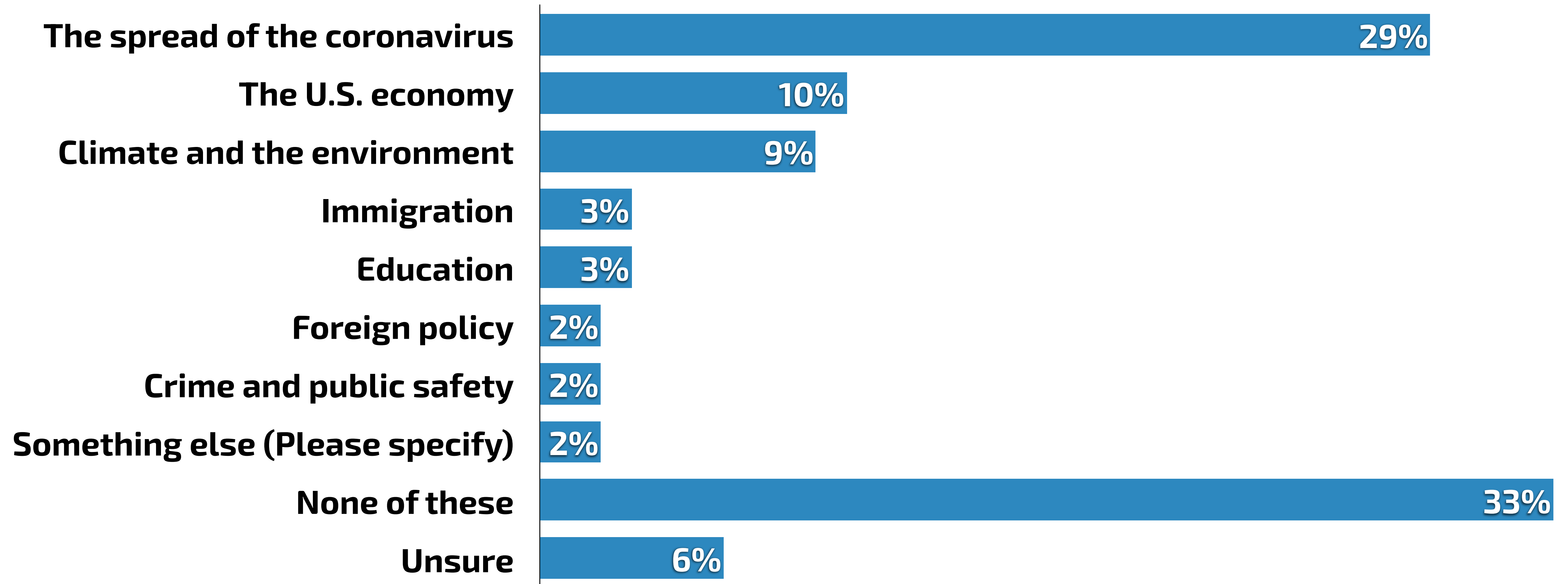

Voters Most Approve Of Biden's Handling Of Pandemic

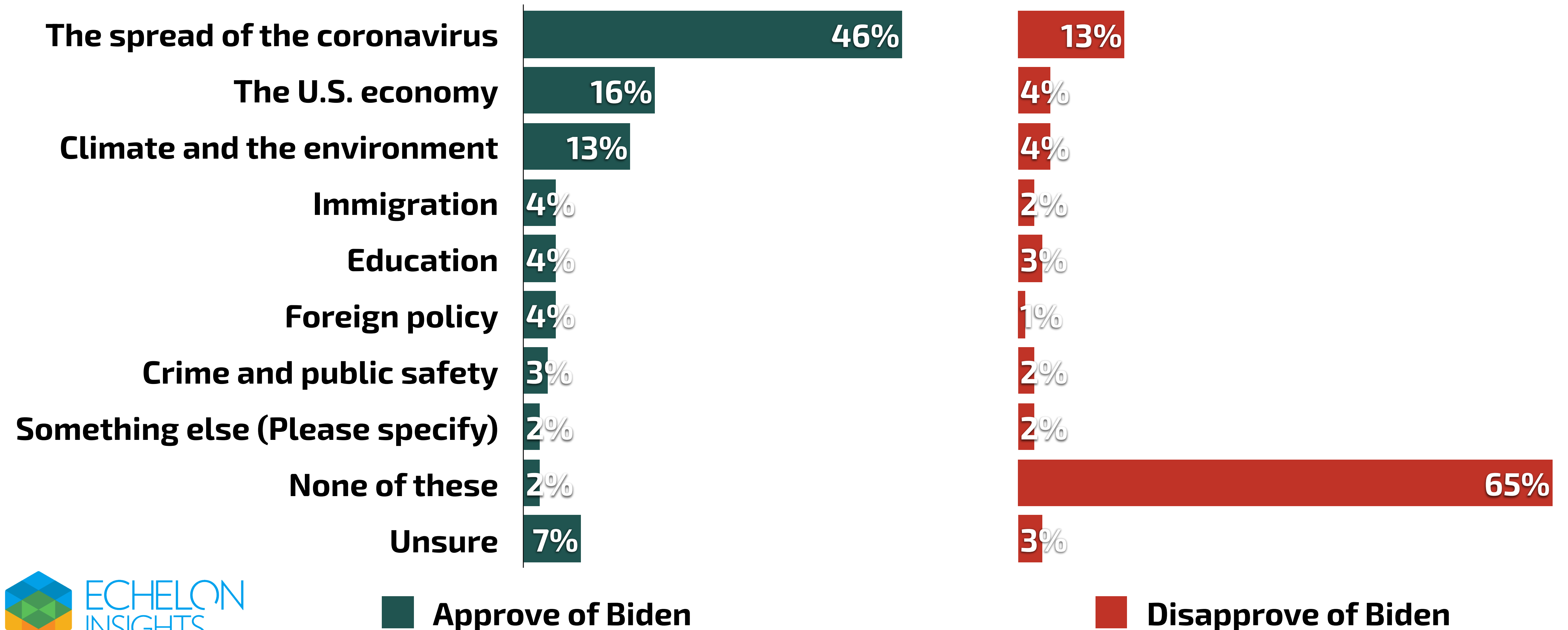
Q. On which of the following issues do you most approve of the job Joe Biden has done?

