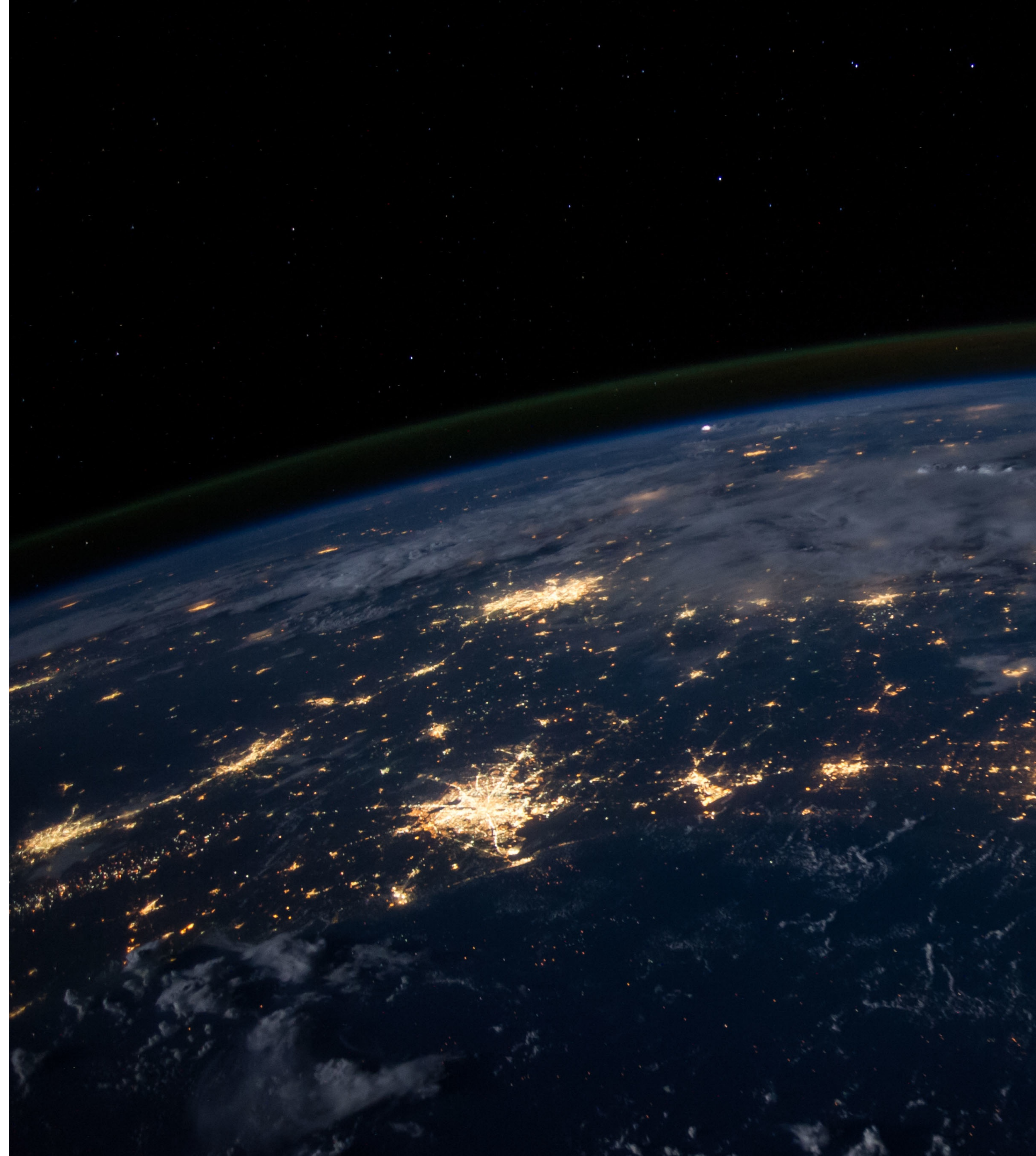

82% Of Electorate Say They Would Protect The Child In The Last Of Us Dilemma

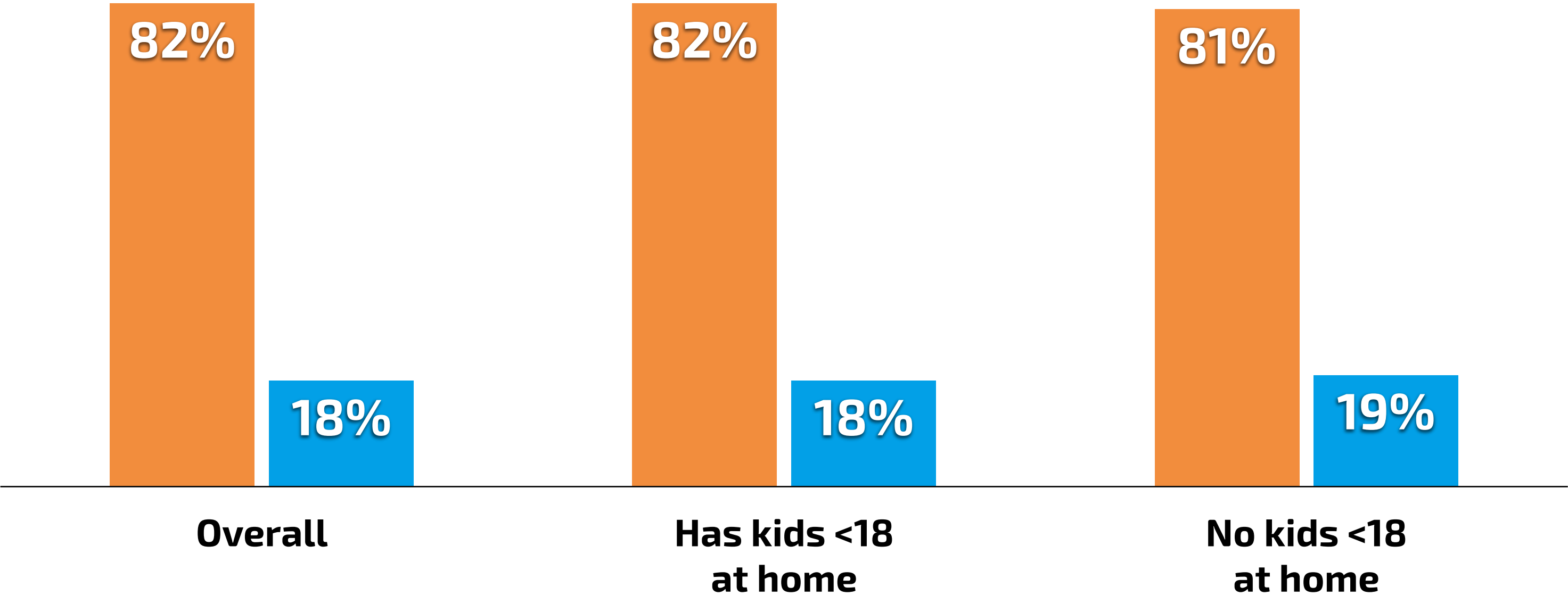
Q. Consider the following moral dilemma:

13% Of Republican Voters Favor Allowing the Surgery Compared To 24% Of Democratic Voters

