




Republicans Have Heard Slightly More About Cuba Protests

Democrats Most Likely To Blame U.S. For Conditions In Cuba



Republicans, Democrats Lean Toward Showing Support For Protesters




Half Of Trump Republicans Want U.S. To Show Support For Protesters


Hispanics Especially Want U.S. To Show Support For Protesters




GOP Drives Support For Increasing Cuban Sanctions







Stronger Support For Sanctions Among Party-First GOP



Foreign Policy Hawks, Doves Intensely Divided On Increasing Sanctions




Whites, Hispanics Most Support Increasing Cuban Sanctions