Coronavirus Drives Biden Approval; Detractors Largely Approve Of Nothing

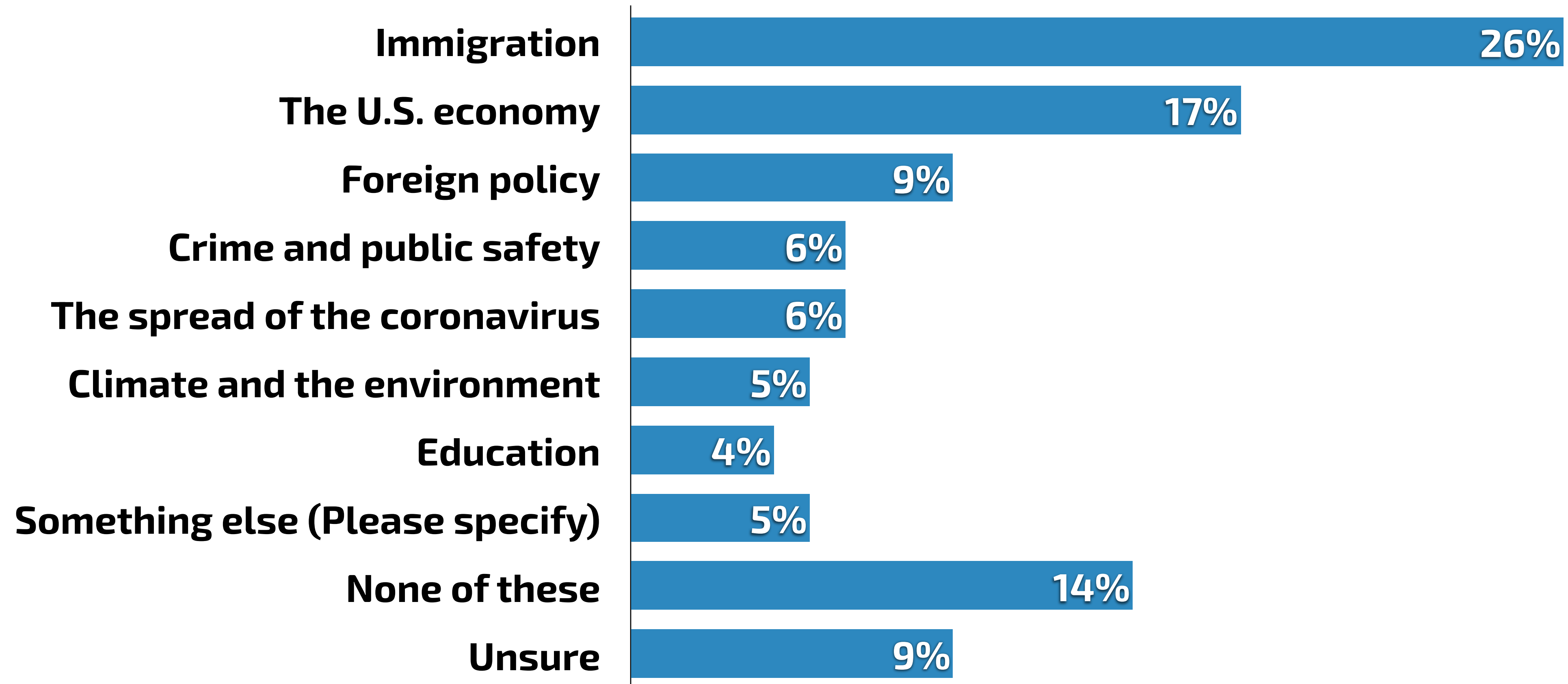
Q. On which of the following issues do you most approve of the job Joe Biden has done?

