



Biden Job Approval Up 4 Points In August



Biden Approval At Highest Point Since January 2022








Biden Favs At Highest Point Since January 2022





Yang Most Liked By Liberals; Forward Party Viewed Unfavorably By 2-1 Margin





Q. Would you say things in the United States are headed in the right direction, or is the country off on the wrong track?






Cost Of Living Remains Top Issue Even With 5% Drop; Political Corruption Sees Largest Increase In August

Q. If you had to choose just one, which would you say is the biggest issue facing the country today?







High Motivation To Vote Has Increased 16% Among Independents Since *Dobbs*



















Single Women Most Likely To Say Protecting Abortion Rights Is More Important To Their Vote Than Inflation









Appetite For Trump 2024 Increases In August

Q. Would you like to see Donald Trump run for President in 2024?




















Biden Lead In 2020 Rematch Largest Since October 2021






Cheney Independent Run Results 3 Point Trump Win










Independent Trump Bid Splits GOP Support








Majority Feel Represented By Two-Party System, Though A Majority Of Moderates Do Not






DeSantis Holds 30 Point Lead Over Non-Trump Field




















DeSantis Easily Leads "Base" Republicans; Haley Higher With Republicans Who Want Candidates Who Appeal To The Public










Trump Support Slips In Contested Primary





Republicans Largely Believe Trump Is Helping GOP's Chances In November Midterms















Share Of Electorate Worried About Financial Security Decreases In August





Share That Believes They Will Be Better Off Financially One Year From Today Grows In August























Biden's Russia-Ukraine Approval At A New Low



Plurality Unsure Who Is Winning War In Ukraine







COVID Concerns Down Slightly In August



Unvaccinated Voters More Likely To Say They Are Not At All Concerned About COVID Infection









Q. Which of the following best describes your feelings about the coronavirus outbreak in the United States?








Meet the Likely Electorate

We know that on Election Day, those who turn out to vote won't necessarily look like the pool of all registered voters. Some voters are more likely to turn out than others, and polling should reflect that reality. But not everyone who shows up to vote on Election Day is a "likely voter," and often times, pollsters' methods of excluding "unlikely voters" can leave out those who are becoming newly activated.

That's why, in the months leading up to a national election, we at Echelon Insights switch not to a "likely voter" sample which arbitrarily excludes certain voters, but to our "Likely Electorate" (LE) frame, which accounts for voter turnout probability in how we weight our national survey.

Our Verified Voter Omnibus samples are matched to the L2 voter file to confirm registration status and incorporate data related to past voting history. The sample for this survey was weighted to characteristics of the 2022 "Likely Electorate" population, a frame which takes into account demographic and turnout characteristics of the 2022 electorate.



Methodology

The August 2022 Echelon Insights Verified Voter Omnibus was fielded online from August 19-22, 2022 in English among a sample of N=1,054 voters in the Likely Electorate (LV) nationwide using non-probability sampling. The sample was drawn from the Lucid sample exchange and matched to the L2 voter file.

The sample was weighted to population benchmarks for registered voters and the 2022 Likely Electorate on gender, age, race/ethnicity, education, region, party, and 2020 presidential vote adjusted for 2022 turnout probability. All benchmarks for the 2022 Likely Electorate were adjusted for turnout estimates based on a probabilistic model of the likely 2022 midterm electorate derived from the L2 voter file. Estimates for gender, age, and party were derived from the L2 voter file. Estimates for race/ethnicity and education were derived from the US Census Bureau's American Community Survey demographic data adjusted to match voter registration estimates from the November 2020 Current Population Survey Voting and Registration Supplement.

Data quality measures included the use of a trap question to check for attentiveness and measures to prevent and remove duplicate responses based on IP address and voter file matches.

Calculated the way it would be for a random sample and adjusted to incorporate the effect of weighting, the margin of sampling error is +/- 3.6 percentage points.