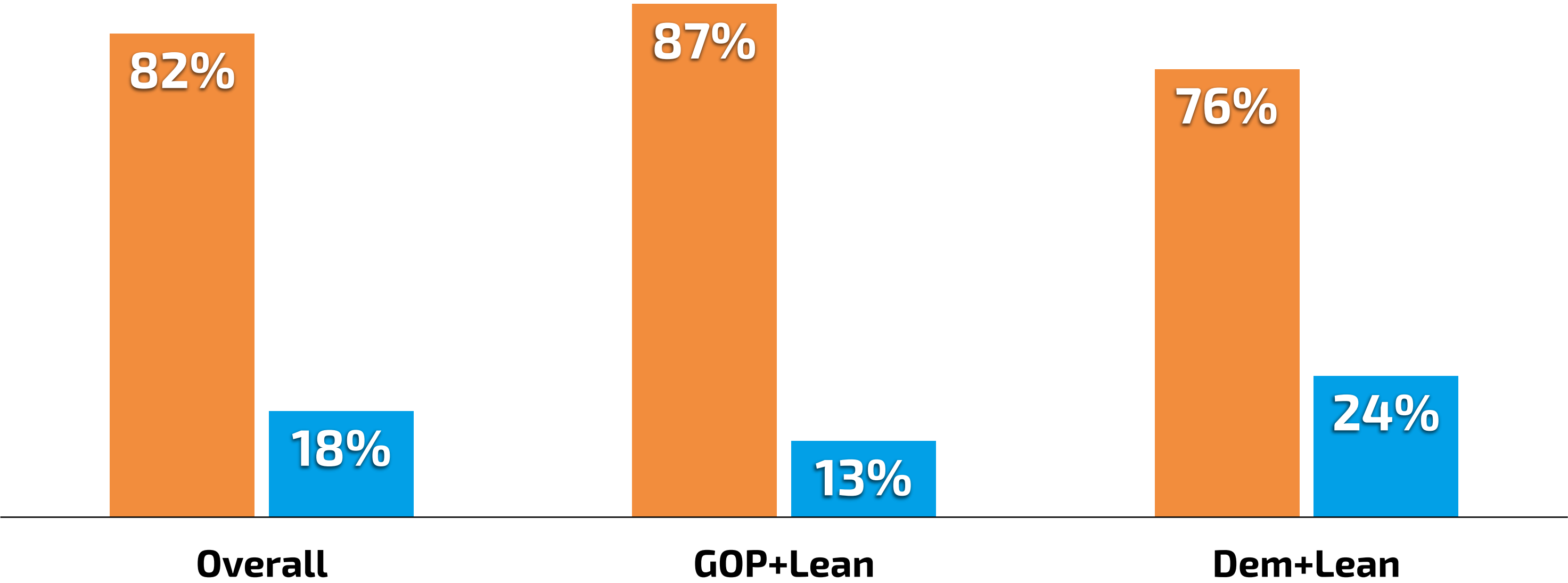

24% Of Younger Voters Favor Allowing The Surgery, While Only 14% Of Those Over 50 Do

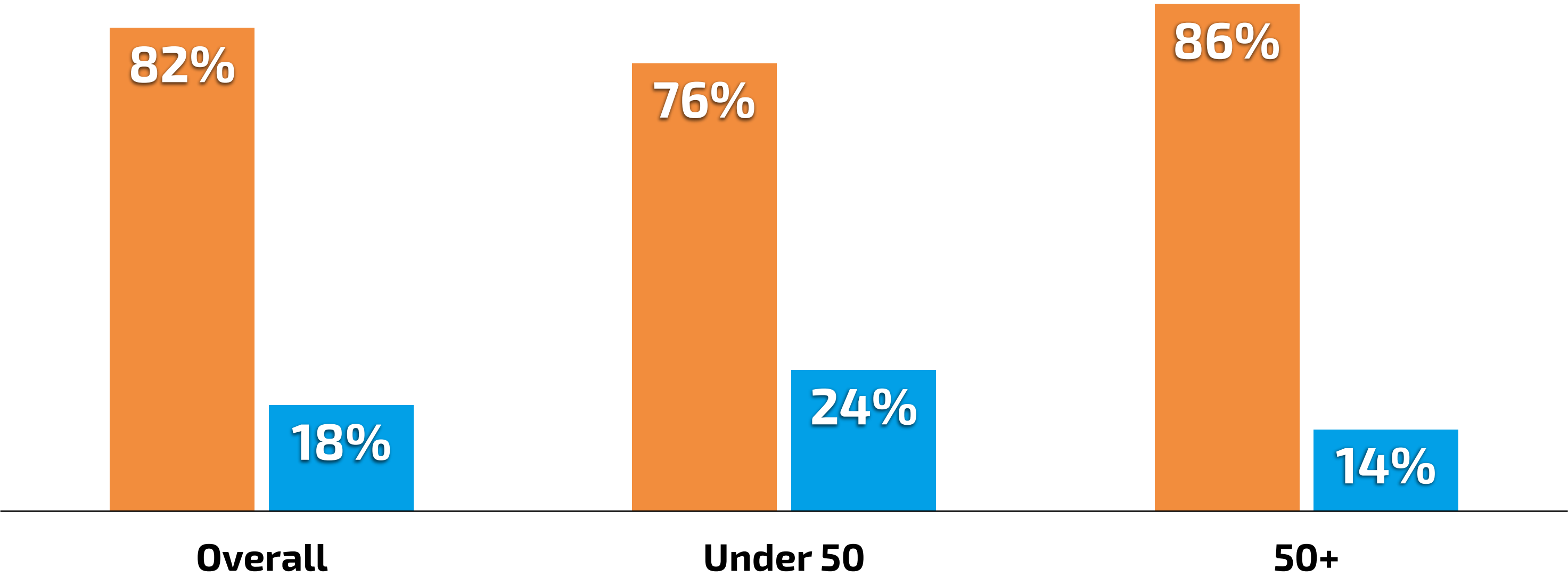