Voters Least Approve Of Biden's Handling Of Immigration

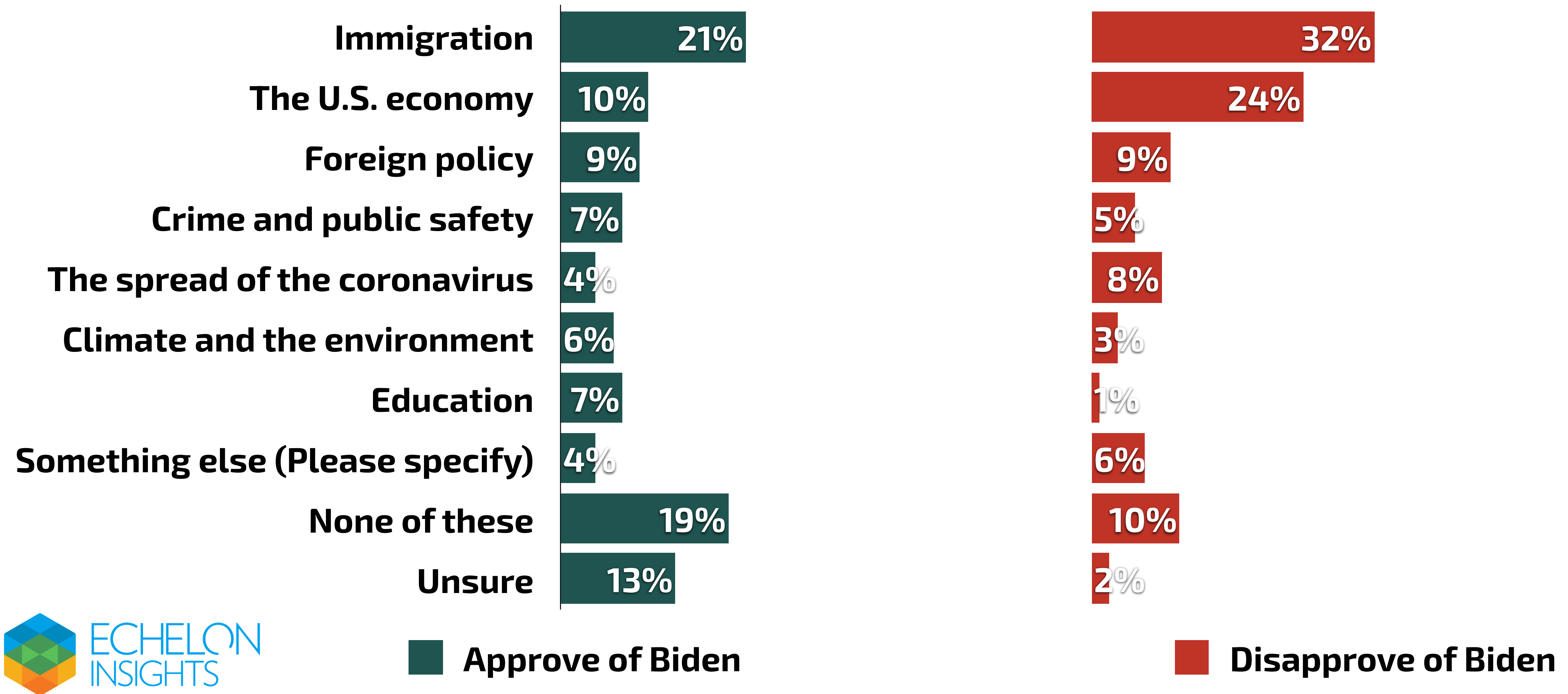

Q. On which of the following issues do you least approve of the job Joe Biden has done?

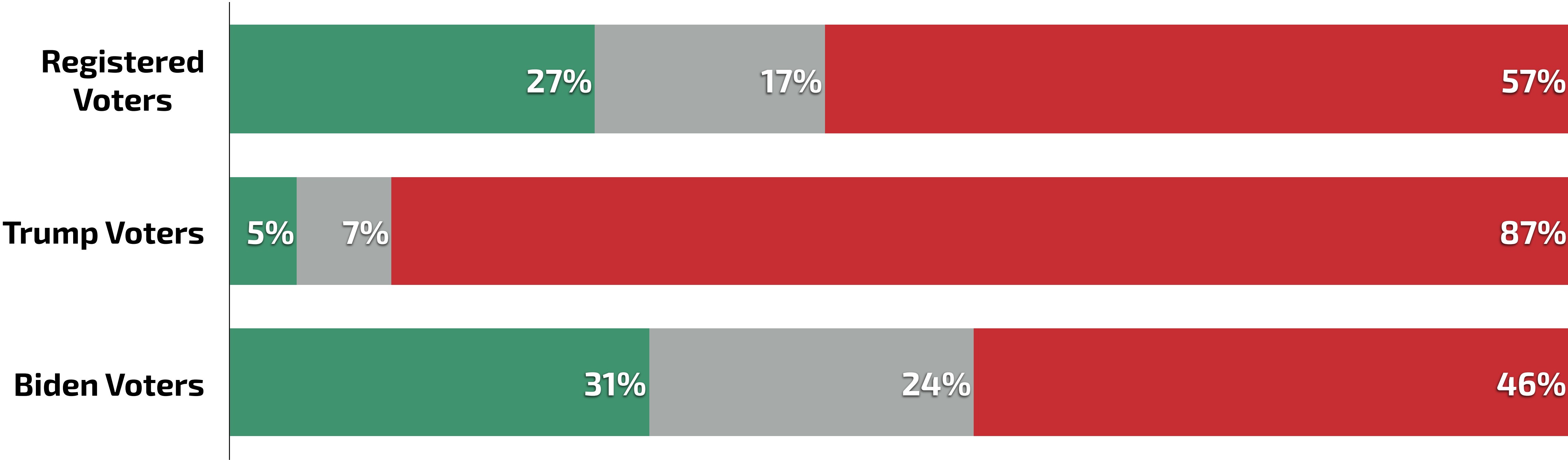

More positive Unsure More negative

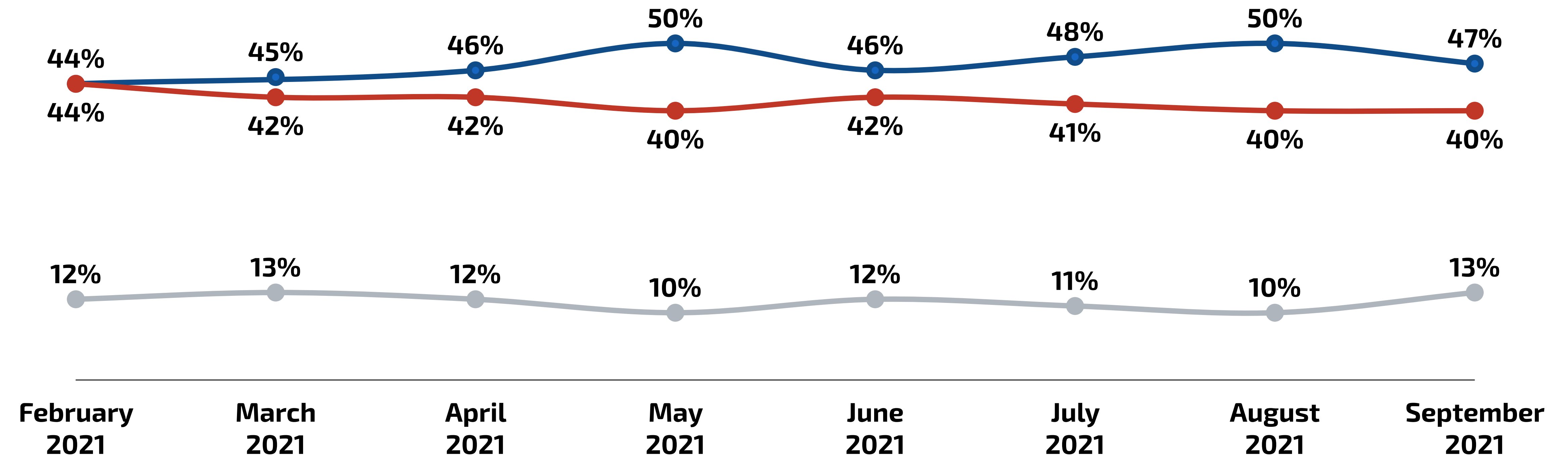

Q. If the election for Congress were held today and you had to make a choice, for whom would you vote?

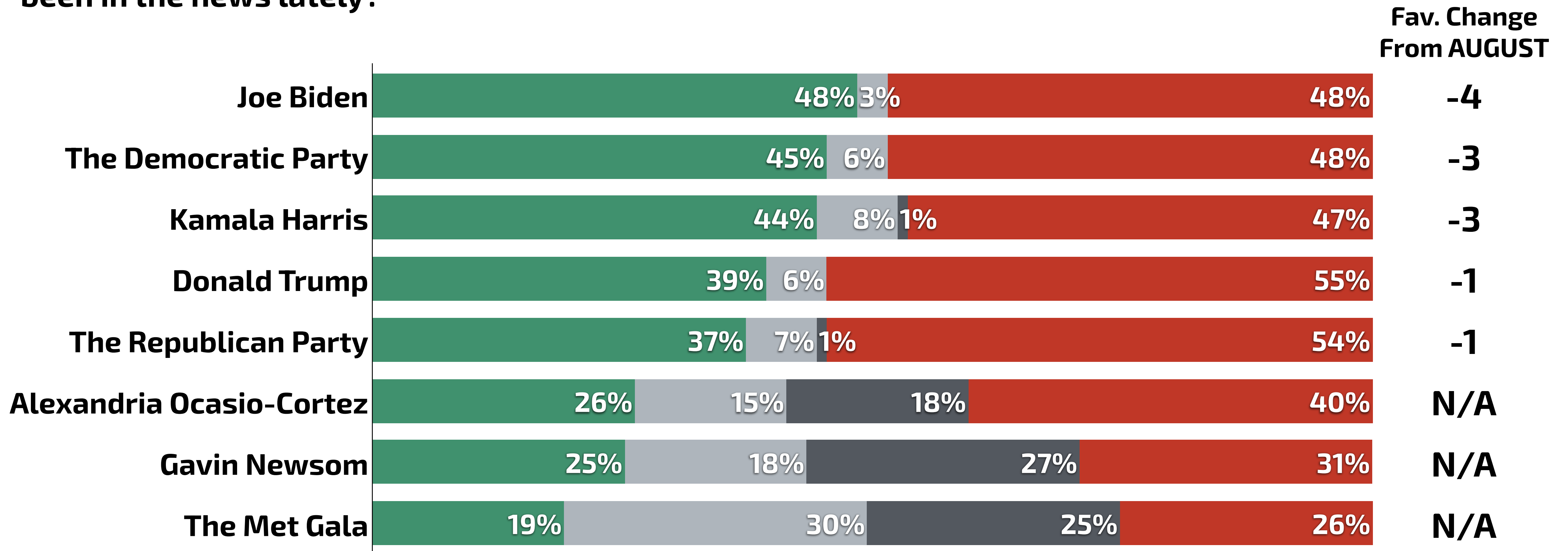

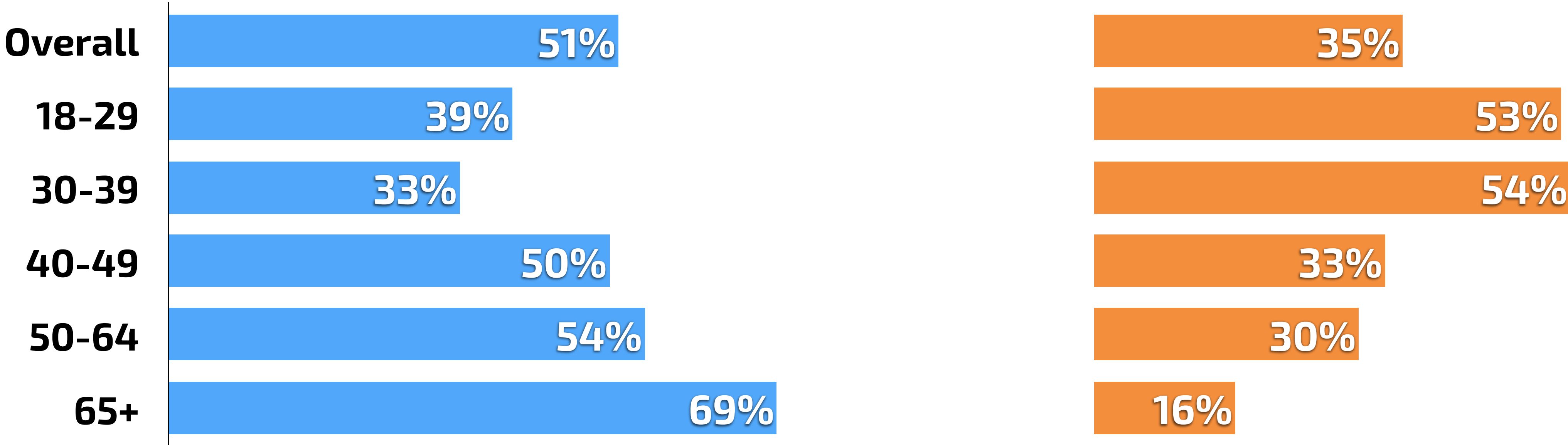

This was a bad way to get her message across because doing so at a party with wealthy celebrities was hypocritical

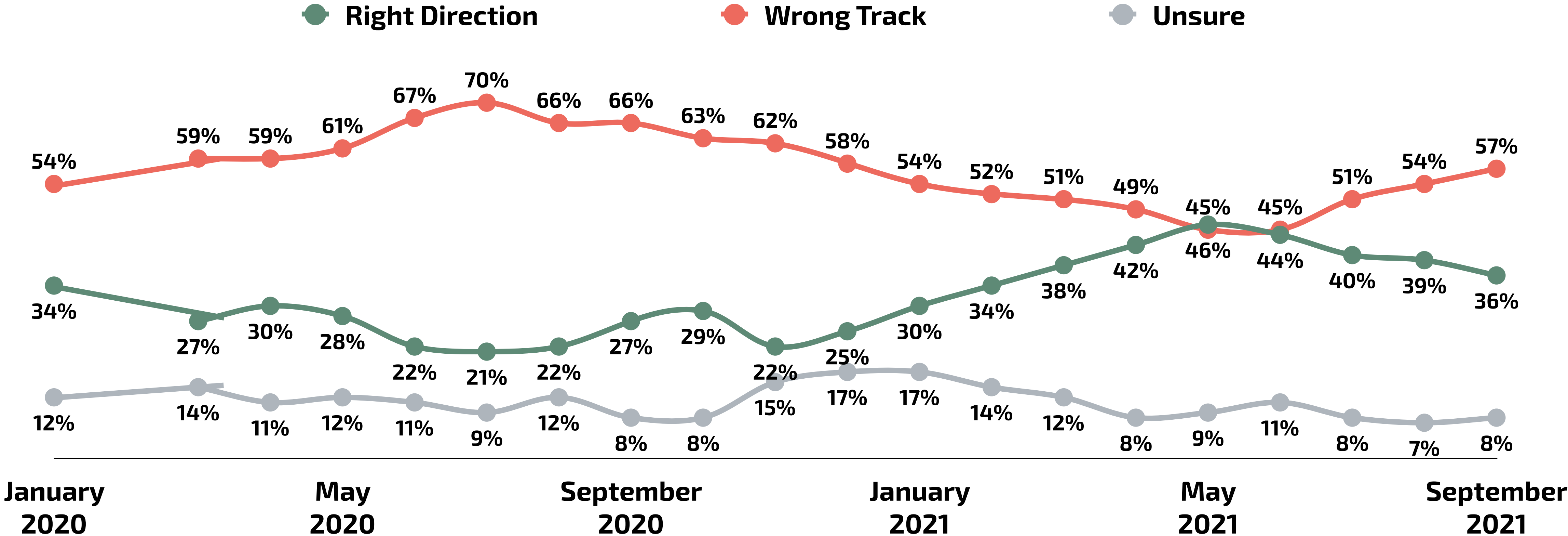
This was a good way to get her message across because of the viewership and attention the Met Gala receives every year

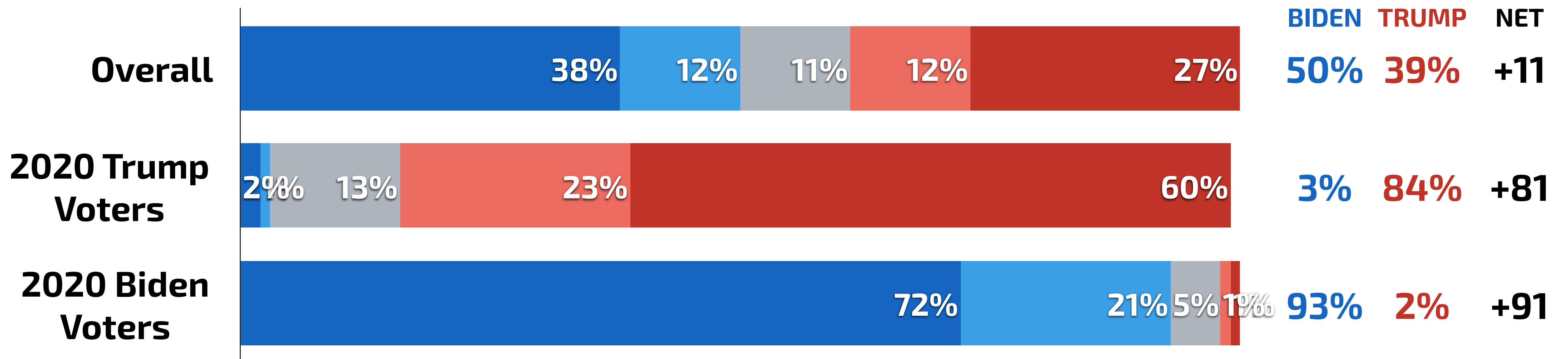

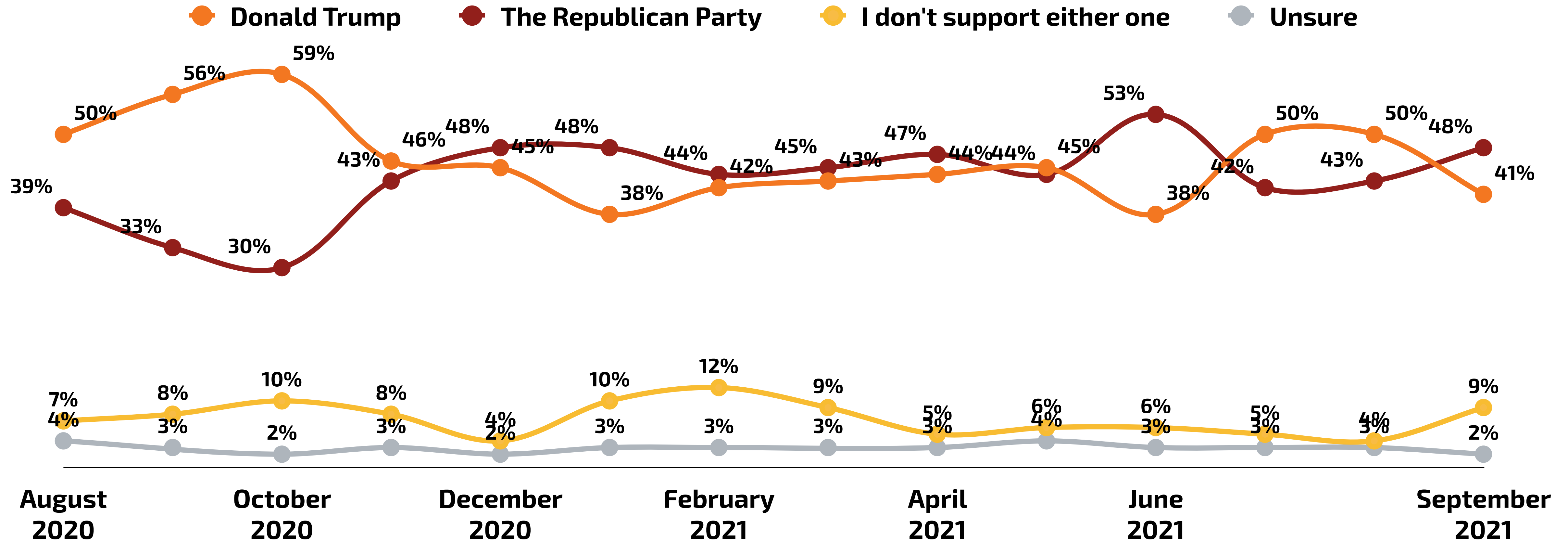

“Party-First” GOP Outnumber “Trump-First” In September

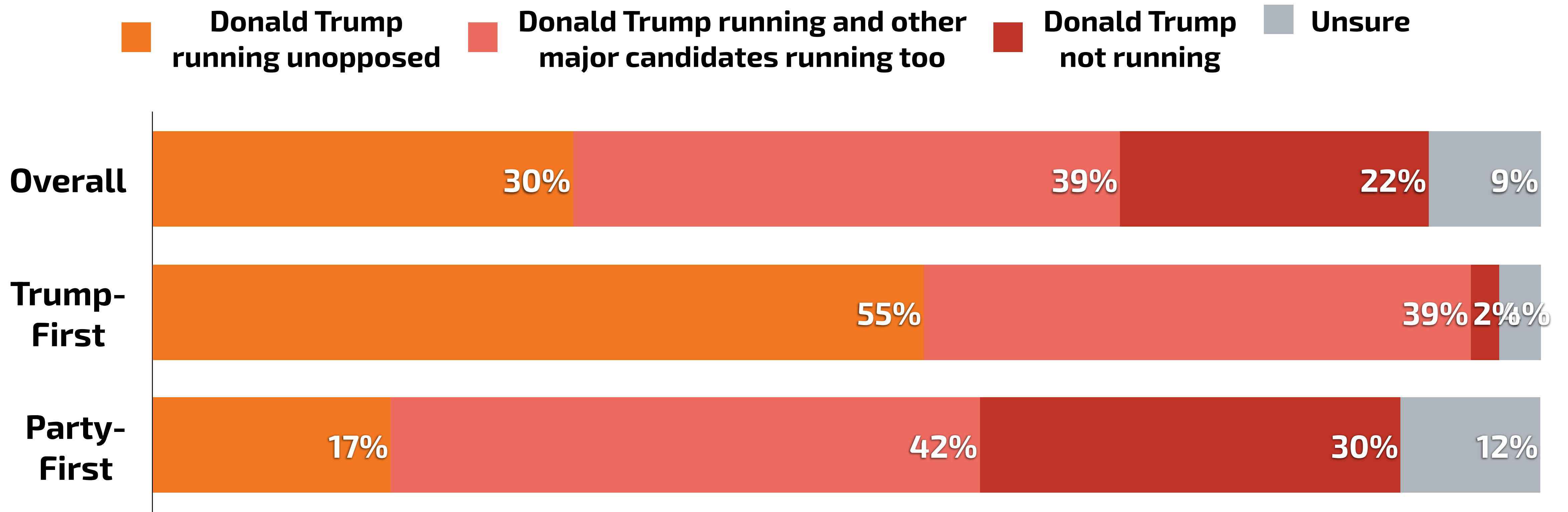
Q. Would you say you consider yourself to be primarily a supporter of Donald Trump, or a supporter of the Republican Party? [Asked of Republican+Lean Voters]

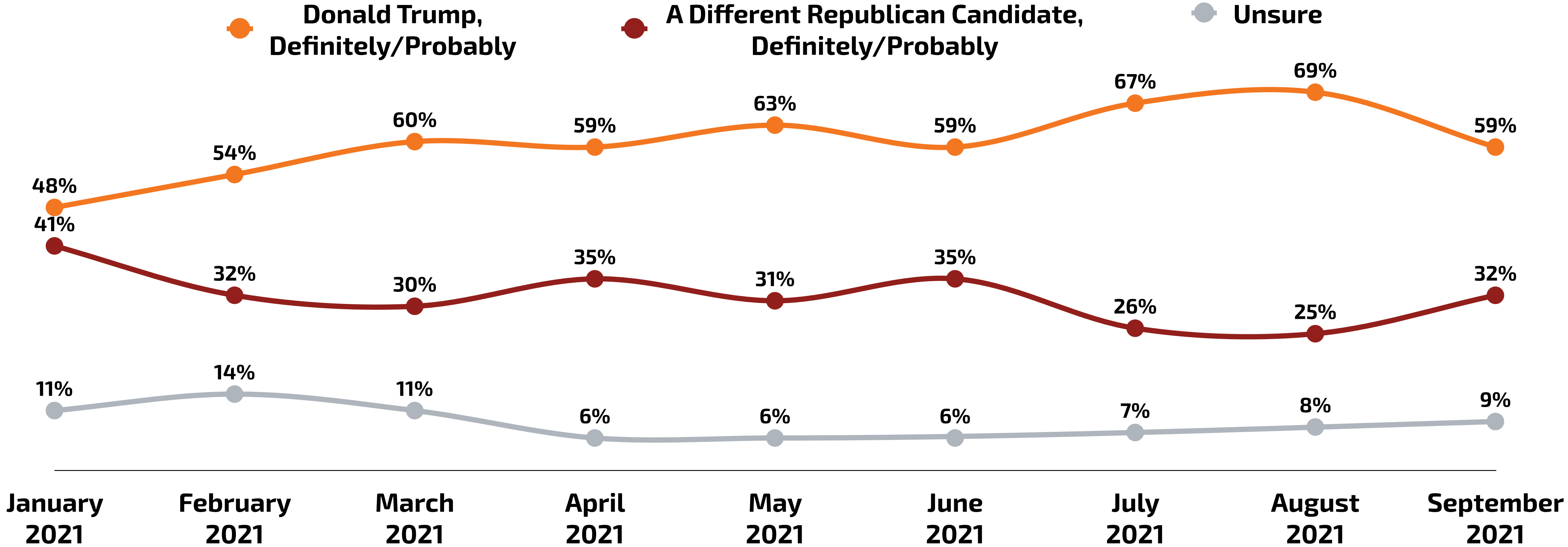
Plurality Of GOP Wants Both Trump & Other Candidates In 2024

Trump Advantage In GOP Primary Dips In September

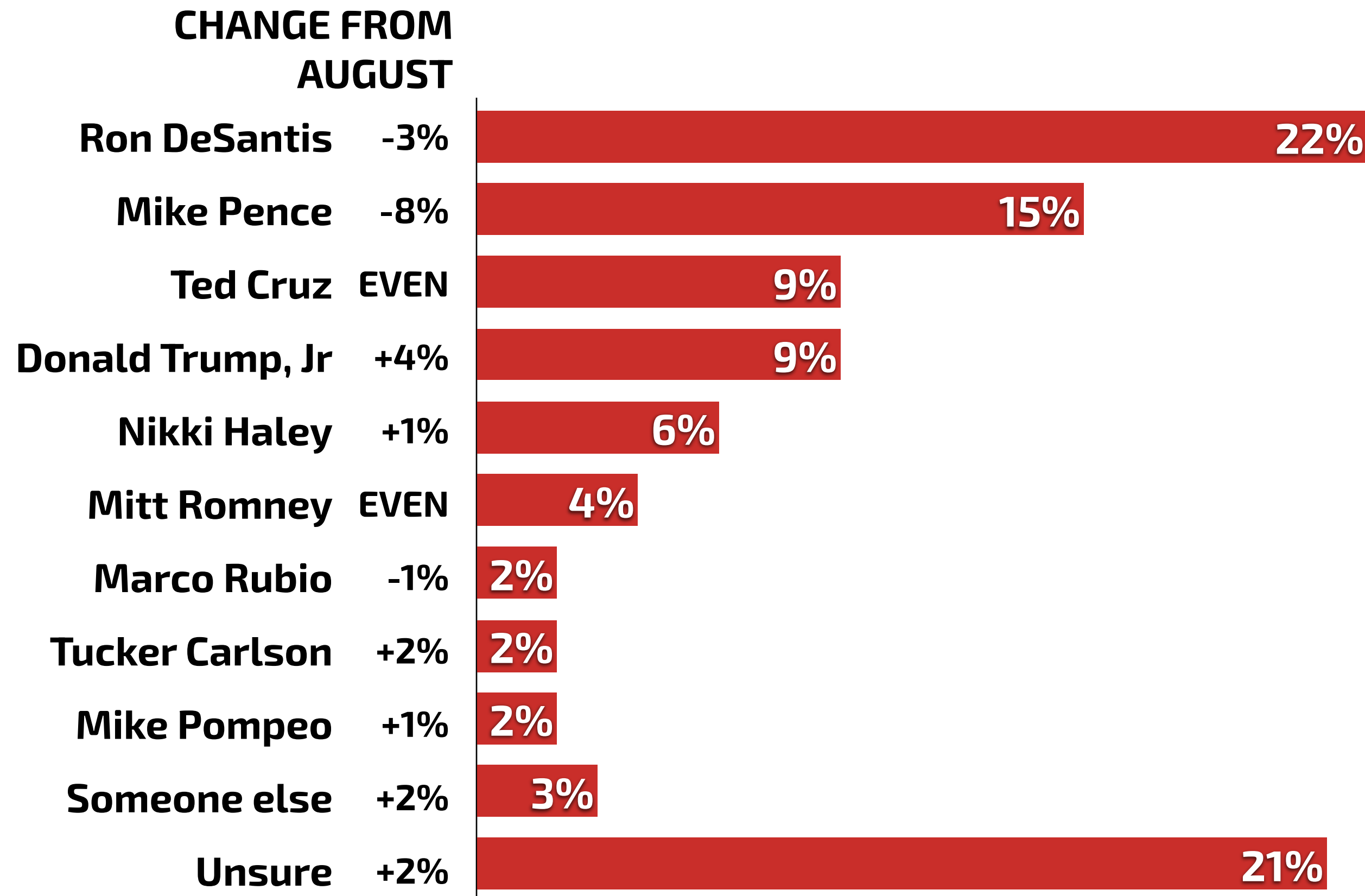

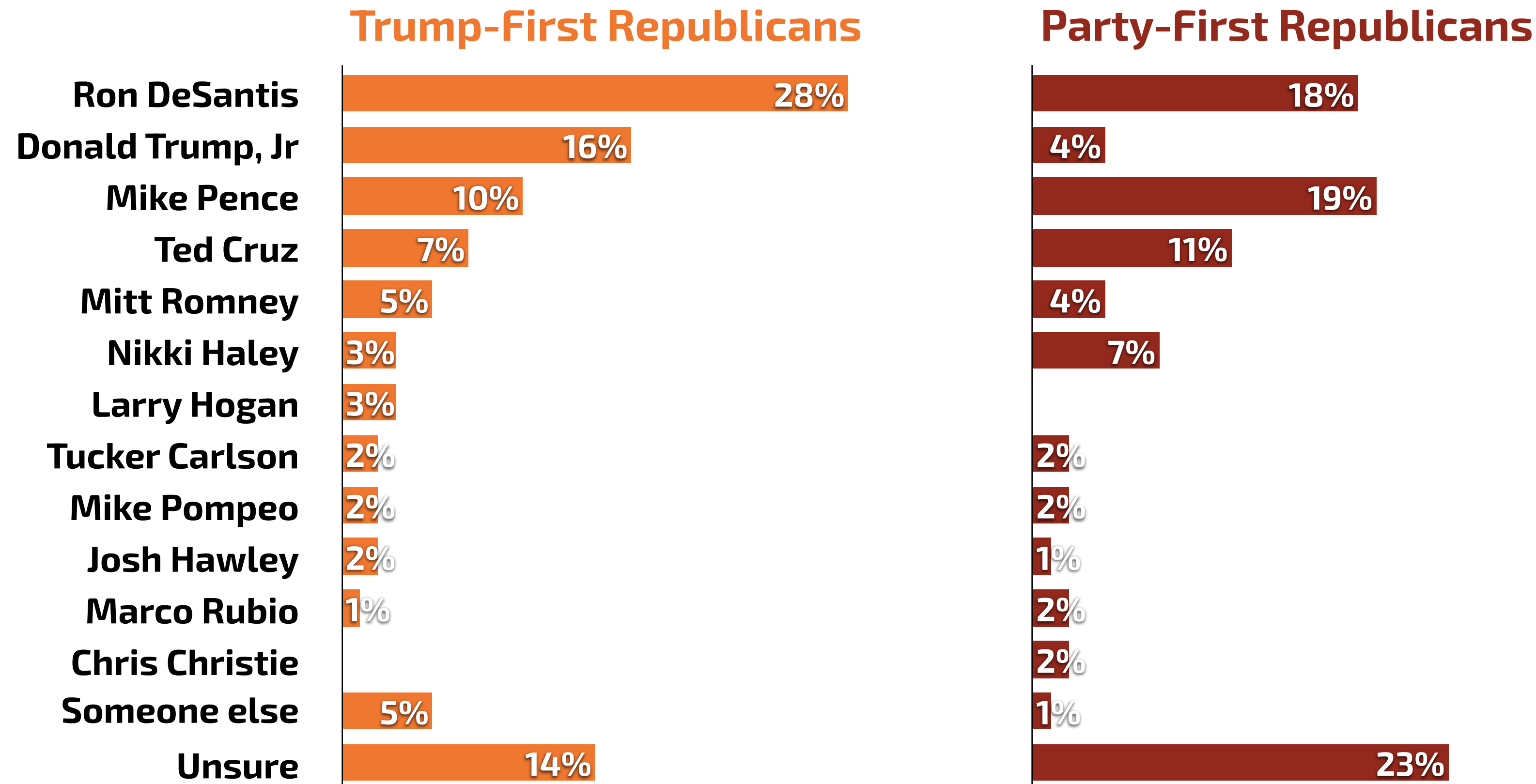

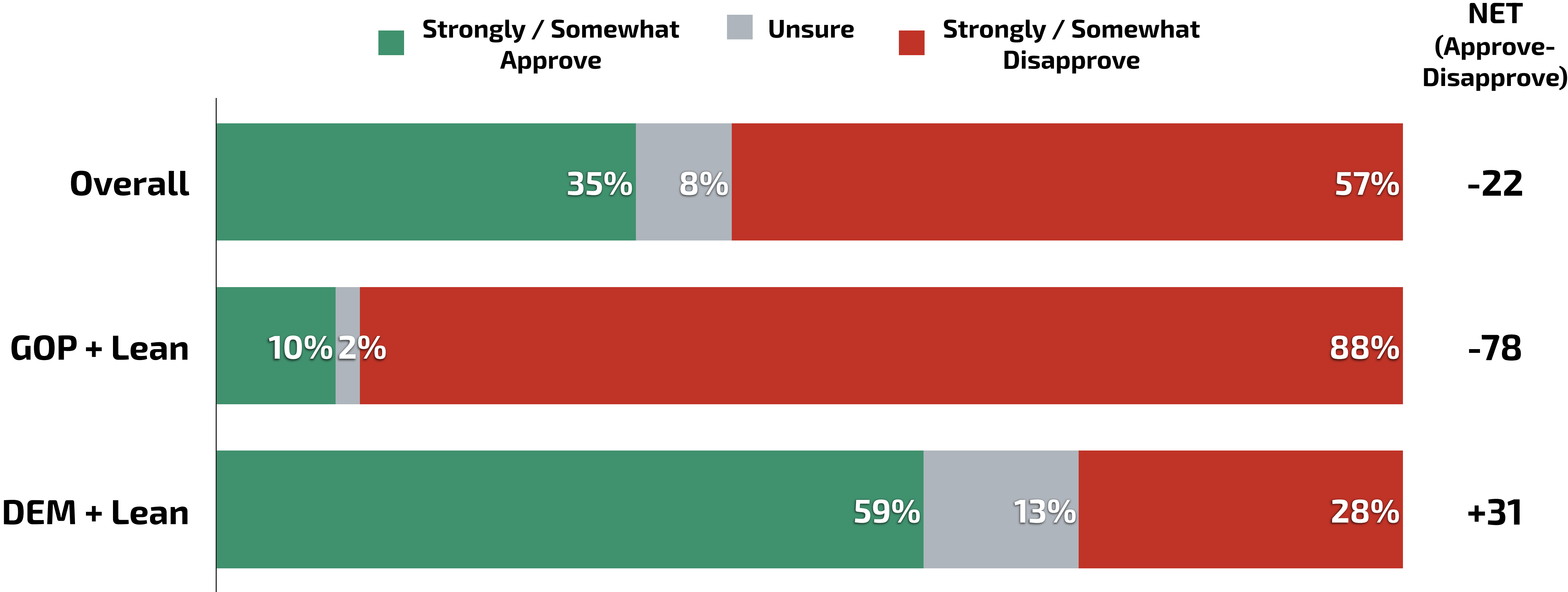

Only One Third Approve Of Biden's Handling Of Afghanistan

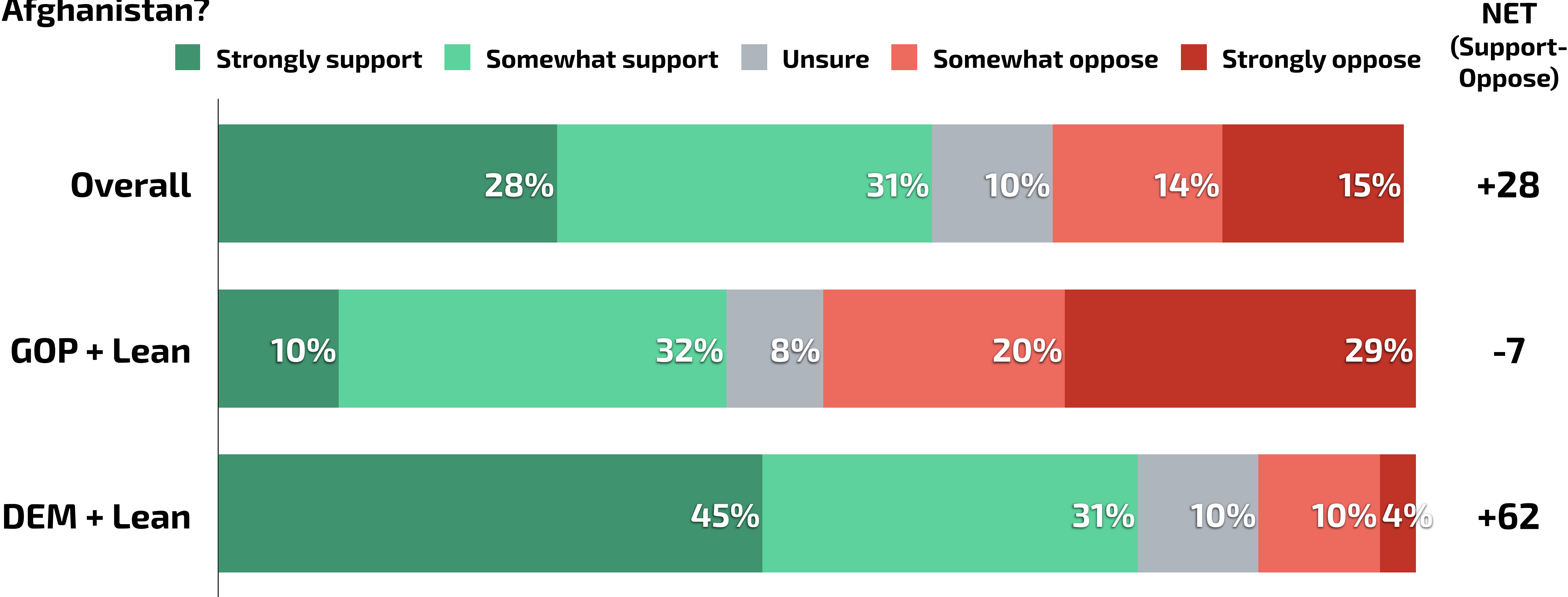
Q. Do you approve or disapprove of the way Joe Biden is handling the withdrawal from Afghanistan?

Democrats Drive Support For Afghanistan Withdrawal

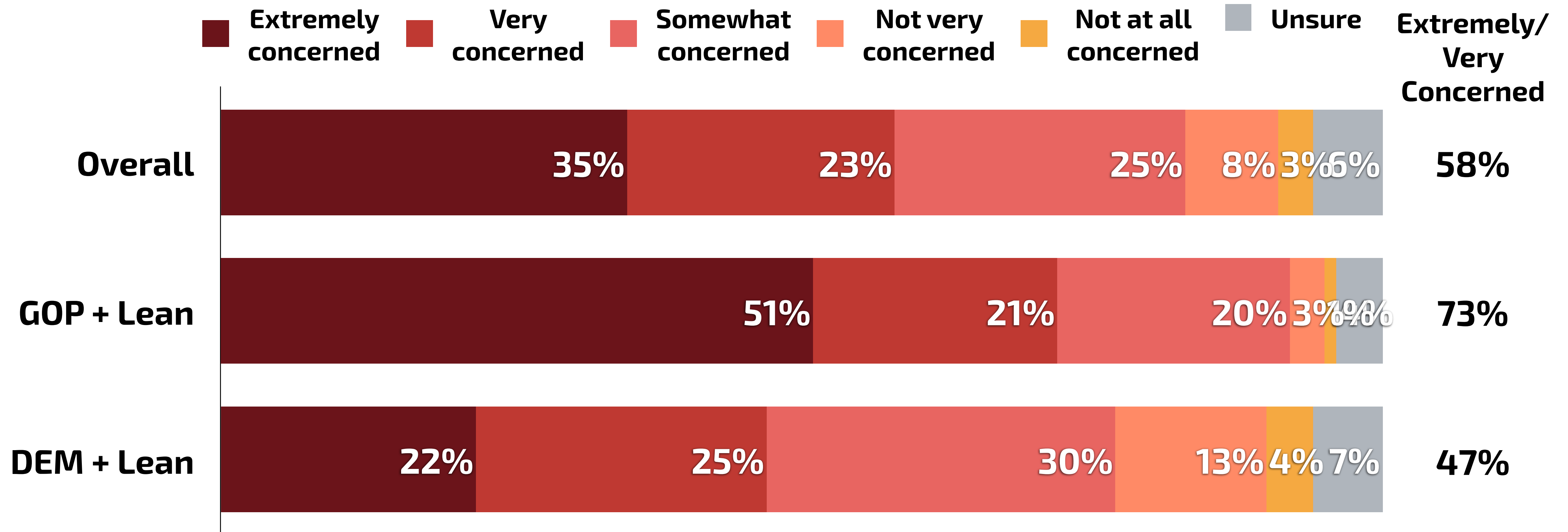
Q. Do you support or oppose the decision to withdraw all American military presence from Afghanistan?

Voters Concerned Afghanistan Withdrawal Makes U.S. Less Safe

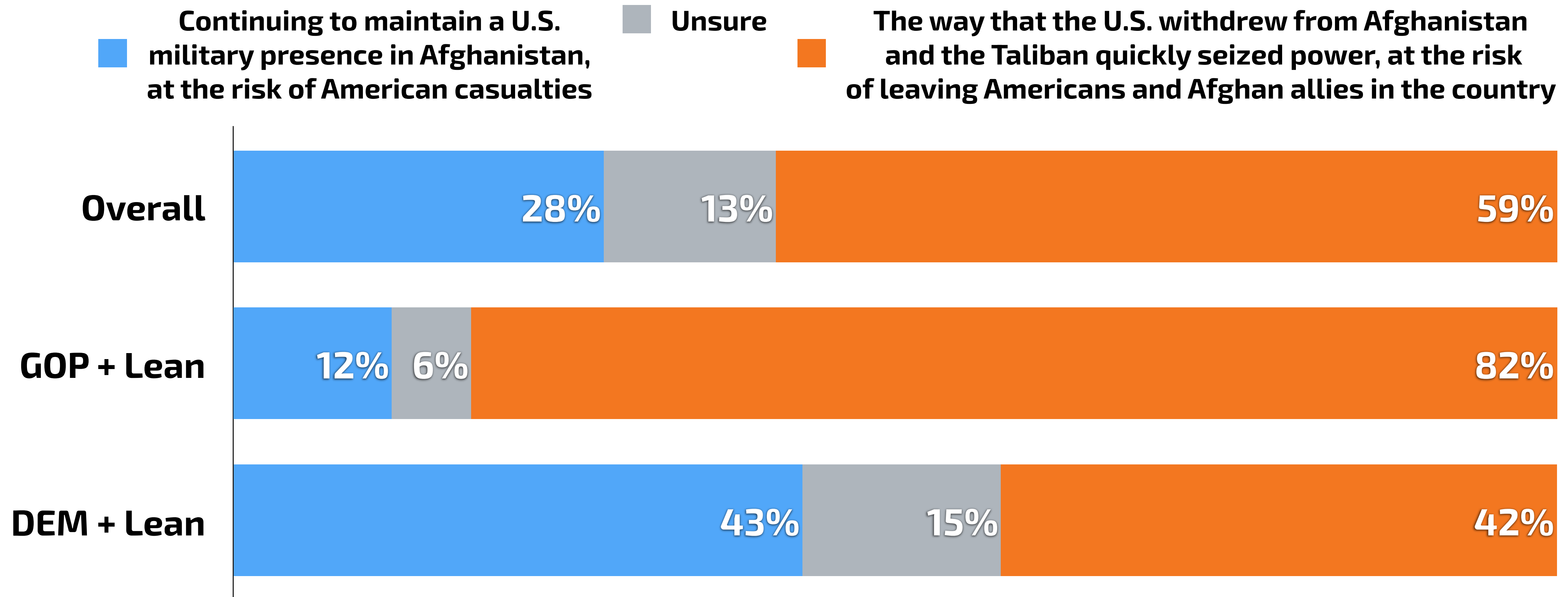
